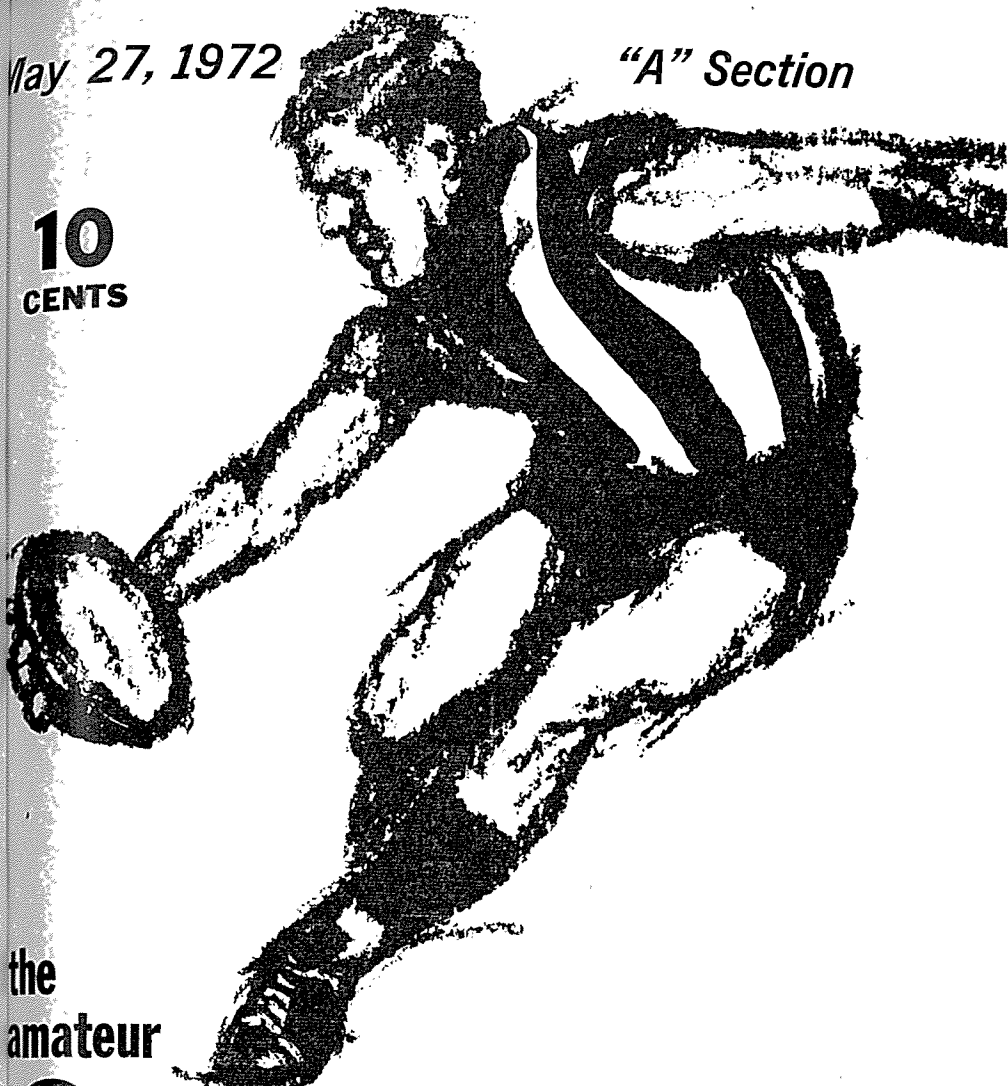

ANOTHER FORM REVERSAL BY COBURG 8-GOALS IN SECOND TERM STOPS CAULFIELD *Parade Trouble Ormond — North Crash*

Coburg staged yet another reversal of form to score a 43-point win over Caulfield Grammarians last week. It was Caulfield's first defeat.

The week before, Coburg put up a miserable performance against Ormond and went under by more than 16 goals. Before that they trounced Old Paradians after being well beaten by North Old Boys.

Ormond, the only unbeaten side now, had to struggle to take the points from Parade — only their straighter kicking saved them. North were all at sea and finished 10 goals behind St. Bernard's.

Geelong went to top place in B Section with a good win over Old Scotch.

It was Coburg's brilliant second quarter burst that gave them the game. They kicked 8-3 in that period and held Caulfield scoreless. Caulfield could not handle the slippery conditions and their high fliers were unable to function effectively.

There was little between Ormond and Parade, with Ormond leading by only 10 points at half-time. Parade crept up to within a point at the final change but Ormond's overall strength and marking ability finally enabled them to take control and win by 25 points.

A 6-goal burst against the wind in the second quarter gave St. Bernard's a good lead over North Old Boys, and St. Bernard's raced away to win by 10 goals. North broke down badly in the forward division.

De La Salle kicked 7 goals in the second term to gain a 2-goal lead over Melbourne High, but High fought back after the interval and held De La Salle off to win by 14 points.

Ivanhoe caused an upset when they thrashed Old Trinity by nearly 15 goals. Ivanhoe's poor kicking left them only 10 points in front at the interval but they rattled on 9-2 to a goal in the third term and virtually settled the issue.

Kew trailed Old Carey by 3 goals at half-time, but Carey faded badly in the second half, when Kew added 12-2 to 3-6 and won by more than 5 goals. University Blacks were 17 points behind Tooronga-Malvern at the half-way mark but were much too strong in the second half and won by 23 points.

Geelong's more accurate kicking explained the magnitude of their 6-goal win over Old Scotch, for the game was much closer than that. Their 9-1 in the second half gave them a total of 17-8 to 10-14.

Collegians were not really troubled by Uni. High and ran out easy winners.

Old Xaverians surprised the previously unbeaten Power House, and led all the way to score by 31 points, while Fairfield were too strong for National Bank and doubled their score.

Brunswick beat Hampton Rovers by 10 points in an even game and Old Geelong beat Alphonston by 2 points, thanks to a 5-goal burst in the last term. Footscray Tech. opened their account with a 7-point win over St. Kevin's, whose strong finish just failed.

Old Brighton opened up an early lead over La Trobe Blacks and were nearly 8 goals in front at the finish.

After leading by only 4 points at the interval, Old Ivanhoe drew away from Glenhuntly in the second half to win by nearly 7 goals. West Brunswick and ANZ Bank were engaged in a close struggle, with West being the winners by a point.

Another leading team to "bite the dust" was State Savings Bank who went down to Marcellin by 29 points. Marcellin won it in the first quarter when they kicked 9-10 to nothing.

After an even first half, Old Camberwell finished too strongly for St. Bede's, kicking 6 goals in the last quarter to win by 25 points. Monash Whites opened up a big lead over Old Mentonians in the first term and won by a big margin.

Eight goals in the second quarter gave St. Bernard's a big lead over Monash University in the Junior Section, and they kicked another nine in the last for good measure. Ormond struggled against Old Scotch, but their 6 goals in the last quarter gave them a 9-point win.

In Section 2, University Blues forged ahead of Coburg in the second half to score by 26 points, while North Old Boys overwhelmed Caulfield Grammar. Old Brighton did the same to AJAX.

Highlights of the Reserve Section games were Geelong's 2-goal win over Old Scotch and Power House's 41-point margin over Old Xaverians. Old Geelong overwhelmed Alphington, State Savings Bank beat Marcellin by 4 points (10-4 to 8-12) and Monash Whites beat Old Mentonians by 14 points.

UMPIRES CORNER

KICKING OFF FROM BEHIND

When a behind has been scored, unless a subsequent free kick has been given **ANY** player on the defending side shall kick the ball from within the **kick off** lines and when the ball is being kicked off, no player of the opposing side shall be allowed within 10 yards of the kick-off lines.

NOTE: If such player handballs the ball over the kick-off line, the field umpire shall stop play and direct the player to kick off in accordance with this law.

If an opposing player attempts to delay play, by moving to or standing within 10 yards of the kick-off line, the field umpire shall direct the defending player to kick-off in accordance with this law and shall report the offending player. No other penalty for attempting to waste time shall be awarded.

The ball shall not be kicked off from behind until the flag has been waved by the goal umpire.

The ball shall be kicked clear of hand and foot and once kicked shall be deemed to be in play.

If this law is not fully complied with by being clear of hand and foot, (merely touched on the foot) the field umpire shall bounce the ball as provided for in law 14D.

If a player will not kick (time-on being added) when directed to do so by the field umpire, a free kick shall be awarded to the nearest opponent and the umpire shall report such offending player for wilfully wasting time.

If the player kicking runs beyond the kick-off area before kicking, the field umpire shall stop play and bounce the ball in accordance with law 14D.

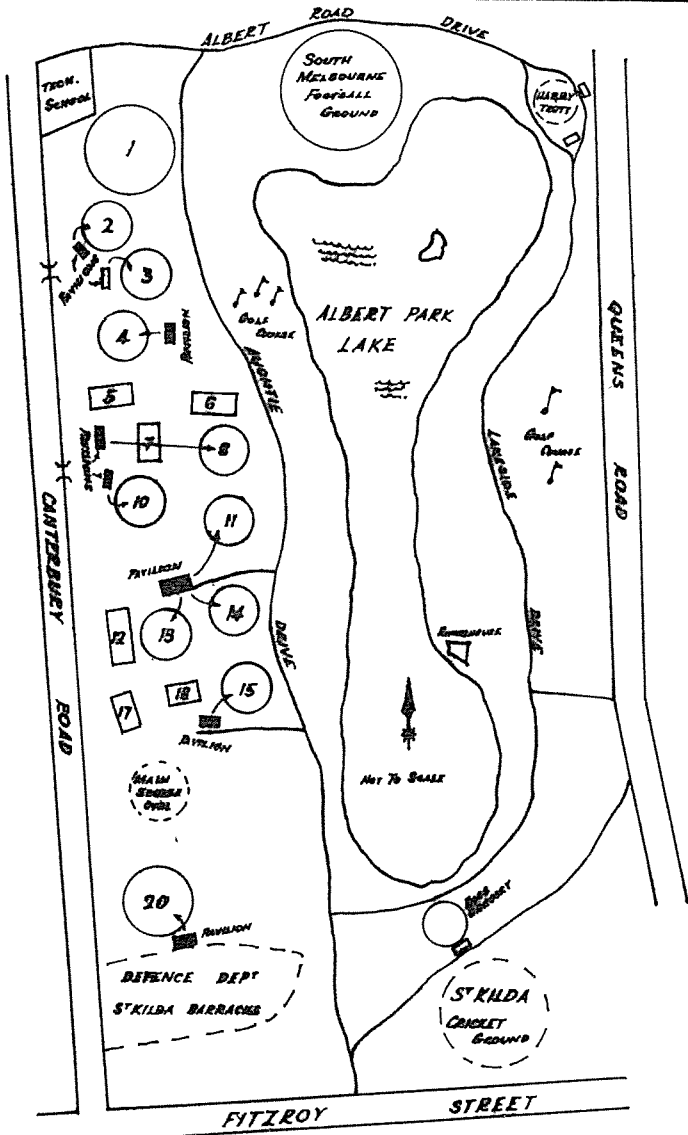
