BLUES' SHOCK WIN OVER ORMOND ST. BERNARD'S FINISH ON TO BEAT NORTH Carnival next week — Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday

University Blues scored a surprise win over leading team, Ormond, in last Saturday's round, ending Ormond's run of ten successive wins.

St. Bernard's held second place on the premiership list with a sound win over North Old Boys, who could not match St. Bernard's finishing effort.

The 12th Australian Amateur Football Carnival will be staged at the Melbourne Cricket Ground next week — on TUESDAY, THURSDAY and SATURDAY.

Two matches will be played each day between the four competing states — VICTORIA, SOUTH AUSTRALIA, TASMANIA and WESTERN AUSTRALIA — commencing at 11 a.m. and 1.45 p.m. on Tuesday and Thursday and 11.30 a.m. and 2 p.m. on Saturday.

The Blues started slowly but when they settled down they matched it with Ormond except in front of goal where they continually fell down. This inaccuracy was the only reason for their 3-point deficit at the interval, for they were outmarking and outplaying Ormond generally.

But they improved in the third quarter and kicked four goals straight to be only a point down at threequarter-time. Their accurate passing worried Ormond who really fell down in the final quarter, when they kicked only 10 behinds, many from deliberate shots. The Blues added another 4 goals in this term and won by 14 points.

North Old Boys had most of the play for three quarters against St. Bernard's, but petered out in the last term and were beaten by 28 points.

North had trouble getting through their opponents' defences, although they hit back in the third term with 7 goals after trailing by 25 points at the interval and were a goal ahead at three-quarter-time. But St. Bernard's kicked 6.3 to 5 points in the last quarter.

Geelong put in a poor first half and were 39 points behind Coburg at the halfway mark. They made up some ground after that but Coburg held on to score by 25 points.

Ivanhoe and Monash Blues were engaged in an even game with Ivanhoe holding on a little better to win by 7 points.

Old Paradians hopped off with a 2goal lead over Caulfield Grammarians, but then Caulfield slammed on 4 goals in 5 minutes and went right away to win by 11 goals.

Old Trinity lost their place in the four when they were soundly beaten by Reservoir Old Boys, and Old Carey, with a 14-point win over De La Salle, are back in the top bracket.

University Blacks beat Kew by 19 points, Collegians scored by a comfortable margin over Melbourne High and Old Scotch beat Assumption by 7 goals.

Old Melburnians scraped home from Old Haileybury by 2 points but Parkside, Old Brighton and Power House all won easily.

Commonwealth Bank drew with St. Kevin's, whose poor kicking cost them the game (12.22 to 14.10) and Hampton Rovers pipped Brunswick by 2 points, while Alphington's win enabled them to climb to the top of their list.

ANZ Bank caused an upset when they beat AJAX by 7 points and West Brunswick ran Elsternwick to 9 points. St Bede's beat University Reds by 10 points and Old Mentonians went down to North Brunswick by 21 points.

In the Juniors, University Blues beat North Old Boys by 16 points and Monash beat the Blacks by 6 goals while the four leading teams in Section 2 were successful.

Among the Reserves, St. Bernard's beat North Old Boys by 2 points, Reservoir easily beat Old Trinity, Parkside beat St. Kilda CBC by 20 points and Old Xaverians beat Old Brighton by 2 points. Marcellin beat Old Geelong by 28 points and AMP scored easily from Glenhuntly.

It is to be hoped that all clubs will give their fullest support to the Carnival, by attending on the final day next Saturday, at least. Those of you who are able to attend on the other days as well are urged to do so.

Admission is 70 cents and tickets are available from your club. These tickets will admit on any day. Children accompanied by an adult will be admitted free, and the charge for unaccompanied children will be 40 cents. Use No. 2 Entrance, Northern Stand.

Ample car parking space will be available, adjacent to the M.C.G.

PARKSIDERS 250



Once again congratulations Norm - go on and make the record for games one that will take a lot of beating.




ALPHINGTON PLAYER BREAKS CLUB RECORD


