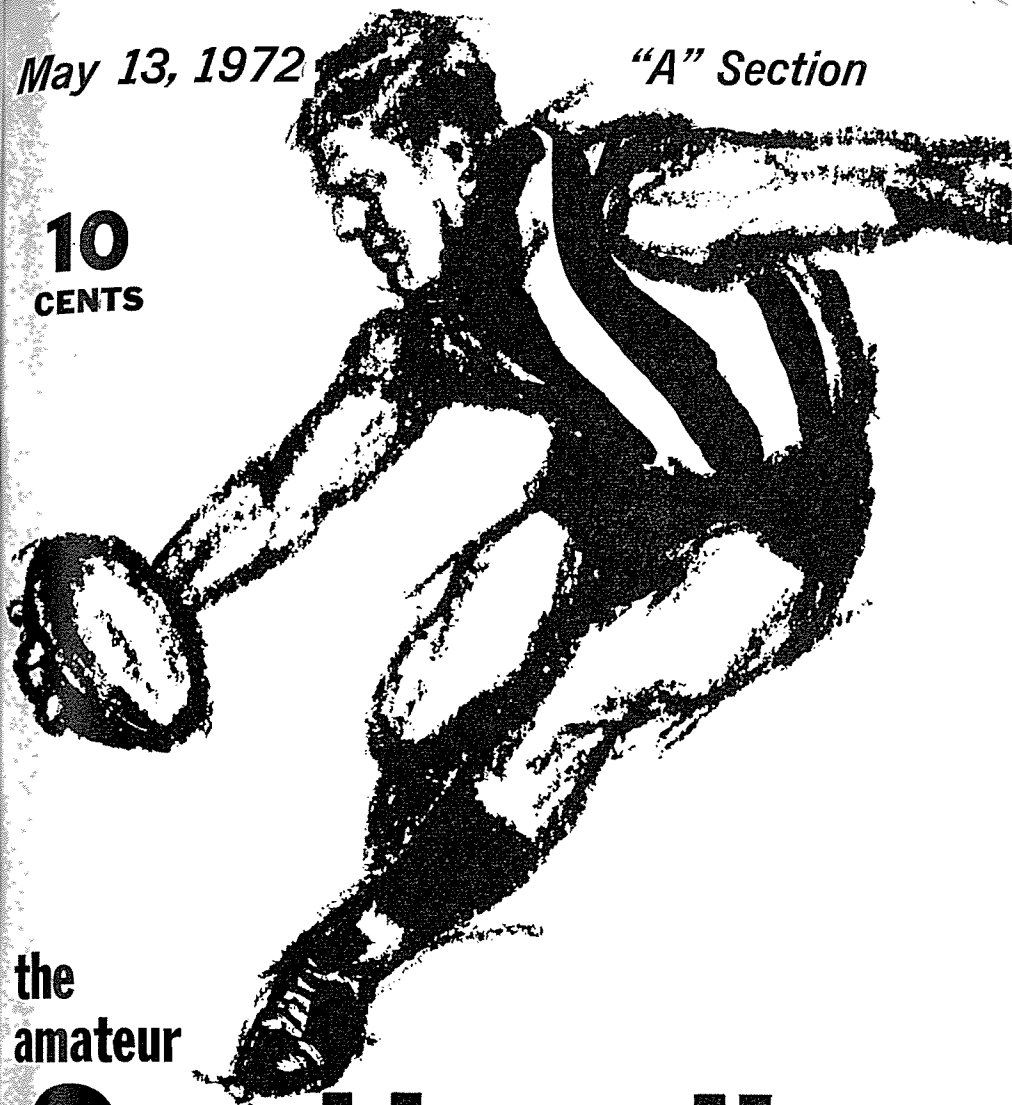

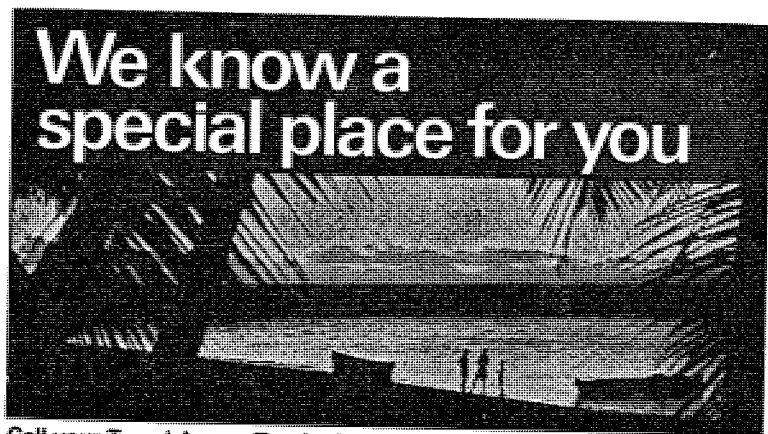

# COBURG CRUSH OLD PARADIANS

## NORTH SCRAPE HOME FROM UNIVERSITY BLUES

### High Scoring in Perfect Weather

High scoring was the order of the day last Saturday, when perfect weather conditions prevailed — in fact, it would have been ideal for cricket — and no fewer than 47 teams scored centuries, including 19 in the Reserve sections. Of this 47, three kicked more than 200 points.

Coburg made amends for their defeat by North Old Boys the week before when they crushed the previously unbeaten Old Paradians by no less than 74 points.

Caulfield Grammarians, Ormond and North Old Boys maintained their unbeaten record, but North were a little lucky to beat University Blues by 11 points.

A little more steadiness on the forward line in the closing stages could easily have won the game for the Blues, despite the fact that they had played a mid-week match against Monash Blues, and were sadly depleted by injuries.

The game was fairly even throughout with North on several occasions looking likely to go right away, but the tenacious Blues fought back well each time.

Coburg ran away from Parade after an even first quarter, and had a 6-goal lead at the interval. The second half was of much the same pattern with Coburg winning in nearly every position.

St. Bernard's greater pace enabled them to gain an early lead over De La Salle, who never looked likely to trouble their opponents and St. Bernard's ran out easy winners by 15 goals.

Better team-work and greater determination gave Ormond the opportunity to take a commanding lead over Melbourne High in the second term and they went on to score by over 10 goals.

Caulfield Grammar were much too strong for Monash Blues, their aerial power and penetrating attack giving them a big win.

Greater accuracy in front of goal was the main factor in Old Trinity's narrow 6-point win over Collegians. Ivanhoe proved far too strong for Old Carey, who went down by almost eight goals.

After poor shooting for goal in the early part of the game, Geelong suddenly found the target and kicked 11 goals in the last quarter to score a big win over Tooronga-Malvern. Old Scotch overwhelmed Kew and University Blacks had a percentage-boosting win over Uni. High.

The first draw of the season occurred in C Section, where Old Xavierians (17-13) tied with Assumption (16-19). Strangely enough, even though it was a high-scoring day, this is the only match in which both teams recorded a century.

Reservoir Old Boys scored a big win over Old Haileybury, and St. Kilda CBC opened their winning account at the expense of Old Melbourne. Power House and Fairfield were the other winners.

Three of the D section games were close — Alphington beat St. Pat's by 2 points, Brunswick beat Parkside by 5, and Old Brighton beat Old Geelong by 2 goals.

Glenhuntly, who conquered Marcellin the previous week, were well beaten by AJAX going down by 33 points. Old Ivanhoe beat AMP Society by 16 points, and State Savings Bank, despite shocking kicking (7-25) won easily from ANZ Bank, to retain top place.

North Brunswick beat Monash Whites by 7 points, St. Bede's beat Dookie and Longerenong by 13 points and Old Mentonians crashed badly against Elsternwick.

Old Scotch scored narrowly from University Blacks in Junior Section 1, the margin being 5 points. Monash crushed Parkside and St. Bernard's, Ormond and Power House won easily.

Coburg won by 5 points from Caulfield Grammar in Section 2, and University Blues and North Old Boys kicked the huge scores of 39-26 and 39-25 respectively.

There were some close results in the Reserves — Monash Blues beat Caulfield by 5 points, Old Geelong beat Old Brighton by 2, and Old Camberwell beat La Trobe Reds by three. Several other games were decided by less than two goals.

## UMPIRES CORNER

### INTERPRETATIONS OF SOME CONTENTIOUS LAWS

It should be emphasised that umpires should have a common sense outlook on free kicks.

#### **Holding Law —**

The law dealing with holding the man — holding the ball — provides that the player who is in possession of the ball, must kick or handball the ball when **firmly held** by an opponent.

If he fails to kick or handball the ball, a free kick shall be given against him for **holding the ball**.

**Note:** Firmly held means when the player is gripped firmly enough to **stop or retard his progress**.

Umpires must give the player who is in possession of the ball a reasonable chance to dispose of it, before free-kicking him.

(a) If a player is in the act of kicking or handballing and he is swung off balance and his foot or hand does not connect with the ball — play on.

(b) If a player is bumped and the ball falls from his hands — play on.

(c) When a player has the ball held to his body by another player — ball-up.

(d) When a player is knocked on the arm or elbow causing him to drop the ball — play on.

(e) When a player has his arms pinned to his sides, causing him to drop the ball — play on.

(f) The spirit of the rule is to keep the ball in motion.

**Note:** If a player is held by one arm whilst he retains possession of the ball with the other — holding the ball.

The main thing to bear in mind is this — if the player shows by his actions that he is trying to dispose of the ball when he is held — let him do it.

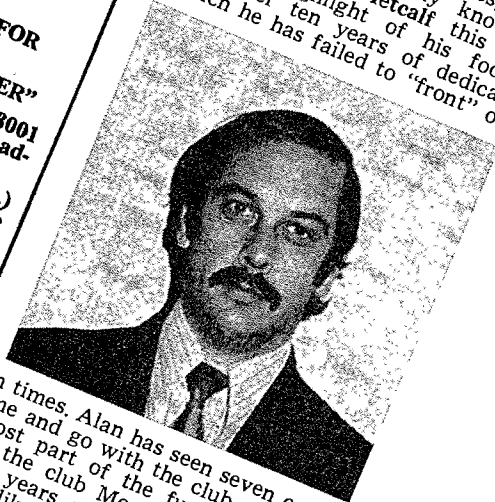
