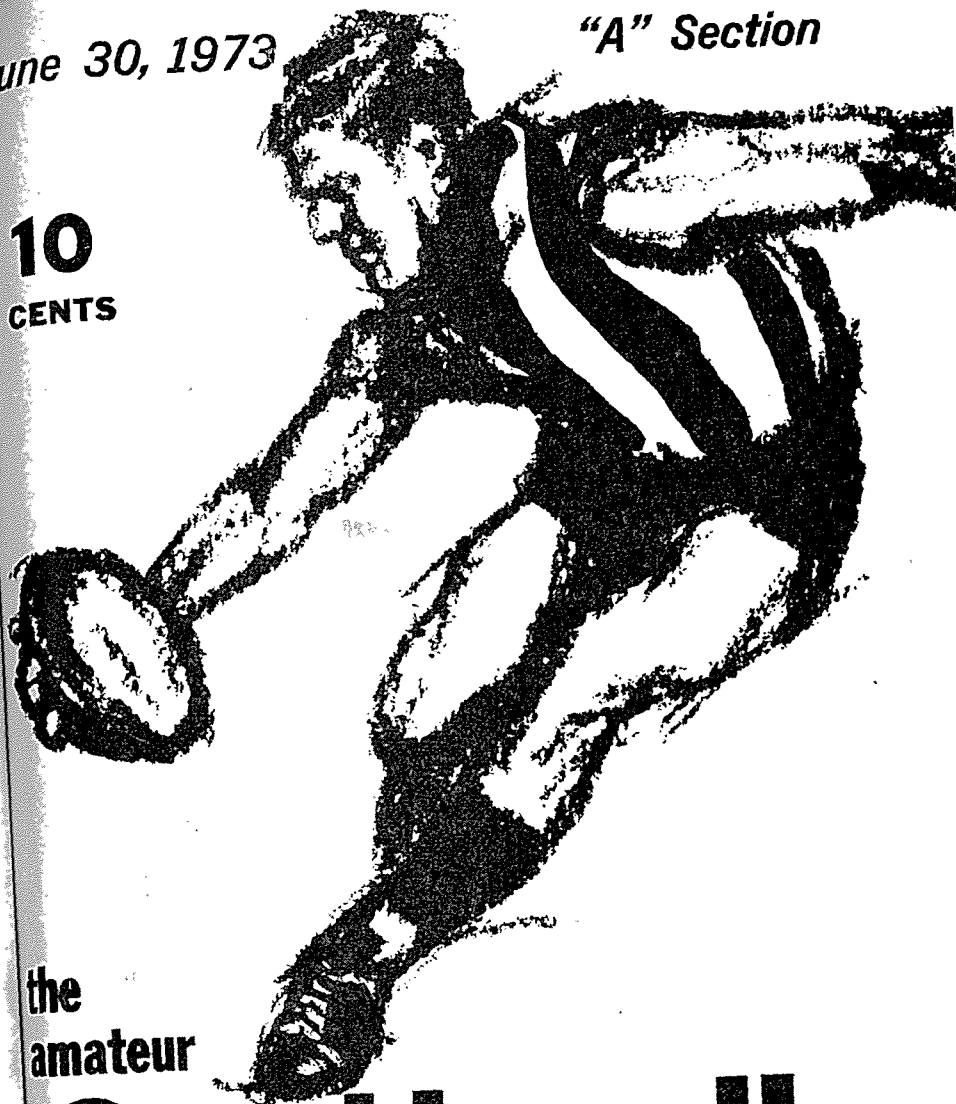

COBURG FAIL AGAINST ORMOND

NORTH HOLD CAULFIELD OFF

Many games won by goal or less

Coburg lost their third game in succession when they were well beaten at Ormond last Saturday. They went down by 41 points.

Caulfield Grammarians failed to finish on against a determined North Old Boys and were beaten by 31 points, but they held their place in the four.

The strong wind made scoring more difficult than usual and only 16 teams topped the century. There were several examples of shockingly inaccurate kicking but on the other hand some teams kicked remarkably well — Ormond Juniors 26.12, Coburg Juniors 20.11, Parkside Reserves 18.8 and Marcellin Reserves 19.5. University Reds kicked 5 goals without scoring a behind.

There were some close finishes, particularly in the lower sections. No fewer than 11 games were decided by a goal or less, the difference in two of them being a solitary point.

Ormond held Coburg to only one goal in the first quarter and although they missed many opportunities with the wind in the second term, they kept Coburg scoreless and ran to a lead of 25 points at the interval (4.14 to 1.7).

Coburg improved a little in the third quarter but Ormond were "sitting pretty" at three-quarter-time when they led by 5 points. Ormond finished on strongly to add 7 goals in the last term and won easily.

North Old Boys took full advantage of the first quarter wind and kicked 6 goals but Caulfield hit back in the second and trailed by only a goal at the interval.

North's positive, determined play took them to a 35-point advantage at the last change and they kept Caulfield down to 2 goals in the final quarter to score a comfortable win.

Poor shooting for goal may have cost Old Paradians the game at Geelong, where they were defeated by 14 points. Geelong led only narrowly

at half-time (4 points) but Parade had had twice as many scoring shots.

Monash Blues were in command against University Blues throughout and won by 23 points, while St. Bernard's were too strong for Ivanhoe and raced away with a 9-goal burst in the last quarter.

University Blacks scored a convincing win over Old Trinity, the margin being 33 points. Trinity dropped from second to fourth. Old Carey beat Old Scotch by 4 goals and Collegians beat Kew by the same margin.

De La Salle had 31 points to spare from Melbourne High and Reservoir Old Boys easily accounted for Assumption.

Power House scored by a goal from Old Brighton in a low-scoring game, and National Bank ran the leaders, Parkside, to a similar margin, while Uni. High beat St. Kilda CBC by 7 goals. It might be more correct to say that St. Kilda beat themselves, for they kicked shockingly (2.14).

LaTrobe Blacks scraped home by 2 points from St. Kevin's, and Marcellin had only 11 points to spare from Hampton Rovers. State Savings Bank, Alphington and Marcellin still share the lead in D Section, three games clear of St. Kevin's (fourth).

All games in E Section were close — Footscray Tech. ran AJAX to 2 points, Elsternwick beat ANZ Bank by 3 and Old Ivanhoe (leaders) went down to Old Camberwell by 4 points, and lost top place to them also.

In the other game, AMP Society beat West Brunswick by 11 points.

Monash Whites beat University Reds by 2 goals and Fawknor won by 40 points from St. Bede's.

In Junior Section matches Monash University went down to North Old Boys by 16 points and Old Scotch scored a big win over Power House. Parkside pipped Beverley Hills by 2 points and Old Brighton went down to Caulfield Grammar by 7 points, while Coburg overwhelmed Old Paradians.

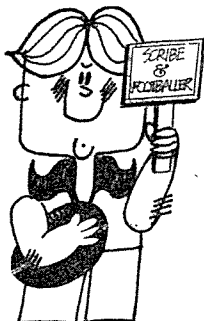
Ivanhoe scored a surprise win over St. Bernard's in the Reserves, but only by a point and North Old Boys beat Caulfield by 2 points. University Blacks easily beat Old Trinity, Old Melburnians beat Old Xaverians by one point also, and Old Haileybury easily accounted for Fairfield.

Marcellin swamped Hampton Rovers to take top place from them. Alphington won well from Old Geelong and LaTrobe Blacks easily beat St. Kevin's. Old Ivanhoe beat Old Camberwell by 4 points.

PERMITS CLOSE TOMORROW

Applications for permits for season 1973 will close with the Records Secretary of the V.A.F.A. Mr. Bruce De Lacy, 67 Charnman Road, Mentone, 3194, tomorrow, July 1st.

The only application considered after that date will be that of a player affiliated with a club in the amateur body of South Australia, Western Australia or Tasmania, who is transferred to Victoria in his employment, or a National Serviceman who returns to Victoria.

A player who has played with a club in the V.A.F.A. this season, and has subsequently played with another club, must stand down for two matches before being eligible to play for his V.A.F.A. club again.

In a case such as this, the date on which he last played with the other club must be shown on his permit application.

Re-registration of a player whose permit is still in force, that is, a player who has not played with any other club since he last played with the club with which he is seeking re-registration may be made at any time up to the last home and home match.

Secretaries are advised that applications must be lodged in person. Any posted will not be received in time.

UMPIRE'S CORNER

HOLDING THE BALL — HOLDING THE MAN RULE

This law is quite clearly defined and should not cause any worry to players or umpires if it is remembered that the spirit of the law is to keep the ball in motion.

1. If a player is bumped and the ball falls from his hands — Play On.
2. If a player is in the act of kicking or handballing and he is swung off balance, and his foot or hand does not connect with the ball — Play On.
3. When a player is knocked on the arm or elbow causing him to drop the ball — Play On.
4. When a player has his arms pinned to his sides, causing him to drop the ball — Play On.
5. When a player is pulled by one arm and swung and the ball falls from his hand — Play On.
6. When a player has the ball held to his body by another player — Ball Up.
7. A player in possession of the ball, when held by an opponent firmly enough to stop him or retard his progress, should be given a reasonable chance of disposing of it by kicking or handballing, otherwise it is holding the ball — Free Kick.

This must surely be a record for goals scored in one quarter.

Last Saturday Coburg Juniors kicked 13 goals straight during the second quarter. A few seconds before half time they scored their only behind for the term.

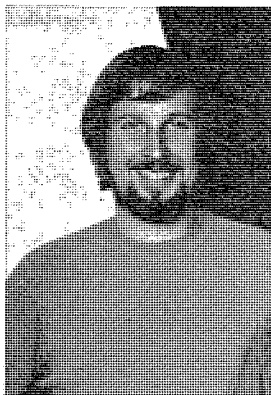
