

CAULFIELD JUST MISS WITH GREAT LAST QUARTER PARADE, COBURG FAIL TO CLINCH PLACES Hopes yet for St. Bernard's, Blues, North

Caulfield Grammarians, after trailing Ormond by 45 points at three-quartertime, put in a great last quarter effort in the game at Elsternwick Park last Saturday and went down by only five points.

Old Paradians and Coburg, third and four respectively, missed the golden opportunity they both had of clinching their places in the four, and will now have to fight for the right to play off in the finals.

St. Bernard's (who beat Parade last week), University Blues and North Old Boys must still be considered as possible contenders.

Ormond's greater adaptability to the strong windy conditions and their better scouting gave them the edge on Caulfield in the early stages and they looked set for an easy win at the start of the last quarter.

They kept Caulfield scoreless in the first term and although Caulfield put in a strong second quarter they were astray in their kicking — four goals from 15 shots — while Ormond kicked two valuable goals against the wind to lead by 11 points at the interval.

Ormond went right on with the job in the third, when they added 6.5 to 1.1, but faded out in the final term when they failed to score. Caulfield plugged away at goal relentlessly but they had given Ormond too much start.

Parade looked to have St. Bernard's measure when they rattled on 7.9 to nothing in the second quarter to gain a 17-point lead, but St. Bernard's hit back with 7 goals in the third term and then kicked 4.9 against the wind to Parade's 1.1 in the last to run out winners by more than 8 goals.

Monash Blues' 6-goal burst in the second quarter paved the way for their win over Coburg. They were their win over Coburg. They were Trinity only just got squeezed out 37 points in front at half-time and of the four, however, for Ivanhoe,

Coburg made little impression on them in the second half and were beaten by 32 points.

De La Salle surprised University Blues in the first half, when they led by 15 points, but the Blues took charge after that, with 6 goals in the third quarter and 8 in the last to score a run-away win.

North Old Boys broke away from Melbourne High when they kicked 9 goals in the second term and although High replied with the same number in the third, North finished too strongly and won by 3 goals. Ormond's win over Caulfield took

them to the top rung of the ladder but Caulfield are in no danger of losing second place. These two are the logical Grand Finalists.

University Blacks almost certainly assured themselves of top place when they scored a resounding win over Old Scotch. The margin was nearly 8 goals.

Old Trinity lost their place in the four when they suffered a 33-point defeat by Kew, who seem to make a habit of upsetting teams higher on the ladder.

Tooronga-Malvern showed improved form in playing a drawn game with Old Carey, and although Geelong beat Uni. High by a big margin, U.H.S. made them earn their goals.

Power House continued their bad run when they went down to Old Haileybury by 2 goals. Assumption also suffered a shock defeat, National Bank beating them by 15 points.

It was only remarkably accurate kicking by St. Kilda CBC (16.2) which enabled them to beat Fairfield (13.17) by 3 points. Reservoir continued their unbeaten run with a big win over Commonwealth Bank and Old Xaverians easily beat Old Melburnians.

Brunswick scraped home by a goal from St. Pat's, and Old Geelong ran Parkside to 2 goals. Hampton Rovers scored an upset win over LaTrobe Blacks, the margin being 15 points, and St. Kevin's crushed Alphington to the tune of more than 12 goals, greatly weakening Alphington's chances of getting into the four.

Marcellin had only 8 points to spare over Glenhuntly, whose poor shooting for goal didn't help. State Savings Bank beat Old Ivanhoe by 5 points, and again bad kicking may have cost Old Ivanhoe the game.

AJAX's hopes of making the four received a jolt when they went down to ANZ Bank by more than 6 goals.

Old Camberwell, still unbeaten, had 17 points to spare from Old Mentonians and St. Bede's were beaten by 28 points by Monash Whites. North Brunswick, still hoping to play in the finals, nearly ruined their chances when they beat the bottom team, La-Trobe Reds, by only 7 points.

In Junior matches, Power House scored a big win over Ormond, who dropped down to fourth. House won by almost 9 goals. In Section 2, North Old Boys settled Tooronga-Malvern's hopes, beating them by 28 points. Caulfield Grammar were no match for University Blues who won by over 12 goals.

Most interest in the Reserves were Coburg's easv win over Monash Blues, Old Scotch's 3-goal win over University Blacks, Power House's close call over Old Haileybury and St. Kilda CBC's easy win against Fairfield. Parkside beat Old Geelong by 32 points, bottom team Glenhuntly beat Marcellin by 4 points, Old Ivanhoe crushed State Savings Bank by 50 points (10.9 to 2.7) and Old Camberwell beat Old Mentonians by more than 10 goals.

David impressed on those present the old adage "You only play as you train". Evidently all P.T. men think on the same lines.


Tomorrow is the golf day at Torquay, to be followed by a bar-b-que at the home of **David Dressing's** parents.





ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS FOR RESERVE AND JUNIOR SECTION FINALS

The attention of clubs is drawn to the restrictions which apply concerning players eligible to take part in Final matches in the Reserve and Junior Sections.

The Rule relating to eligibility of players in Reserve Section Finals now reads:—

A player who has been a member of a senior team of any club in nine or more matches during the homeand-home matches in any season shall not be eligible for inclusion in the reserve team of a club taking part in a final match in the same season unless both the senior and reserve teams are participating in a final match on the same day.

Provided that no player shall be eligible for inclusion in a reserve team taking part in a final match in any season unless such player has been a member of such reserve team in at least TWO home-and-home matches during the said season.

JUNIORS

A player who has been a member of a senior or reserve team in more than five matches during any season shall be ineligible for inclusion in a junior team taking part in a semifinal, final or grand-final match in the SAME SEASON UNLESS he has been a member of the junior team for more than five matches in the same season.






