

CAULFIELD GRAMMARIANS, COBURG FAIL MEET TODAY TO DECIDE FOURTH PLACE *Collegians lose 3 in row, Kew in four*

Caulfield Grammarians and Coburg both failed in important matches in last week's round, and their meeting at Elsternwick Park today will almost certainly decide which one of them plays off in the finals.

Caulfield were swamped by St. Bernard's last quarter burst which yielded 7-4 to 1-1, and gave St. Bernard's a 6-goal win; while the third quarter proved Coburg's downfall — North Old Boys kicking eight goals in this term and running out winners by 17 points.

Kew have made a remarkable rise in the last three weeks; before that they looked to have very little chance of making the four, but three wins in succession coupled with three defeats to Collegians have lifted Kew into third place, with the Wesley boys dropping to fifth.

Caulfield and St. Bernard's staged a very even game for three quarters, but Caulfield failed to finish on and were soundly beaten.

A fortnight previously they went down to Ormond also due to a lapse in one quarter — in that case it was the first, as Ormond kicked 7-3 to 2 goals.

There was nothing between Coburg and North in the first half with each side scoring in bursts, North kicking 3 quick goals just prior to the interval to snatch a 3-point lead.

Coburg opened the third term with 2 goals then North took charge and rattled on 8-goals to lead by 32 points at the final change. Coburg battled hard to bridge the gap but the North backs held firm and kept Coburg down.

Monash Blues stayed with Ormond for the first half and a burst of 7 goals in the third quarter gave them a 10-point lead, but Ormond finished too strongly, adding 8 goals in the last term to win by 19 points.

Old Paradians built up a 29-point lead over Ivanhoe at half-time and held on to win by 2 goals, lifting themselves out of the relegation zone.

Ivanhoe had the chance however, but kicked only 8 behinds in the last

quarter — Parade were also goalless, adding 5 points.

The Geelong-University Blues game also had a goalless last quarter — Geelong kicked 4 points and the Blues one. Geelong won by 13 points in a low-scoring encounter.

De La Salle scored a surprise win over Collegians, knocking them out of the four. The margin was 26 points. Old Trinity's more accurate kicking played a big part in their 13-point win over Old Carey. They kicked 18-12 to 15-17.

Old Scotch put up a good effort against Reservoir Old Boys, kicking 16-10, but they were beaten by just over 7 goals. University Blacks and Kew scored big wins over Melbourne High and Assumption respectively.

A 12-goal burst in the third quarter enabled Fairfield to down Parkside by 25 points and St. Kilda CBC finished too strongly for Old Brighton to win by 26 points. Poor kicking by Power House left them winners by only 11 points over Old Xaverians.

Alphington gained a 27-point break on Marcellin in the second quarter and ran out winners by 23 points. St. Kevin's stayed with State Savings Bank for the first half but Bank were too strong after that and won easily.

Hampton Rovers trailed Commonwealth Bank by 2 goals at the interval but ran away in the second half to score by more than 8 goals.

Elsternwick inflicted a crushing defeat on Glenhuntly, kicking 31-14 (200 points). They kicked 12 goals in the third term. Old Ivanhoe also scored a big win, at the expense of AMP Society.

LaTrobe Reds beat Monash Whites by more than 6 goals and North Brunswick beat Fawkner by more than 7 goals, while Dookie scored a 7-point win over Old Mentonians.

In the Juniors, University Blacks surprised the Blues, who went down by 44 points, and Ormond beat Monash University by 32 points.

ARRANGEMENTS FOR FINALS

Clubs taking part in the final series must arrange between themselves the following:—

(d) EACH CLUB MUST PROVIDE ONE NEW BALL, the winners to have first choice of balls after the game.


(e) EACH CLUB MUST PROVIDE a Goal Umpire's Coat (laundered).

ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS FOR RESERVE AND JUNIOR SECTION FINALS

The attention of clubs is drawn to the restrictions which apply concerning players eligible to take part in Final matches in the Reserve and Junior Sections.

The Rule relating to eligibility of players in Reserve Section Finals now reads:—

A player who has been a member of a senior team of any club in nine or more matches during the home-and-home matches in any season shall not be eligible for inclusion in the reserve team of a club taking part in a final match in the same season unless both the senior and reserve teams are participating in a final match on the same day.

Provided that no player shall be eligible for inclusion in a reserve team taking part in a final match in any season unless such player has been a member of such reserve team in at least TWO home-and-home matches during the said season.


JUNIORS

A player who has been a member of a senior or reserve team in more than five matches during any season shall be ineligible for inclusion in a junior team taking part in a semi-final, final or grand-final match in the SAME SEASON UNLESS he has been a member of the junior team for more than five matches in the same season.




