

GEELONG CRASH BADLY AGAINST NORTH OLD BOYS NORTH MOVE UP TO 2nd, GEELONG OUT OF FOUR Eight teams in first defeat — Three leaders

Geelong suffered their second successive defeat when they put in a poor nerformance against North Old Boys and were beaten by nearly 12 goals.

North's win shot them up to second place on the list — there are five teams sharing top place, with Caulfield Grammarians leading on percentage.

Three leading teams were among the eight which were beaten for the first time last Saturday, and after four rounds only 19 remain undefeated.

Geelong never really looked like beating North, whose better anticipation and backing-up left Geelong floundering. North led in the race for the ball all day, and Geelong seemed unable to do anything right.

North had five goals up before Geelong scored and were 35 points in front at quarter-time. Geelong recovered a little ground in the second term but missed many opportunities and still trailed by 27 points at the interval.

North forged further ahead and held a commanding lead of more than seven goals at the last change, and their 7-goal burst in the final term carried them to an easy win.

Ormond were in a good deal of trouble against Old Paradians until the last quarter, when they slammed on 6.8 to a point and won quite comfortably.

Parade outplayed Ormond in the first half, leading by 11 points at half-time, after keeping Ormond goalless in the first quarter. Parade missed many chances in the third term, which enabled Ormond to keep within striking distance.

Caulfield Grammar were always in command against Monash Blues in a scrambly game, and were in a winning position when they led by 49 points at the break. Monash matched their opponents in the second half but went down by more than 10 goals.

St. Bernard's opened up a 23-point lead over University Blues in the opening quarter, but the Blues fought back strongly in the second term to be only two points down.

The second half was a closely contested struggle but St. Bernard's won by 7 points. They finished better than the Blues but were off the target, kicking only 2 goals from 11 shots in the last term.

A 9-goal second quarter burst by Coburg ended any hopes that Ivanhoe may have had about opening their account. Coburg were more than 8 goals ahead at half-time, and although Ivanhoe did better in the third term Coburg raced away again in the final quarter to score a big win.

Melbourne High caused an upset when they beat the previously undefeated Old Scotch by 3 goals. Reservoir Old Boys crushed De La Salle to the tune of 106 points and Collegians scored an 8-goal win over Old Trinity.

University Blacks were too strong for Assumption, aud Old Carey's straighter kicking gave them a 5-goal win over Kew.

Power House lost their top spot when they went down to Old Haileybury by 25 points. Old Brighton beat Parkside by 4 goals in a high-scoring game and National Bank pipped Uni. High by a point to hand over the wooden spoon.

Old Melburnians beat St. Kilda CBC by more than 6 goals and Old Xaverians were no match for Fairfield.

State Savings Bank were another team to vacate the No. 1 position on the list when they lost by 13 points to Alphington. Their place has been taken by Marcellin, who scraped home from St. Pat's by 3 points in a thriller (18.11 to 18.8).

Commonwealth Bank scored by 7 points at the expense of Brunswick, St. Kevin's were much too strong for Old Geelong, and LaTrobe Blacks were no match for Hampton Rovers.

AJAX had a narrow win over AMP Society, the difference being 9 points, and Footscray Tech., despite a score of 16.10, were well beaten by Elsternwick, who kicked 24.19. Old Ivanhoe outclassed Glenhuntly and Old Camberwell did the same to ANZ Bank.

The other leading team to suffer defeat was Monash Whites, who were crushed by Fawkner to the tune of more than 10 goals. Old Mentonians went down to University Reds by 7 points, St. Bede's beat LaTrobe Reds by 15 points and North Brunswick scored by 22 points over Dookie and Longerenong. Monash University upset the previously unbeaten Power House in Jur ior Section 1, their winning margi being 28 points. North Old Boys bea St. Bernard's by 21 points and On mond had only 10 points to spare from University Blacks.

University Blues were too stron for Old Scotch, and Ivanhoe over whelmed Hampton Scouts to oper their acount.

In Section 2, Coburg trounced AJA2 by more than 20 goals. The othe winners, St. Bede's, Old Brighton, Ole Paradians and Parkside, had few worries and all scored by substantia margins.

The most interesting results in the Reserves were Caulfield Grammar's 10-point win over Monash Blues and University Blue's 5-point defeat by St Bernard's North Old Boys beat Geel ong by 10 points.

Reservoir crushed De La Salle and Collegians went down to Old Trinity by 17 points. St. Kilda CBC had rather a close call over Old Melburnians winning by only 2 goals, Old Hailey bury beat Power House by 6 goals Marcellin beat St. Pat's by 2 goals Old Geelong won comfortably from St. Kevin's and Alphington beat State Bank by 8 points.

AMP Society beat AJAX by 9 goals St. Bede's ran LaTrobe Reds to 4 points and Monash Whites scraped home from Fawkner by 3 points.



Today's game's a real cruncher.


We've copped the Premiers from last season. Anyway I've got me boys in the nick of health and although the scribes don't give us a chance I m quietly confident.

UMPIRE'S CORNER

15 METRES PENALTY

"When a player has been awarded a mark or free kick and an opponent unduly holds or deprives him of or refuses him possession of the ball, or deliberately encroaches over the mark, or refuses to come back to the spot where the mark or free kick was awarded, or in any way deliberately delays the play, the spot where the mark or free kick was awarded shall be advanced not more than 15 metres nearer the goal which the player entitled to the kick is attacking.

1

Note — this law will also apply where a player is taking a kick after the first sound of the bell.

This law should be applied in the following cases:---

1. If a player deliberately holds an opponent who has marked the ball or has been awarded a free kick.

2. If a player deliberately withholds the ball from the rightful player by:

- (a) retaining possession of the ball unduly;
- (b) throwing or rolling the ball away so that the rightful player has to cover unnecessary ground to retrieve it, or when in possession of the ball, fails to make a genuine attempt to return the ball to the rightful player on the full.
- (c) knocking the ball from the rightful player's hands.

3. If a player deliberately goes over the spot where an opponent has been awarded a mark or a free kick, or moves back too slowly when in front of the spot.

4. Any other obvious and deliberate attempt to waste time or deprive the

rightful player of possession of the ball.

Note — it should be noted that there must not be undue delay in the play and that the infringement must be deliberate.

IVANHOE - THE MAGPIES OF THE AMATEURS

Everyone at Ivanhoe Amateur Football Club is brimful of confidence that 1973 will be one of the best years in the club's history.

That is really saying something, as the "Hoes" have had some great eras during 39 years in the Amateurs.

The earliest highlight was a string of 70 straight wins immediately after the club switched to this competition from the Sub-District League.

Under the astute coaching of former star Collingwood and Hawthorn rover, "Jiggy" Harris, the 'Hoes won successive D, C and B Section flags in 1934-35-36. In their first taste of A Section football, in 1937, they missed out on the four.

The 'Hoes had to wait until 1956 for their first (and so far their only) top grade flag.

Players in that team included two senior present-day club officials president, **Russell "Rusty" Burt** and vice-president, **John "Plumber" Miles**.

"Rusty", with 250 games, has the second highest total of any player who has stripped for the black and whites. In his present capacity he is effectively adding to a wonderful record of service to the club.

In recent years the 'Hoes have moved between A and B Sections. In 1969 there was a B Section flag under coach and former player, Sid Neale. Sid has returned to the club this year as assistant to the senior coach, ex-Carlton and Victorian back pocket player, John Benetti.

Last year the 'Hoes' spectacular finals run from fourth position finished only in the dying stages of a hard fought B Section Grand Final. Another notable achievement last year was the entry, master-minded by another club "veteran", **Ron Lucas**, of four under-age teams in the Doncaster and District Sunday competition.

These teams, ranging from Under 11 to Under 17, are expected to provide many senior Ivanhoe players in the years to come.

The 'Hoes have begun the 1973 season in impressive new clubrooms, which adequately complement what must be one of the most pleasantly situated grounds in the competition, on the Boulevard at East Ivanhoe.

We look forward to welcoming all visiting teams there this year. The hospitality will be as warm, the football as fiercely competitive, and Ida as vocal as ever.


