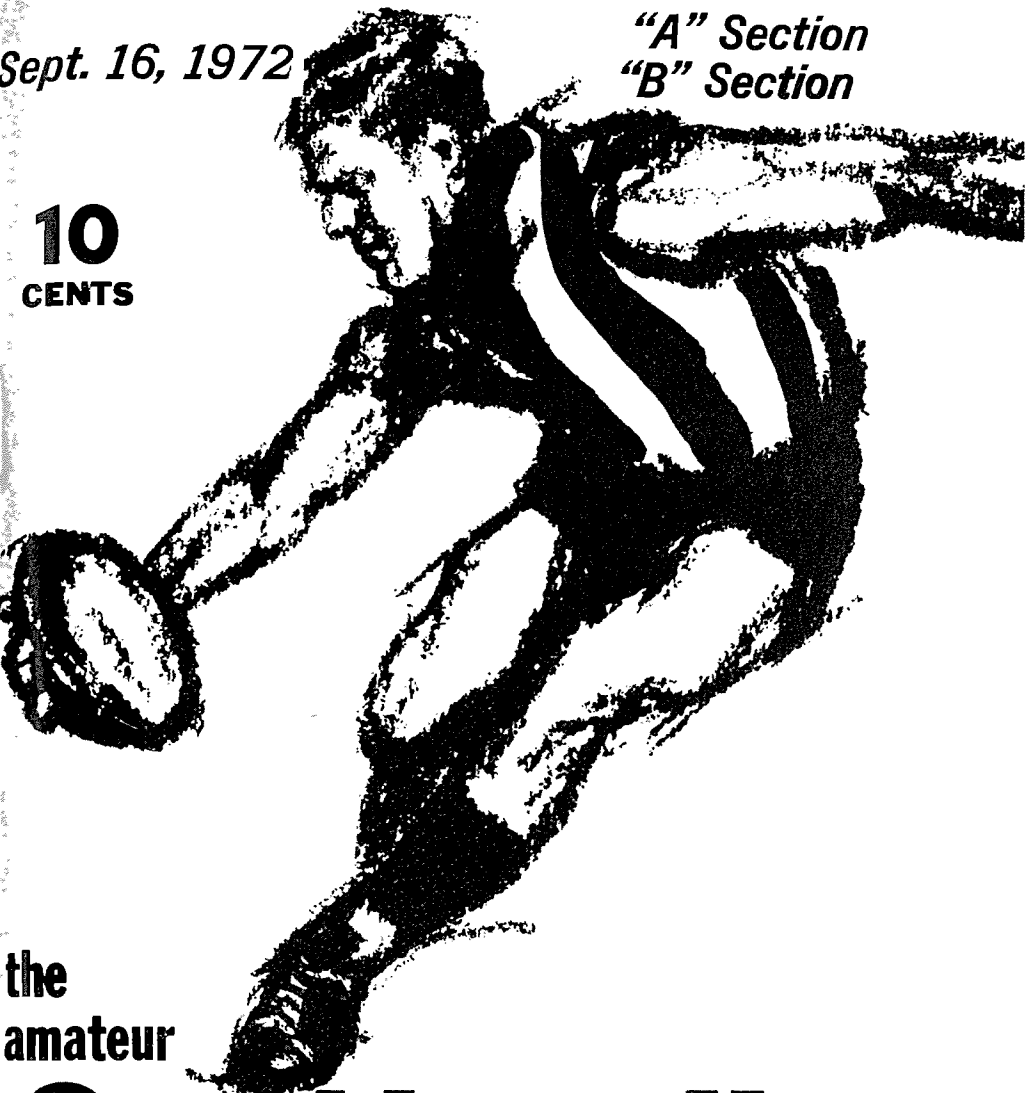

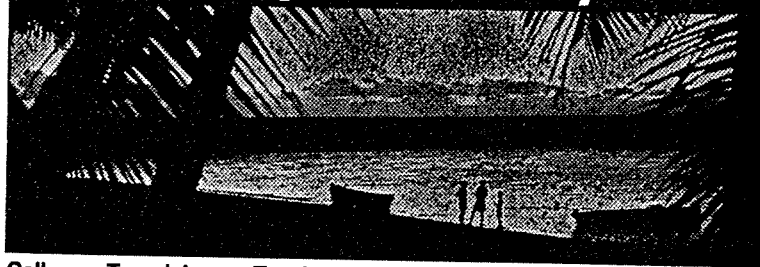

PARADE WIN THROUGH TO GRAND FINAL CAULFIELD FADE OUT OF PREMIERSHIP FIGHT Black's poor kicking cost them promotion

A burst of four goals in as many minutes midway through the third quarter paved the way for Old Paradians to go on and beat Caulfield Grammarians in the Final last Saturday.

Parade now meet Ormond in the Grand Final today. Both are going for their second successive premierships — Ormond were premiers last season and Parade took the honours in B Section.

Caulfield looked certain winners just before the Parade onslaught, as they led by four goals, but after that they faded right out of the picture and went down by 31 points.

Poor kicking caused the downfall of University Blacks in the B Section Final, and Ivanhoe beat them by five goals, although Blacks had five more scoring shots.

Ivanhoe now meet Geelong in the Grand Final, and both will play in A Section in 1973.

Parade almost kicked themselves out of calculations in the first half — they kicked 1-9 in the first quarter and at half-time had scored only three goals from 17 scoring shots. They added 5-2 in the third term but lapsed again in the last to kick 11 behinds but they also scored five goals.

The bad habit of fading out in the last quarter which Caulfield have acquired in recent matches repeated itself in this game and probably cost them the chance to play in the Grand Final.

They managed only 1-3 in the last quarter with the ball rarely in their attacking zone.

The Blacks kicked 6 behinds before their first goal and when Ivanhoe slammed on 9-3 to 3 points in the second term they had the game well in their keeping, with a lead of 51 points at the interval.

The Blacks continued to miss the target in the third quarter when they scored 4-10 and were still 23 points down at the last change. Ivanhoe finished well and although the Blacks added 5-3, Ivanhoe went on to win comfortably.

After an even first quarter, Reservoir Old Boys raced away from Assumption in the second term when they added 10-4 to 1-1, and were more than 9 goals in front at the interval.

They went further ahead in the third quarter and although Assumption did better in the last, Reservoir ran out easy winners by 46 points, to go through the season undefeated.

Parkside trailed Old Brighton by 14 points at half-time but added 6-5 to 2-3 in the third quarter to have a 2 goal lead at the final change.

They were steadier in a tense last term and held on to score by a point, kicking 3-1 to Old Brighton's 4-6.

Dame Fortune smiled kindly on Parkside who beat Alphington by a point in the last home-and-home match to sneak into the four — and then they won the Grand Final by a point.

State Savings Bank and Marcellin staged an even first half, but Bank gained a winning break in the third quarter when they kicked 5-7 to 2 points and were more than 6 goals in front at three-quarter-time.

They finished well and were winners by almost 8 goals.

Old Camberwell trailed Elsternwick by 3 goals at half-time but staged a much better second half and got home by 7 points. Elsternwick kicked 7 goals in the second quarter but managed only 4-4 in the second half while Camberwell added 8-5.

Old Camberwell also went through the season undefeated.

Except for the third quarter, the St. Bernard's — Power House game in Junior Section 1 was a very even struggle. But in that term, St. Bernard's kicked 4-4 to 2 points and that was enough to bring them victory by 4 goals.

University Blues scored a runaway win over North Old Boys in Section 2. The first quarter was even but then the Blues took charge. They kicked 9 goals in the second term and shot to a 46-point lead and by three-quarter-time were nearly 11 goals in front. This was their winning margin.

In the Reserves, Ormond led Monash Blues by 14 points at half-time but were scoreless in the third term while Monash kicked 5-3 and held Ormond off in the last quarter to win by 15 points.

Geelong proved too strong for Old Scotch and ran out winners by 29 points.

Reservoir Old Boys finished too strongly for St. Kilda CBC and won by 14 points, to give the club a double premiership.

St. Kilda were unbeaten in the home-and-home round but Reservoir beat them twice in the final series.

Parkside also completed a double when they beat Old Geelong by a goal. Old Geelong led by 9 points at the interval but Parkside kicked 4-3

to nothing in the third term and held off a strong last-term bid.

Monash Whites were not troubled by Old Camberwell and won by 15 goals. Monash lost only one game for the season, going down by 17 points to Old Camberwell on July 29th.

And so today the curtain falls on the 1972 Amateur football season — a successful one in many aspects but one marred by the fact that not one week went by without it being necessary to call the Tribunal together to deal with reported players — even in the Finals.

Let us resolve to adopt a slogan similar to that of the Country Fire Authority in 1973, and by playing the game as it should be played — **PUT THE TRIBUNAL OUT OF BUSINESS!**

AFTER 22 YEARS

Geelong, which has saddled up in "B" Section almost continuously since 1951, (the only exception being a one year visit to "C" Section

to win a premiership in 1966), has at last lifted itself back into "A" Section for 1973.

To top a splendid season both "B" Section and "B" Reserves Grand Finals will see Geelong represented today.

Today's game is a highlight in the careers of such players as **Guyon Wilson**, **Ray Wookey**, **Eric Smith**, **Mickey Allden**, **Philip Marshall**, and **Rob Lawler** who all played in the winning "C" Section team. Apart from Wookey, these players were then either first or second year players.

Wilson is now captain and Wookey vice captain.

Guyon Wilson this season finished fourth in the "B" Section best and fairest while **Eric Smith** has experienced certainly his best year — unlucky not to have gained interstate honours. **Wookey** and **Allden** have had their usually good seasons whilst **Marshall** has done well at full-back (in 1966 he was a half forward).

Rob Lawler returned from England mid-season and won back his ruck berth.

Apart from these players senior coach **John Vautier** and Reserves coach **Russell Morris** (both players in that 1966 team too) are to be congratulated on getting their teams in the Grand Final. Now for the big one.

5 Years Ago — 1967

Experience was on the side of Parade as four of their 100 game players, **Fred Proctor, John Tudor, Brian Weyman** and **Bernie O'Brien** had played in their four premierships teams. 10.11 to 10.13 at three-quarter-time, Parade kicked 5.4 to 3.2 in the last quarter to win yet another premiership.

Proctor, Quinlan and **Weyman** were best for winners while **Ward** (5 goals) **Barker** and **Chaffey** were strong players all day for Caulfield Grammarians.

Another notable performance was Ormond Reserves appearing in the grand final for the 7th consecutive year.

Uni Blues 23.12 trounced **North Old Boys** 9.16 to win the 'B' section pennant. **Rovers Rutherford** (9 goals) and **Church** (5 goals) were dominating players while **Elliott** and **Les Murray** battled all day for the losers.

10 Years Ago — 1962

Both clubs in the 'A' section Grand Final were attempting to create history — **Melbourne High** by winning 'A' section premiership and thus becoming first club ever to win premierships in C, B and A in successive years, and **Old Paradians** to win their first 'A' section premiership.

Among those on MHS list of players was "A. Guy" (later of "The Seekers" fame). **Melbourne High Juniors** were attempting to win their third successive premiership.

Well, Old Paradians easily won the big one, 16.14 to 9.9 while **MHS Juniors** 17.10 (with **Green** a star with 10 goals) trounced **Ivanhoe** 5.7.

Stars for Old Paradians were **O'Dwyer, Proctor, Weyman** while for

the losers **Hance, Turnbull** and **Nelson** were best.

20 Years Ago — 1952

University Blues and **Ormond** played the Grand Final at Warringal Park (Heidelberg) in blistering heat. **Ormond** brought in some players from their Junior team but were no match for the **Blues** who won 20.10 to 8.16.

Blues had struck form in the last few games and with the brilliant half-forward line of **Geoff Tunbridge, Mick Eggleston** and **Geoff Dahlenburg** in control and champion **Duncan Anderson** (6' 4") at full-forward kicking 11.1, they went right away in the last quarter scoring 9.1 to 1.2.

Coburg, 2 points in front at three-quarter-time, kicked 3.9 to a goal in the last term, to defeat **Elsterwick** for the 'C' section premiership.
