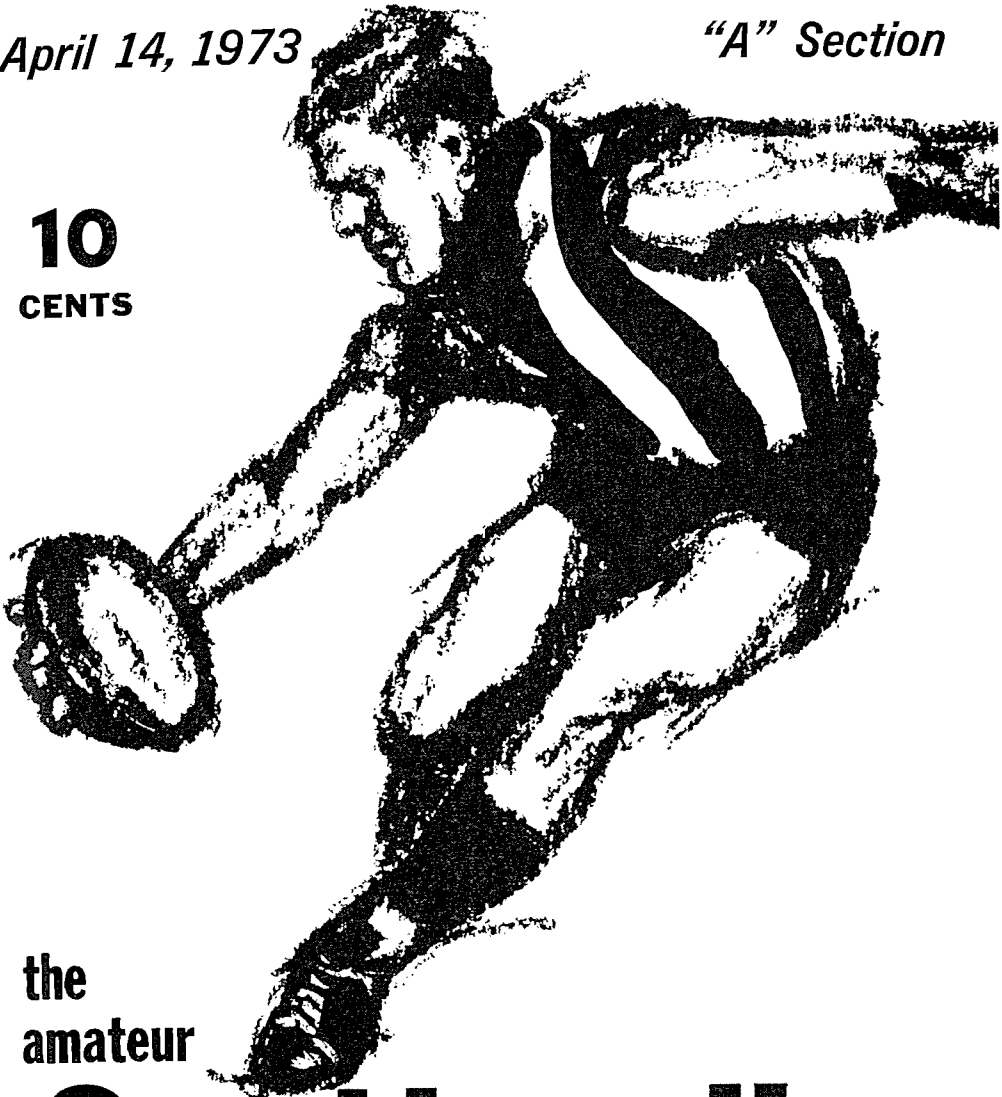

SHOCK DEFEAT FOR '72 PREMIERS

ORMOND CRASH AGAINST NORTH OLD BOYS

Parade extended by Monash

Last year's premiers, Ormond, suffered the indignity of defeat after unfurling their premiership pennant, in the biggest upset of last Saturday's opening round.

North Old Boys cleared out in the third quarter to establish a winning lead and held Ormond off to score by 29 points.

And runners-up, Old Paradians, had a hard battle with Monash Blues before emerging victors by 11 points.

The only other premier team to be defeated was Monash Blues Reserves, who went down to Paradians by nine points.

North Old Boys held a slight edge on Ormond in the first half, and led by 7 points at half-time, but they ran right away in the third quarter and were almost 10 goals in front at the final change.

Ormond fought back in the last term but the gap was too great and North won quite decisively.

Parade were only a couple of points ahead of Monash at the interval, but edged away to a 14-point lead at three-quarter-time. Parade's backline was a big factor in their win as they stood firm against repeated Monash attacks.

Caulfield Grammarians put in a great second half after trailing University Blues by 10 points at the interval. Blues hopped out with 8 goals in the first quarter and led 8-3 to 1-3, and although Caulfield had much more of the play in the second they were well off the target, kicking 5-9 to 1-1.

It was a different, more determined Caulfield which took charge of the game in the third quarter, kicking 8-8 to 5-2 against the breeze in a spectacular term of football.

Caulfield were in a strong position when they led by 14 points at three-quarter-time and they finished all over the Blues, who could manage only a point in the last term while Grammar

slammed on 10 goals to be winners by 80 points.

Geelong raced away from Ivanhoe in the first half to lead by 39 points, and although Ivanhoe finished well to add 7 goals in the last quarter Geelong were 23 points in front at the siren, thus repeating their 1972 B Section Grand Final win.

St. Bernard's and Coburg were locked in a neck-and-neck struggle with the scores level at half-time and three-quarter-time, but Coburg went away in the last quarter and their 7 goals gave them a 35-point win.

Coburg's strong play around the packs helped considerably in their win but St. Bernard's shocking inaccuracy (6-19) contributed greatly to their defeat. They had as many scoring shots as Coburg.

University Blacks and Old Carey were evenly matched for most of the day. Blacks broke away to lead by 4 goals at three-quarter-time and finished 2 goals to the good.

Reservoir Old Boys had an edge on Melbourne High, who kept with them for three quarters, but Reservoir ran right away with a 9-goal burst in the last term to score an easy win.

Collegians also put in a strong finish, against Assumption, and ran out winners by 8 goals, while Old Trinity were too strong for De La Salle and

had a comfortable 34-point margin in their favour.

Kew's accurate kicking kept them in the game with Old Scotch, but Scotch were a little too strong at the finish and won by 20 points.

St. Kilda CBC trailed Old Xaverians by 13 points at the interval, but came home strongly and won by 28 points. Parkside, Power House, Old Brighton and Old Haileybury were the other winners in C Section, and all won easily except Parkside who were pushed to 3 goals by Old Melburnians.

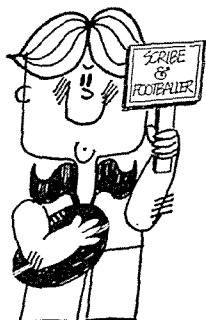
Marcellin made their D Section debut with a 10-point win over Commonwealth Bank but Brunswick, State Savings Bank, St. Kevin's and St. Pat's all won by substantial margins.

Ten goals in the last quarter enabled Old Camberwell to score a good win over Elsternwick and Footscray Tech., despite a burst of 8 goals in the third quarter, failed by a point against AMP Society.

New clubs, Fawknor and Thornbury, each opened with a comfortable win.

New Junior team, Fairfield, led Caulfield Grammar by 17 points at half-time, but Caulfield kicked 6 goals in the third term and won by 4 goals. Parade beat Old Brighton by 15 points.

In the Reserves, Ormond scraped home from North Old Boys by 5 points, Assumption beat Collegians by 2 points after leading by 21 at half-time and Old Geelong beat State Bank by 9 points.

UMPIRE'S CORNER

Hints for boundary Umpires

Our club boundary umpires are a most important function of our game and these loyal officials who week after week "run the boundary" give great assistance to the field umpire and it is with those thoughts I offer the following tips to them.

1. Look an umpire. White shirt, white shorts, black socks and white boots.
2. Be proud of your club and the position you hold.
3. Immediately you get the ball, throw it in.

Do not wait for the rucks to get into position, that's their worry.

Your's is to put the ball into play.

4. After a goal has been scored, rush the ball back to the centre.

5. Never kick the ball — this is unforgivable.

6. Make sure you have a good whistle and blow it hard and loud — also wear a white wrist band.

7. Never argue with your field or goal umpire.

8. When a player is kicking for goal, you should take up a position at the behind post in line with the flight of the ball.

You then command a view to give an accurate decision.

9. The ball is **not out** until it has **completely crossed over the line**.

10. If any portion of the ball is on the line, it is **still in play**; do not be influenced by spectators.

To all boundary umpires — thank you for your great efforts.

Questions and Answers

Q1. When does a time-keeper start the quarter — at the bounce of the ball or the umpire's whistle?

A1. The umpire's whistle is the start of each quarter, therefore a free kick can be awarded before the ball is bounced.

Q2 How does the goal umpire annul a score.

A2 When a score is to be annulled, the goal umpire shall immediately stand in the centre of the goal line and hold both flags above his head in a crossed position.

RESULTS OF MATCHES

Results of amateur matches are broadcast in the Sporting Sessions of Radio Stations 3LO, (commencing at 6.20 p.m.), 3DB and 3KZ (included in 7 p.m. News) each Saturday evening and from Television Channels ABV-2 and HSV-7. Repeat on 3KZ, 9.30 a.m. Sunday. Channel 2 also provides quarter-by-quarter scores of A Section matches each Saturday afternoon.

TIMEKEEPERS' INSTRUCTIONS

REGARDING "TIME-ON"

"Time-on" must be added (1) when signalled by the Field Umpire and (2) when a goal or behind has been scored. In the case of a goal, take the time from the waving of the flag by the Goal Umpire to the bouncing of the ball in the centre by the Field Umpire and, in the case of a behind, take the time from the waving of the flag to the kick-off.

CORRECT SCORES ESSENTIAL

Clubs are reminded that correct scores must be phoned to the Herald office, otherwise a fine (one dollar) will be incurred.

And remember, too, that scores are incomplete without the points — offending clubs will be fined.

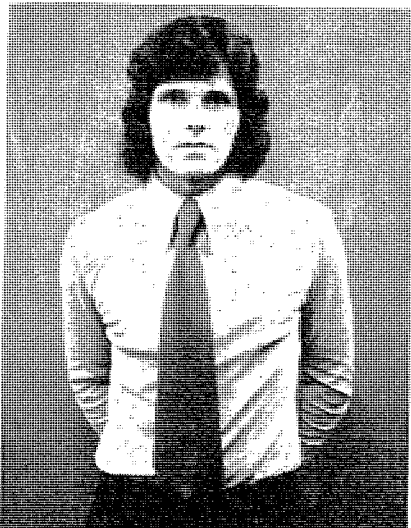
