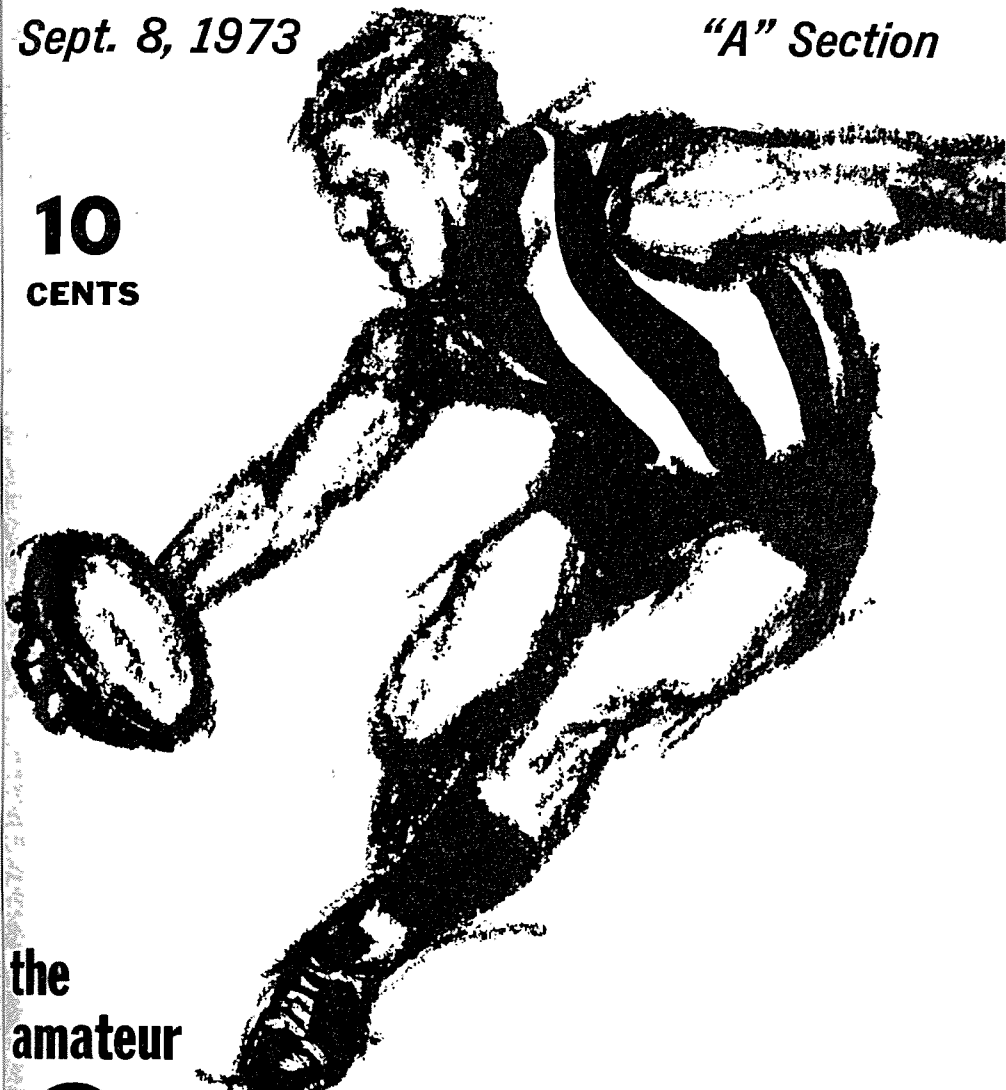

ST. BERNARD'S BEAT ORMOND, GOAL AFTER SIREN RESERVOIR NOT TROUBLED BY UNI. BLACKS *Close finishes in many other games*

St. Bernard's won their way into next week's Grand Final when they beat Ormond in last Saturday's Second Semi-final with a goal kicked after the siren.

After the first quarter, University Blacks were no match for Reservoir Old Boys, who went right away to score by more than eight goals — and gain promotion to A Section next season.

Old Camberwell, with a great second half, beat AMP Society easily, but Fairfield, Marcellin, St. Bede's and the two Junior winners, Monash University and Beverley Hills, had only points to spare.

What a day! Three of the six senior games and both Junior games decided by margins of less than a goal and another by seven points.

One game was won after the siren, two within seconds of the finish and another may have been won on the siren but the kick fell short.

Strangely enough, none of the Reserves games produced an exciting finish, the narrowest margin being Marcellin's 22-point win over St. Kevin's.

Ormond had first use of a strong breeze but were unable to adapt themselves to the wet conditions and made little use of the wind.

With more than half the term gone, Ormond had kicked only 2 goals and when St. Bernard's cut loose to score 3 quick goals, Ormond were in trouble, and they finished the quarter a point behind.

But they played much better football in the second term, holding St. Bernard's to 3 goals and kicking a couple themselves. They were only 9 points down at half-time and still very much in the game.

Ormond forged ahead in the third quarter, adding 5-7 and holding St. Bernard's scoreless, to lead by 28 points at three-quarter-time.

St. Bernard's kept plugging away in the last term, and gradually reduced their deficit until they got within 4 points with about five minutes to play.

Ormond rallied to score a goal and it looked all over, but St. Bernard's got another and then from a free kick awarded only a matter of seconds before the siren, goaled after it, to win by 3 points.

University Blacks led Reservoir by 8 points at quarter-time, due mainly to R.O.B.'s poor kicking (3-3 to 1-7), but after that the Blacks were never really in it.

Reservoir kicked 6-4 to a point in the second quarter and were 31 points up at the interval, and despite 7 behinds straight in the third term, ran out easy winners by 49 points.

Fairfield and Parkside played an even first quarter but Fairfield went to a 2-goal lead at half-time and cleared out to lead by 6 goals at the final change — (8-9 to 2-9).

Parkside, who had kicked only 6 behinds since the first term, put in a determined effort in the last quarter, kicking 4-5 and keeping Fairfield

scoreless, but Fairfield hung on to win by 7 points.

Marcellin edged away from State Savings Bank in the second quarter to lead by 2 goals and were 14 points in front at three-quarter-time. Bank nearly snatched a win in the last minute, but Marcellin scored by 4 points.

Old Camberwell trailed AMP Society by 15 points at half-time, but they added 7-7 to 1-1 in the third term and kicked another 6 goals in the last quarter to run out winners by 47 points.

Poor shooting for goal certainly robbed Monash Whites of promotion, when they had 29 scoring shots (kicking 8-21) to St. Bede's 15, and were beaten by a point.

St. Bede's kicked remarkably accurately in the conditions (11-4) but they scored the winning goal only seconds before the siren.

Monash University trailed University Blues for three quarters in the Junior Section 1 match, but there was never much in it. Monash got to the front in the last term and although the Blues had a chance on the sired, the kick fell short and Monash scored by 2 points.

In Section 2, Beverley Hills cleared out from Parkside with an 8-goal burst in the first term to lead by 29 points, but then kicked only 7 behinds in the second quarter when their advantage was cut to 15 points.

They were still 2 goals in front at the last change, but in a thrilling final quarter, during which the lead changed several times in the last few minutes, Beverley Hills goaled within three seconds of the siren to win by 4 points.

They kicked 5-2 to Parkside's 6-4 in the final term.

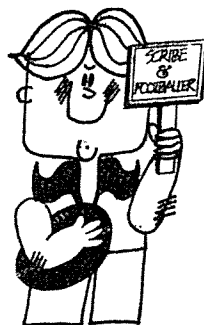
Ormond held St. Bernard's well in the first quarter of the Reserves game and a 6-goal burst in the second term paved the way for them to go on to an easy win.

The re-play between Old Haileyburians and Fairfield, who played a draw the previous week, turned out a real "fizzer", Old Haileybury winning easily (9-12 to 1-5).

Fairfield, Marcellin, Old Camberwell, St. Bede's and Beverley Hills Juniors, who won the Finals in their respective sections, have gained promotion to a higher section next season, along with those who qualified by winning their Second Semi-finals the week before.

Reservoir Old Boys' win in the B Section Semi-final last week also gives them promotion.

The winners of the Kew-University Blacks game today will accompany them to the top grade in 1974.

ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS FOR RESERVE AND JUNIOR SECTION FINALS

The attention of clubs is drawn to the restrictions which apply concerning players eligible to take part in Final matches in the Reserve and Junior Sections.

The Rule relating to eligibility of players in Reserve Section Finals now reads:—

A player who has been a member of a senior team of any club in nine or more matches during the home-and-home matches in any season shall not be eligible for inclusion in the reserve team of a club taking part in a final match in the same season unless both the senior and reserve teams are participating in a final match on the same day.

Provided that no player shall be eligible for inclusion in a reserve team taking part in a final match in any season unless such player has been a member of such reserve team in at least TWO home-and-home matches during the said season.

JUNIORS

A player who has been a member of a senior or reserve team in more than five matches during any season shall be ineligible for inclusion in a junior team taking part in a semi-final, final or grand-final match in the SAME SEASON UNLESS he has been a member of the junior team for more than five matches in the same season.

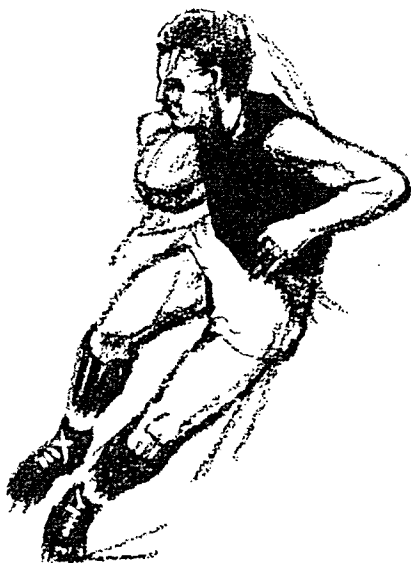
