ORMOND MAKE IT NINE IN A ROW COBURG DOWN TO ST. BERNARD'S IVANHOE BREAK THE ICE

Ormond completed the cycle of beating every team in turn when they finished 23 points to the good against North Old Boys last Saturday.

It was Ormond's ninth win in succession — their only defeat for the season heing by North in the opening round.

St. Bernard's beat Coburg by a goal in a game that was close all day, and moved up to second place. Coburg's defeat tumbled them out of the four.

Ivanhoe, after troubling some of the leading teams in recent matches, finally broke the ice at Geelong's expense. They won by seven goals.

Ormond hopped off with 7 goals in the first quarter to gain a 4-goal lead over North, and North never recovered. Ormond kicked another 7 goals in the third term to lead by almost 8 goal's but North came back well in the last quarter.

Ormond's backing-up was a feature of their play and their good field kicking was another factor in their win.

The evenness of the Coburg-St. Bernard's game can be seen from the fact that Coburg led by a goal at the end of each of the first three quarters, but they managed only 3 points in the last and St. Bernard's kicked 2-3 to gain the points.

Ivanhoe broke away from Geelong when they added 7.4 to 2.4 in the second quarter and were in a sound position at the interval with a 34point lead. Geelong did a little better in the second half but made no impression on their big leeway.

The back lines were on top in the first half of the University Blues-Caulfield Grammar encounter, with Caulfield edging to a 17-point lead at the interval after an even first term. | the game at Elsternwick Park, going

Caulfield took charge in the third quarter and were more than 8 goals in front at one stage. But the Blues hit back with 2 goals just before threequarter-time, and another three in quick time in the last gave them a chance of pulling it off, but Caulfield steadied and won by 31 points.

It was even for the first half of the Old Paradians-Monash Blues game, then Monash broke clear in the third term and went to a 5-goal lead. But Parade fought back to within 2 points at the last change. That was the end of it for them though, and Monash finished on well to win by more than 6 goals.

University Blacks scored a 57-point win over Old Carey and knocked them out of the four in doing so. Blacks went in to replace them.

Kew thrashed Old Scotch and Reservoir did the same to Melbourne High. Collegians had more than 5 goals to spare from Assumption and Old Trinity beat De La Salle by 23 points.

Old Melburnians put up a disappointing display against Parkside in

down by nearly 12 goals. Power House beat Fairfield by only a goal while bottom team, National Bank, surprised Old Haileybury, beating them by 23 points.

Marcellin had an easy win over Commonwealth Bank, whose accurate shooting for goal (12.1) was a feature of the game.

AJAX beat Glenhuntly by only 3 points and AMP Society scored from Footscray Tech by a similar margin. It was a good effort by Tech., who have not won a match. Old Camberwell easily beat Elsternwick and Old Ivanhoe had little trouble in disposing of West Brunswick.

Monash Whites lost top place in F Section when they went down to Old Mentonians by 22 points. Fawkner, who scored by nearly 8 goals from LaTrobe Reds, are clear leaders.

Junior Section leaders, University Blues, had only 14 points to spare from Ivanhoe (14.23 to 14.9). North Old Boys crashed against Ormond, going down by 45 points.

In Section 2, Beverley Hills scored easily from Old Brighton, but Parkside beat West Brunswick by only 15 points.

PERMITS CLOSE SOON

Applications for permits for season 1973 will close with the Records Secretary of the V.A.F.A. Mr. Bruce De Lacy, 67 Charman Road, Mentone, 3194 on July 1st.

The only application considered after that date will be that of a player affiliated with a club in the amateur body of South Australia, Western Australia or Tasmania, who is transferred to Victoria in his employment, or a National Serviceman who returns to Victoria.

A player who has played with a club in the V.A.F.A. this season, and has subsequently played with another club, must stand down for two matches before being eligible to play for his V.A.F.A. club again.

In a case such as this, the date on which he last played with the other club must be shown on his permit application.

Re-registration of a player whose permit is still in force, that is, a player who has not played with any other club since he last played with the club with which he is seeking re-registration may be made at any time up to the last home and home match.

UMPIRE'S CORNER

- Answers to queries by coach 9.6.73 1. Shepherding in the ruck is an infringe-ment of the rules and should be penalised.
- 2. A player on or over the ball is deemed to be in possession of it, and if tackled correctly should be penalised for "holding the ball"

NOTE! If the player over the ball is making a deliberate attempt to get rid of the ball, but is unable to do so, it would be "ball up".

would be "ball up". 3. This query refers to an injured player in the centre square, at the time of bouncing the ball after a goal has been scored.

This rule as laid down by the Australian Football Council is quite clear. Four players only from each team are

allowed in the centre square at time of

allowed in the centre square at the or bouncing the ball after a goal. But — if a player is so badly injured that he is unable to be moved without the aid of a stretcher, etc., the umpire would use common sense and allow time for such injured player to be taken out of the square and removed from the ground.

BOUNDARY UMPIRES

It is your duty as an umpire to strictly police the centre square when the umpire is about to bounce the ball after a goal, or

at the start of each quarter. Do not be afraid to give your decision if more than four players from each team are in the centre square.

TIMEKEEPERS

You should sound the bell or siren until the field umpire has heard it, and has signalied that he has heard it.

Last week a time keeper sitting in a motor car rang a bell and play went on for at least 20 seconds during which time a goal was scored. Do not blame the field umpire. Keep ring-

ing the bell.




