



ORMOND GO INTO GRAND FINAL

FINISH TOO STRONGLY FOR CAULFIELD Geelong down Blacks — gain promotion

Ormond won their way into the Grand Final when they finished too strongly for Caulfield Grammarians in the Second Semi-final last Saturday and won by 29 points.

It was anyone's game at three-quarter-time, when Ormond led by eight points, but they added 5-5 to 2-2 in the last term to win well.

Geelong came from behind to beat University Blacks in the Second Semifinal of B Section, and thus gained promotion to the top grade next season.

The Blacks play Ivanhoe today to decide which other club plays in A Section in 1973.

Assumption, Parkside, Marcellin and Elsternwick, who won the finals in their respective sections, will play in a higher section next season, while North Old Boys, who were successful in the Junior Section 2 Final, will play in Section 1 next year.

Ormond were first away and quickly went to a 3 goal lead over Caulfield, whose poor shooting for goal hampered them in the first quarter.

But Caulfield came back well in the second term and put on 7.3 to Ormond's 2.3, and Caulfield led by 9 points at the interval. Their full-forward, John Butcher, had kicked five of the seven goals in the quarter.

Caulfield maintained their lead in the early part of the third quarter but Ormond gradually whittled down their advantage and led by 8 points at the final change.

Ormond continued to apply the pressure in the last term while Caulfield tired and went down by 29 points.

University Blacks had much the better of things in the first half and led Geelong by 27 points at half-time. But Geelong staged a grand recovery after the interval, during which time they kicked 10-9 to the Blacks' 3-7. Geelong were a point behind at three-quarter time but carried on to win by 17 points.

Assumption led all day against Power House and were winners by 27

points. They were only 7 points in front at the interval but their 5-4 to 2-4 in the third term widened the gap.

Parkside hopped away with an early lead over Brunswick and held a 20 point advantage at half-time. They were 33 points ahead at three-quarter-time but had to withstand a strong challenge by Brunswick in the last term which cut their winning margin to 16 points.

Marcellin trailed Old Ivanhoe by 17 points at the halfway mark but a burst of 8 goals in the third quarter carried them to a 23 point lead and they went further ahead to win by 31 points.

Elsternwick opened up a four goal lead over Old Mentonians in the first quarter and when they added 8-2 to a goal in the second they had the game well in hand. The second half was much the same pattern and Elsternwick won by an overwhelming margin.

In the Junior Section games, St. Bernard's beat Ormond by almost 10

goals and North Old Boys beat Coburg by 26 points.

A 9 goal burst in the second quarter by St. Bernard's settled Ormond's chances of playing in the Grand Final, although Ormond fought on to add 5 goals in the last quarter.

North and Coburg was a much more even game with North holding a slight edge all through. A highlight was Coburg's accuracy in the second half, when they added 9-1.

In the Reserves games, Coburg proved too strong for Ormond and after leading by 11 points at the interval, finished strongly to win by 28 points.

University Blacks' greater accuracy in front of goal was the big factor in their 31 point win over Old Scotch. They kicked 10-5 to 4-10.

St. Kilda C.B.C. raced away from Power House after the first quarter to lead by 6 goals at half-time and finished 13 goals in front. Parkside trailed Hampton Rovers by 13 points at three-quarter-time, but kicked 6-3 to 3 points in the last term to win by 23 points.

There was little between Old Ivanhoe and State Savings Bank all day and the scores were level at the last change, but Old Ivanhoe managed to scrape home by 4 points.

The Old Camberwell-Elsternwick game was a one-sided affair after the first quarter, with Camberwell scoring a runaway win by more than 21 goals. They kicked 9 goals in the second term, 8 in the third and 7 in the last.

ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS FOR RESERVE AND JUNIOR SECTION FINALS

The attention of clubs is drawn to the restrictions which apply concerning players eligible to take part in Final matches in the Reserve and Junior Sections.

The Rule relating to eligibility of players in Reserve Section Finals now reads:—

A player who has been a member of a senior team of any club in nine or more matches during the homeand-home matches in any season shall not be eligible for inclusion in the reserve team of a club taking part in a final match in the same season unless both the senior and reserve teams are participating in a final match on the same day.

Provided that no player shall be eligible for inclusion in a reserve team taking part in a final match in any season unless such player has been a member of such reserve team in at least TWO home-and-home matches during the said season.

JUNIORS

A player who has been a member of a senior or reserve team in more than five matches during any season shall be ineligible for inclusion in a junior team taking part in a semifinal, final or grand-final match in the SAME SEASON UNLESS he has been a member of the junior team for more than five matches in the same season.
