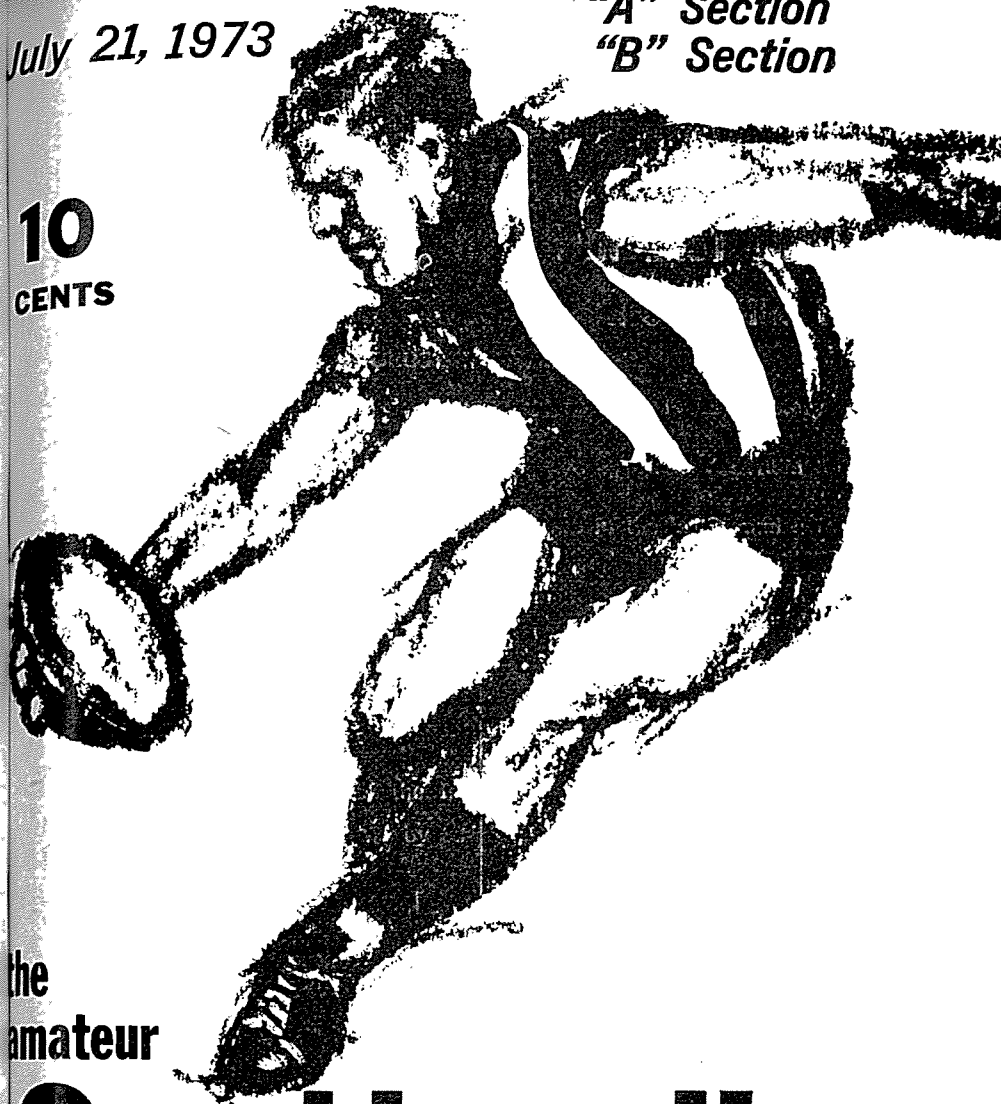

# THE CARNIVAL IS OVER — AND SOUTH AUSTRALIA WON IT

## SHOCKS ON LOCAL SCENE IN LAST ROUND

### Fight for the fours tightens with 5 rounds to go

The Twelfth Australian Amateur Football Carnival is now history — and it created such a lot of history too.

It was won, and won very convincingly too by South Australia to whom we offer our congratulations.

There were some shocks on the local scene in the last round a fortnight ago, especially in B Section, where three of the top four were beaten, all of all of them by teams outside the four.

South Australia showed on the first day of the Carnival that they would be a hard side to beat and they were much more impressive in the games against Tasmania and Western Australia than the Victorians.

South beat Tasmania by 114 points, while Victoria's margin over the Island State was 80 points. The West went down to South Australia by 96 points whereas Victoria beat them by 45 points.

In the final, Victoria kicked themselves out of it with a shockingly inaccurate 7-18 to South Australia's 12-10, giving South a win by 22 points.

Actually, on their play, Victoria didn't deserve to be as close as that, but had they kicked straight in the second half particularly, they could have won it.

They kicked 4-13 in this period, and in addition, many shots went out of bounds.

In the last round of local matches, Monash Blues had the better of things in the first half against Caul-

field Grammarians in the first half, and led by 9 points.

But they slumped after the interval, adding 4-3 in the second half, while Caulfield kicked 10-8 and won quite comfortably by 32 points.

St. Bernard's were not greatly troubled by University Blues, although their inaccurate shooting in the first half kept the Blues in the game.

Coburg had quite a battle at Ivanhoe in the first half but forged ahead after the interval to score by 26 points.

North Old Boys got an early lead over Geelong who fought back well and held north to a 23-point margin.

Ormond, even without their five State representatives overwhelmed Old Paradians, who however rallied to kick 5 goals in the third quarter.

Reservoir Old Boys led De La Salle by 17 points at half-time but "De La" hit the front in the third term and held on to win by a goal, and cause a major upset.

A 5-goal burst in the third quarter after an even first half gave Melbourne High the lead over Old Scotch, and they ran out winners by 16 points.

Kew raced away from Old Carey in the third quarter to score by nearly 7 goals and Old Trinity were a shade too strong for Collegians and won by 14 points.

St. Kilda CBC surprised Old Melbourne, who went down by 34 point and Parkside raced away from Old Brighton to score an easy win. Old Xaverians beat Fairfield by 27 points in a high-scoring game.

Alphington's 6-goal burst in the second quarter and again in the last were big factors in their 37-points win over State Savings Bank.

Old Geelong surprised St. Kevin's when they slammed on 6 goals in the last term to win by 25 points. Marcellin finished well to beat St. Pat's by 31 points.

Elsternwick's poor kicking caused their 10-point defeat by Footscray Tech, who opened their account for the season.

A.M.P. Society were in trouble against AJAX early, but finished well to win by 9 points.

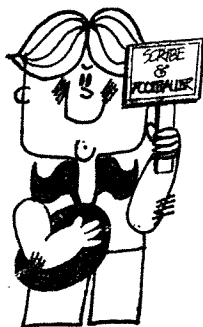
Fawknor and Monash Whites played a draw — but Monash should have won it — they had five more scoring shots.

La Trobe Reds beat St. Bede's by 11 points in a very even game.

There was also a draw in the Juniors — Power House and Monash University being the teams involved.

Hampton Scouts opened their account with a 5-point win over Ivanhoe.

Fairfield upset Old Paradians in Section 2, winning by 21 points, and Parkside kicked a huge score (40-28) against National Bank.

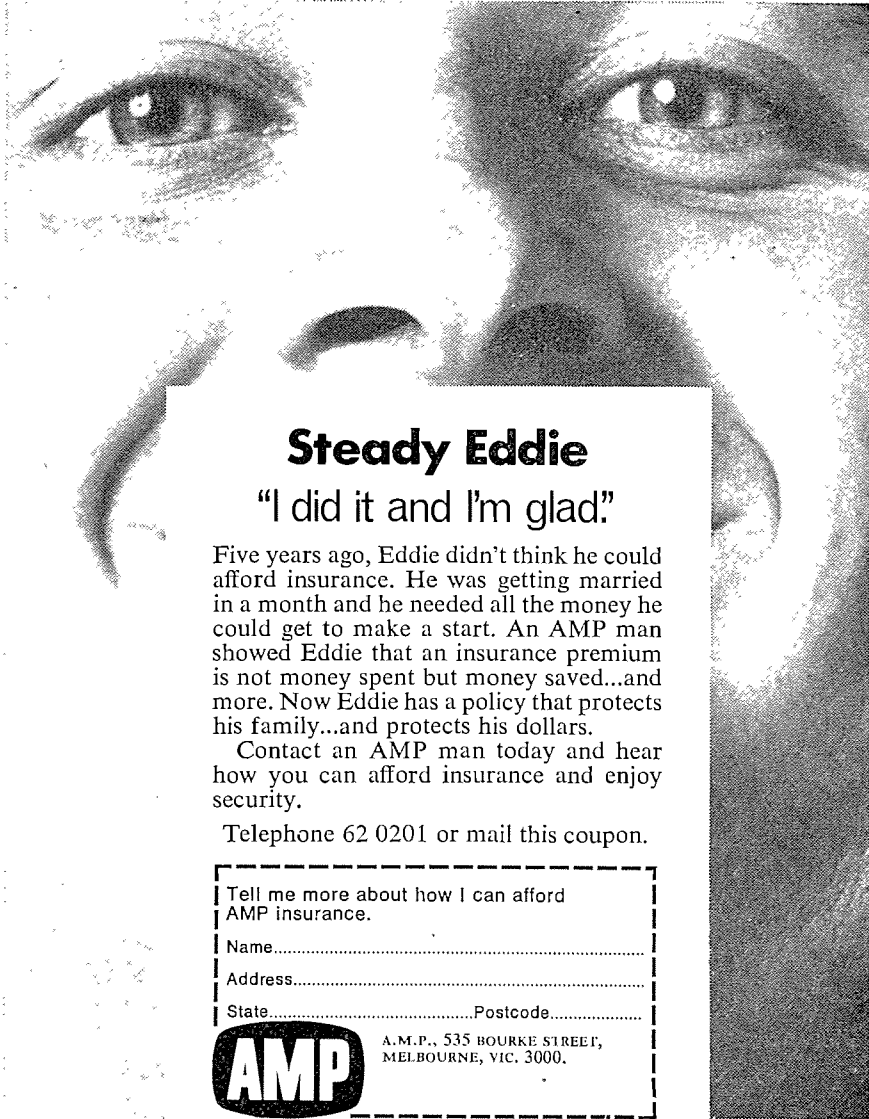

# THE CARNIVAL — AND HOW SOUTH AUSTRALIA CREATED HISTORY

- South Australia's Carnival win created history in many ways.
- It was the first time they had won a Carnival other than at Perth, where they have won two — in 1948 and 1970.
- It was the first time they had won two successive Carnivals — but they still have a long way to go to beat Victoria's run of seven consecutive Carnival wins — from 1951 to 1967 inclusive.
- It was the first time a South Australian player had won the Best and Fairest Medal at a Carnival — their Vice-Captain, Paul Rofe, was the winner.
- It was the first time Victoria had been beaten in a Carnival match in Melbourne.
- It was Victoria's lowest score ever in a Carnival match.
- It was the first time South Australia had beaten Victoria in Melbourne for 36 years — their only other win in Melbourne being back in 1937 at St. Kilda Cricket Ground.

South Australia opened the Carnival with a run-away win over Tasmania, their pace, handball and effective forward work being features of their play.

South started slowly and led by only 8 points at quarter-time but forged ahead to a comfortable 32-point lead at the interval.

From then on, it was just a question of how much they would win by. They slammed on 9 goals in the third quarter and 8 in the last to win by 19 goals.

Victoria got away well against Western Australia and after leading by 11 points at the first change, went on to a 40-point advantage at the half-way mark.

The West had not made the most of their opportunities, compared to the home side, who were playing well.

Victoria continued to dominate the game in the third term, adding 7-5 to 2-2 and were more than 12 goals in front at  $\frac{3}{4}$ -time.

But it was a vastly different Western Australia from the start of the last quarter. They got 2 quick goals and continued to finish on well, while the Victorians could do nothing to stop them.

West Australia kicked 6-2 to 1-4 in

the final term but Victoria were winners by 45 points.

On the second day Victoria were not really troubled by Tasmania after the first quarter and ran on to an easy win.

They added 6 goals in the second quarter to hold a commanding lead of more than 7 goals and at  $\frac{3}{4}$ -time were just over 10 goals in front.

But the Vic's faded again early in the last term as Tasmania rallied. Then they settled down and rattled on 7 goals for the quarter to Tassie's 5 in a real scoring spree.

Tasmania showed much better form than they did in the opening match and played with a lot more spirit and determination.

South Australia ran to a 5-goal lead over Western Australia in the first quarter and kicked 9-2 to 4-2 in the second to be exactly 10 goals in front at the interval.

West's fumbling and poorly-directed handball marred their efforts and South coasted to a 16-goal win.

But Western Australia made sure of giving the "wooden spoon" to Tasmania with a burst of 8 goals in the second quarter of the early match on Saturday. This gave them a lead of 8 goals at half-time.

Apart from this quarter, the game was very even, and Tasmania were unable to make up any ground in the second half, finally going down by 56 points.

Victoria started brightly in the deciding match against South Australia, kicking 3 goals in the first few minutes.

But South Australia quickly made up for their slow start, and gradually pegged Victoria back, gaining a narrow lead just before quarter-time.

The second term was a disastrous one for the home state as they managed only 3 points while South put on 4-2 and held a very handy 25-point advantage at the interval.

Another goal to South early in the third term meant that they had kicked 8 goals without Victoria scoring a major.

Then Victoria hit back with 3 goals — their handball and passing working well for them and they cut South Australia's lead to 11 points.

But their success was short lived as South swung into action for 2 more goals and a lead of 21 points at ¾-time.

Victoria had plenty of opportunities but hurried kicking for goal let them down. They had added 3-7 to South's 3-3.

Victoria had the chance to make up the leeway in the last quarter as South Australia appeared to be tiring, but the Vic's continued to waste scoring opportunities.

South Australia hung on well and were winners by 22 points.

**Their loose-man tactics, effective use of handball and excellent passing had proved too much for Victoria, and South really deserved their win.**
