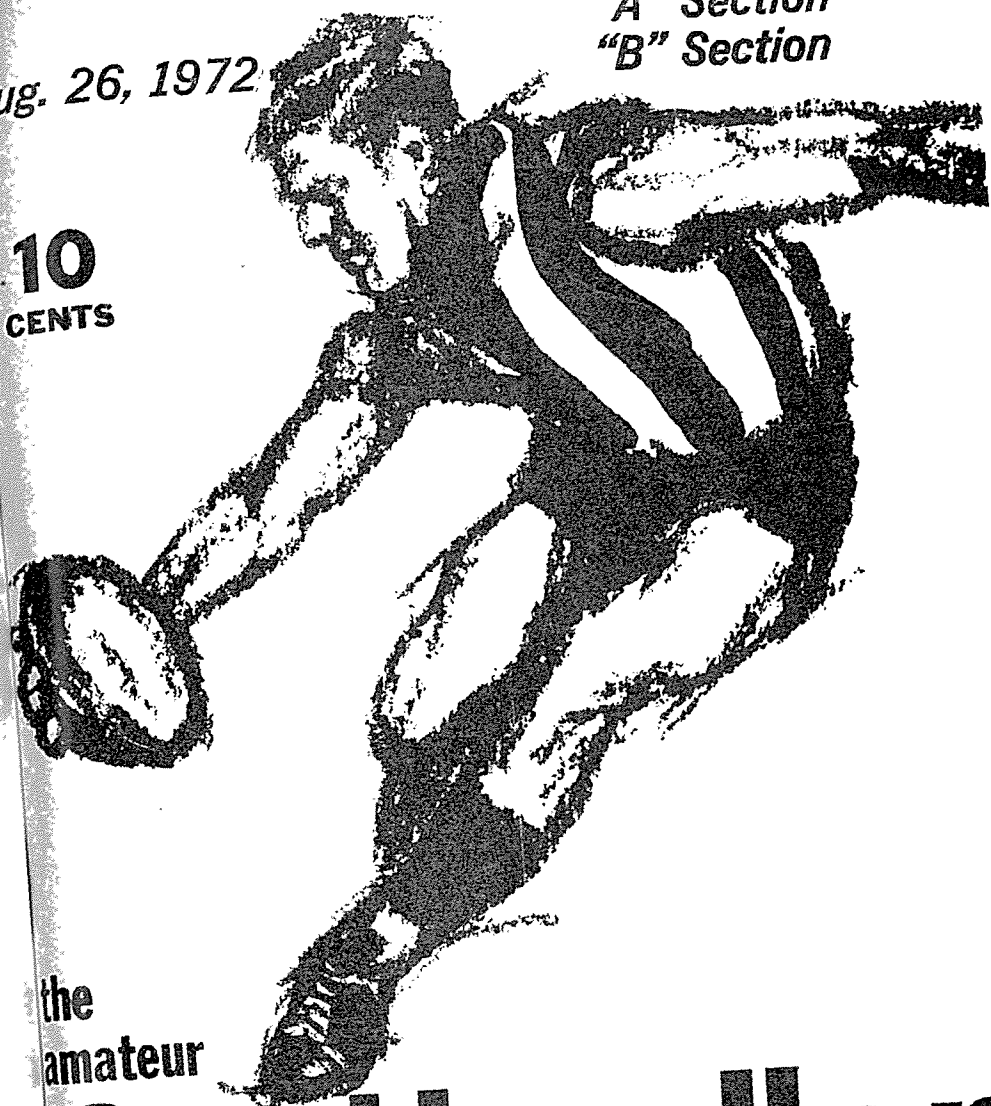

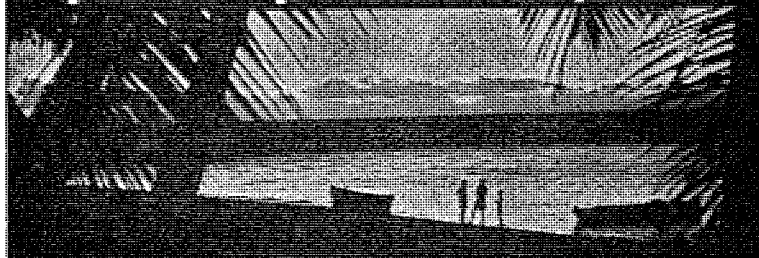

COBURG WIN WELL TO HOLD PLACE PARADE SURPRISE CAULFIELD GRAM.

Coburg scored a big win over St. Bernard's in the vital game last Saturday and held their place in the four. They meet Old Paradians in the First Semi-final at Elsterwick Park today.

Parade caused a surprise when they finished too strongly for Caulfield Grammarians and won by 20 points. It was anybody's game until the last quarter with little between the scores.

Geelong were well beaten by University Blacks but held on to second place when Ivanhoe went down to Tooronga-Malvern.

Fourteen of the 56 teams in the fours will drop out of the fight for premiership honours today — the losers of the respective First Semi-finals.

Coburg made good use of the wind in the first quarter to establish a 45-point lead, and with St. Bernard's not utilising the breeze to the fullest in second term, Coburg led by 31 points at the interval.

St Bernard's held them early in the third quarter, but Coburg broke away later on and were more than 9 goals in front at the last change. They finished well and were winners by over 10 goals.

Parade were faster to the ball than Caulfield, won in several key positions and were more purposeful in their play. Caulfield led by 3 points at quarter-time, Parade by 5 points at the interval and Caulfield by 2 points at three-quarter-time, but Parade kicked 6 goals in the last quarter.

Ormond opened up a big lead over University Blues in the first term, kicking 9.7 to 1.1, and although the Blues fought back strongly in the second quarter to add 6 goals, Ormond went right away after the interval to score by a huge margin.

Melbourne High outplayed Monash Blues in the first half and led by 26 points, but it was a different story after the break, when they managed to score only 2.5 while Monash kicked 11.7 and won by 5 goals.

North Old Boys handled the ball a little better than De La Salle and were stronger in the air, and although they

won by only 9 points it was "De La's" straight kicking (10.4) which kept them in the game.

Geelong kept within striking distance of the Blacks in the first half, when they trailed by 20 points, but the Blacks kicked 5.2 to a point in the third quarter to virtually seal the game and won by 51 points.

Old Trinity, who had to win to have a chance of taking part in the finals, crashed against Old Carey's accurate kicking and were beaten by 5 goals. They kicked 14.15 to Carey's 20.9.

But it made no difference to Trinity, really, because Old Scotch, who were a game ahead of them, made sure of holding their place with a 25-point win over Collegians.

Ivanhoe lost the chance to displace Geelong from second when they were surprisingly beaten by Tooronga-Malvern. The margin was 3 points.

Assumption held on to second place when they beat Power House by 14 points in a high-scoring game. Had House won they would have moved up to second.

Old Xaverians' hopes of making the four ended when they went down by 26 points to St. Kilda CBC who held their place, and actually moved ahead of power House.

Reservoir kicked a morale-boosting score of 36.21 (237 points) against National Bank and Commonwealth

Bank recorded their only success for the season when they beat Old Melburnians by 28 points. Fairfield beat Old Haileybury by 5 points in a high-scorer (18.18 to 18.13).

Parkside clung to their place in the four with a 1-point win over Alphington, who had to win to get into the finals. Alphington had the chance however, with four more scoring shots than Parkside, kicking 11.17 to Parkside's 12.12.

Alphington were a little unlucky as they were beaten by a point a few weeks ago by Old Geelong. They finished the season dead square — won 9, lost 9, and 1559 points for and against.

LaTrobe Blacks' poor kicking in front of goal nearly cost them the match against Footscray Tech, who kicked 17.9 to 14.28 and were beaten by a point.

Old Brighton thrashed Brunswick to the tune of nearly 10 goals and Old Geelong beat Hampton Rovers by nearly 12 goals to save themselves from relegation.

ANZ Bank surprised Marcellin when they scored by 14 points and Old Ivanhoe overwhelmed AJAX. State Savings Bank and Glenhuntly also won easily.

North Brunswick failed in their bid for the four when they went down by 8 points to Old Mentonians, whose win clinched fourth place for them. St. Bede's had a close call with bottom team, LaTrobe Reds, winning by only 4 points.

And Dookie and Longerenong put up a creditable performance against the unbeaten Old Camberwell, who scored by 21 points. Elsternwick won easily from Monash Whites.

The top four teams in Junior 1 all won with plenty to spare but Coburg crashed against Tooronga-Malvern in Section 2, going down by more than 7 goals.

A disturbing feature of this section was the fact that three clubs failed to fulfil their obligations and forfeited the game to the opposing club. In each case it was the home club which for-

feited — Brunswick, Beverley Hills and AJAX.

In the Reserves, Coburg drew with St. Bernard's, Carey easily beat Trinity, Blacks were too strong for Geelong, Assumption beat Power House by 5 goals and gained a place in the finals at the expense of Old Xaverians, who went down by 11 points to St. Kilda CBC.

Old Geelong beat Hampton Rovers by 14 points and put them out of second place, AJAX's 3-point win over Old Ivanhoe enabled them to do the same thing, and Monash Whites beat Elsternwick by over 7 goals.

ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS FOR RESERVE AND JUNIOR SECTION FINALS

The attention of clubs is drawn to the restrictions which apply concerning players eligible to take part in Final matches in the Reserve and Junior Sections.

The Rule relating to eligibility of players in Reserve Section Finals now reads:—

A player who has been a member of a senior team of any club in nine or more matches during the home-and-home matches in any season shall not be eligible for inclusion in the reserve team of a club taking part in a final match in the same season unless both the senior and reserve teams are participating in a final match on the same day.

Provided that no player shall be eligible for inclusion in a reserve team taking part in a final match in any season unless such player has been a member of such reserve team in at least TWO home-and-home matches during the said season.

JUNIORS

A player who has been a member of a senior or reserve team in more than five matches during any season shall be ineligible for inclusion in a junior team taking part in a semi-final, final or grand-final match in the SAME SEASON UNLESS he has been a member of the junior team for more than five matches in the same season.
