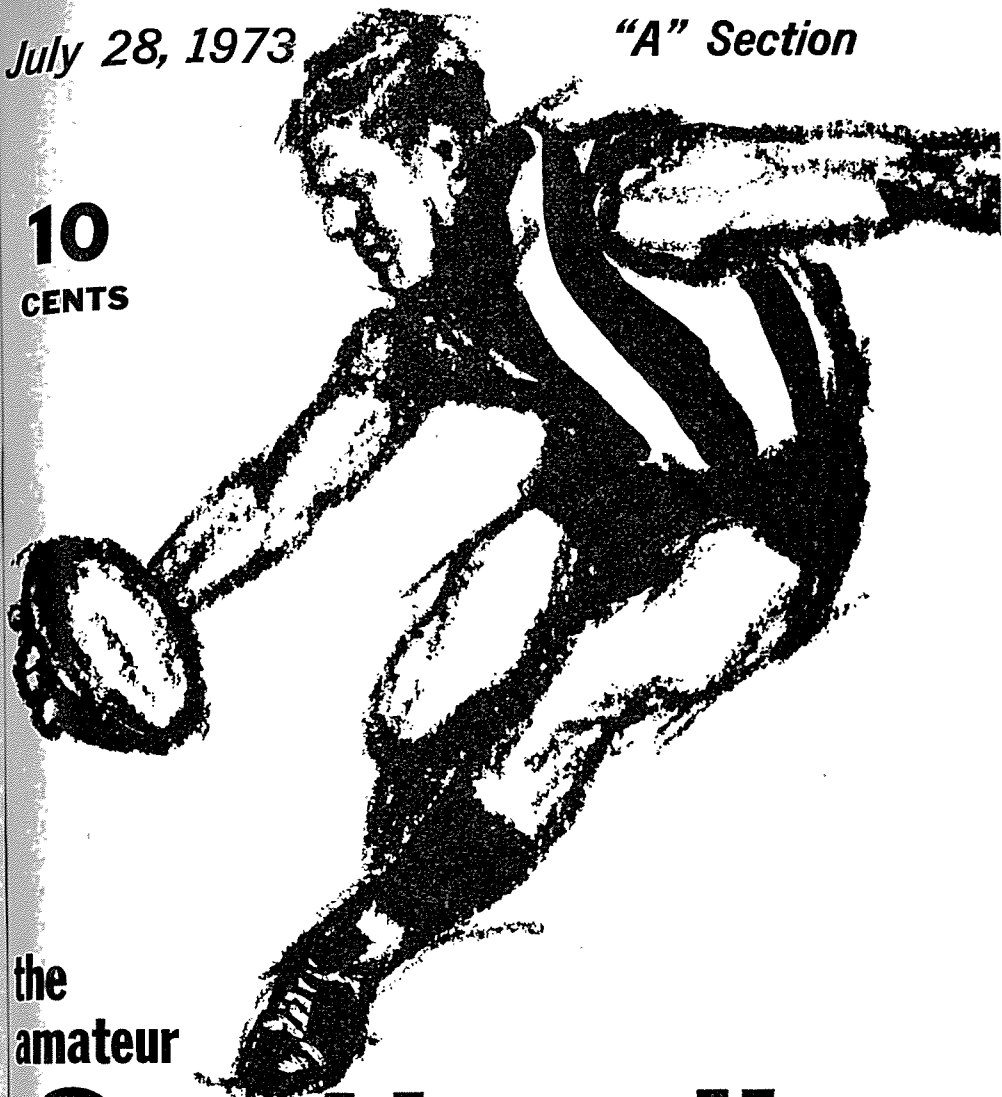

# Parade's Shock Win Over St. Bernard's Ormond's First Quarter Beats Caulfield Gramm. University Blues Draw With Coburg North Old Boys Pressed by Ivanhoe

Bottom team Old Paradians scored a shock win over equal leaders St. Bernard's in one of several upsets in last week's round. Parade led all day and won by 26 points.

A great first quarter by Ormond, in which they kicked seven goals, was more than Caulfield Grammarians could cope with, and although it was even after that Caulfield went down by 26 points also, and lost their place in the four.

Coburg could manage only a draw with University Blues, on their own ground too, but it was enough to lift them into fourth place.

Ivanhoe gave North Old Boys a lot of trouble and it was only in the last minute or so that North really broke clear to score by 19 points.

Parade were on top in the ruck and were more determined than St. Bernard's. They ran to a lead of more than 5 goals at half-time and held on well to win comfortably.

Ormond's opening burst gave them a lead of 33 points at quarter-time but after that it was goal for goal in a great exhibition of football.

Each side added 6 goals in the second term and in the third Caulfield kicked 6 goals straight to Ormond's 5.2.

University Blues' big men handled the shocking conditions at Coburg much better than did the locals small brigade, and drew with the home side in a very even low-scoring match (8.6 each).

Coburg led by 2 goals at quarter-time but the Blues put on 4.2 to 1.2 and were a goal in front at the interval.

Coburg edged away to a 2-point lead at the last change and in a battle of the backlines in the final term, kicked the goal to level the scores in the last two minutes.

There was never more than a

couple of goals between North Old Boys and Ivanhoe until just before the finish when North gained the upper hand.

North led by 7 points at quarter-time but Ivanhoe kicked 6.1 to 4 goals in the second term to be a goal up at the interval (10.3 to 9.3) and the scores were level (15.6 each) at three-quarter-time. North spoilt their accuracy in the last quarter by adding 3.7.

It was goal for goal for most of a very entertaining match.

Six goals in three minutes in the third term gave Geelong the break on Monash Blues and another 7 goals in the last ensured an easy win for them.

Collegians suffered their second successive defeat when they were beaten by Reservoir Old Boys, the margin being 22 points.

Old Trinity, who beat Collegians in the previous round, failed by 23 points against Old Scotch and lost their place in the four. Old Carey's easy win over Assumption taking them back into the top bracket.

Kew easily beat Melbourne High and University Blacks had 31 points to spare over De La Salle.

Old Brighton also lost their second in succession, this time at the hands of Old Melburnians by 28 points. Uni. High surprised Power House, whose poor kicking had a lot to do with their 2-goal defeat.

St. Kilda CBC easily beat Fairfield and National Bank had a big win over Old Xaverians in a high-scoring affair.

Marcellin scored by almost 8 goals from State Savings Bank but LaTrobe Blacks had only 7 points to spare over Commonwealth Bank, and Old Geelong ran Hampton Rovers to 4 points.

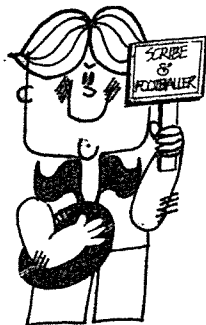
Elsternwick beat AMP Society by 3 goals, A.M.P.'s poor kicking contributed to their defeat. Leaders Old Ivanhoe thrashed AJAX, which must have dented their hopes of making the four.

North Brunswick scored a surprise 8-goal win over St. Bede's, and Dookie & Long ran University Reds to 8 points, while Old Mentonians put up a fight against Fawkner, who won by 26 points.

In the Juniors, University Blues scraped home from Monash by 4 points and Old Scotch beat St. Bernard's by 39 points. In Section 2, Coburg suffered their first defeat, going down to Fairfield by 33 points, while AJAX beat Old Brighton by 3 points. Parkside had 44 points to spare over Old Paradians.

There were a couple of interesting ones in the Reserves, too. Ormond and University Blacks, both unbeaten, could only manage draws — Ormond with Caulfield Grammar and the Blacks with De La Salle.

All at Ormond were deeply saddened at the death of Dennis Drum, a former great player and Captain of the Club in 1963. Dennis also played for University Blacks and Old Xaverians before joining Ormond and he represented Victoria. Greatly respected by all who knew him. Our sympathy is extended to his widow Julie and family.

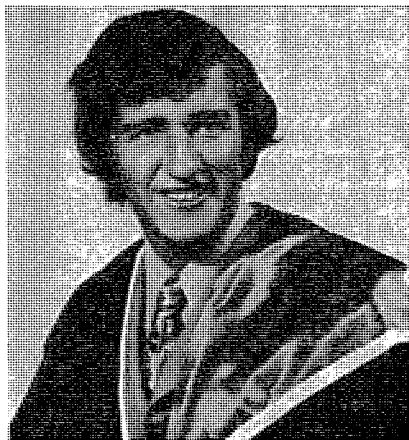
Every team visiting Geelong was lavish in their praise of hospitality extended — Bruce Wemyss was president.

# CLUB HISTORIES

## ST. BERNARD'S — PROUD RECORD IN SHORT HISTORY

A further phase in the history of St. Bernard's Old Collegians Football Club was commenced in 1973 with the opening of the first stage of our Club Rooms. Work on stage two is hoped to be commenced in 1974.

The completion of this work will see another milestone in the short history of a club which has enjoyed great success since our entry into the V.A.F.A. in E Section in 1963.

The first committee was led by Kevin Tobin, President; Bob Perrett, Treasurer; and Peter Nathan, who helped in the formation of the club by doing all the early work with Jim Overman as Secretary.

On the field the club was led by Geoff Tobin, with Jack Kent as Coach and all were rewarded by being Premiers in E Section in 1963.

The effort of a Premiership in the first year was made unique by the Reserves, with Rex Doran as Captain-Coach, also winning the flag. The same combination was successful in 1964 when St. Bernard's captured the D Section flag.

In 1968 with "Duffy" Plummer, of Essendon fame, as coach and Jack Tyrrell and Peter Atkinson as President and Secretary respectively, the club gained promotion to B Section and in their first year finished a creditable third.

In this same year a further development of the club was made by the forming of an under 19 team, and in their first year, with former club best and fairest winner in Gus Mitchell as Coach, and with present senior player John Fox as Captain, the team won the Junior Section 2 Premiership.

Over this period the Reserves with senior player Mick Perrett as Coach, had the unfortunate distinction of one third and four times runner-up.

With the retirement of "Duffy" as Coach, the club saw fit to appoint Junior Coach, Gus Mitchell as Senior Coach and he had instant success, for with Gary Amott as Captain, the club gained promotion to A Section, in 1971 and in their first year were beaten by the ultimate premiers Ormond in the Final.

When the club reached the top grade Mick Perrett resigned as Reserves Coach to concentrate on playing, and the newly appointed Captain-Coach, Brian Cusack had immediate success by winning the A Reserves premiership.

The Juniors, under Coach Rex Doran, with Gerard Mahoney as Captain, were successful in capturing the Junior Section 1 Premiership in 1972.

Over these successful years our first Captain Geoff Tobin was President with Mick Arnold as Secretary and John Lawless as Treasurer.

Many have contributed to the success of the club but none more than the College principals in Brothers Collopy and Chappell who have allowed the Old Boys the use of the College Oval and facilities throughout their history.

The club has also been well served by numerous long-time supporters and helpers such as "Mac" McCartney in the early years, Tom Sharkey and present Vice-President and hard worker Bob Merrick. Present Captain Gary Amott, Mick Perrett, and John Perrett, who played while still at school, have been with the club since its inception and Gary and John are expected to play their 200th games early next year, whilst Mick became the first player to do so recently. Present Coach, Gus Mitchell was also a member of the 1963 and 1964 Premiership sides and so has been connected with the club throughout its history.

All connected with S.B.O.C. have a great pride in the achievements of the Football Club to date, and all those committee men and helpers already mentioned, plus many others, have played a vital part.

However, games are won on the field and without the players already mentioned, coupled with such fine players as Brian Mahoney, ex-Essendon; Frank McCartney, Victorian Amateur; David Collins, later Essendon; Tony Hanneberry, Victorian Amateur; and present Williamstown; Kevin Coughlan, later Brunswick; Gerald Foley, John Sharkey, Charlie Overman, Ron Hancock, Paul Collins; Victorian Amateur players John Crennan, Mick Glinivan, David Burgin and Greg Wade, now Collingwood, and present stars such as All Australian Amateurs Mick Mahoney, and Peter Aughton, and present Reserves Coach John Harvey, coupled with many others the aim of the club to win an A Section flag would have no chance of realization.

However, along with first year President, Des Smith, and an extremely active and hard working committee, all are hoping for this success in 1973.
