

FORM REVERSAL BY CAULFIELD GRAMM. COBURG THRASHED BY 51 POINTS *ORMOND TROUBLED BY IVANHOE*

Caulfield Grammarians staged a reversal of form to beat Coburg by 51 points in the main game last Saturday.

The week before they failed badly against St. Bernard's and lost their place in the four. Coburg, on the same day, were all up in the air over their win against North Old Boys, who were leaders at the time.

New leaders, Ormond, had a lot of trouble with Ivanhoe, who have not yet broken the ice, but Ormond finally shook them off to win by 23 points.

Caulfield never let up on Coburg, who never looked like winning. The home side opened up a lead of 26 points in the first quarter and edged away to a 37-point advantage at the interval.

But it was the third quarter when they really rubbed it in — they held Coburg scoreless and increased their lead to nearly 10 goals.

Coburg came back in the last term but were unable to make much impression on their big leeway. Each side kicked 6 goals in this quarter.

Caulfield's more determined approach to the game and greater strength in the air were big factors in their win, and once again Oval 3, Albert Park proved a hoodoo ground for Coburg.

It was a fairly even game at Monash for the first half, when North Old Boys led by 11 points, but North applied more pressure after the interval and a 7-goal burst in the third term enabled them to go on to a very comfortable win.

Ivanhoe surprised Ormond for most of the game, which was of high standard and very even. Ormond led

by 4 points at the interval and were only a point ahead at the last change. Ivanhoe worried them until well into the last quarter and it was only in the last 10 minutes that Ormond broke away.

University Blues established a 23-point lead over Old Paradians in the first half and went on to win by 44 points.

Geelong kicked only one goal in the first half against Bernard's and trailed by almost 9 goals at the interval. They fought back well in the second half but their early leeway was too great and they went down by 34 points.

Old Carey dropped from second to fourth when they went down to Collegians by 22 points. University Blacks trounced Old Scotch by more than 10 goals but Old Trinity scraped home from Melbourne High by only 8 points in a high-scoring game (17.17 to 16.15).

Reservoir Old Boys and De La Salle had big wins over Kew and Assumption respectively.

Power House crashed against St. Kilda CBC, going down by 19 points and Old Melburnians had only 11 points to spare from Uni High.

Marcellin beat La Trobe Blacks by 19 points and Alphington scored by 22 points over Commonwealth Bank but St Kevin's went down to Brunswick by 9 points. Poor kicking robbed Old Geelong of the chance of passing on the wooden spoon — St. Pat's beat them by a goal.

AJAX lost their chance of climbing back into the four when they failed by more than 6 goals against West Brunswick. Old Camberwell were flat out to beat AMP Society getting there by only 3 points.

La Trobe Reds beat Old Mentonians by 9 points in a low-scoring encounter and Monash White's big win over North Brunswick enabled them to displace Fawkner (who had the bye) from the head of the list.

Power House lost their place in the Junior Section four to Monash University when they went down to North Old Boys by 10 points.

In Section 2, Beverley Hills beat AJAX by 3 goals to hold their place in the four.

PERMITS CLOSE SOON

Applications for permits for season 1973 will close with the Records Secretary of the V.A.F.A. Mr. Bruce De Lacy, 67 Charman Road, Mentone, 3194 on July 1st.

The only application considered after that date will be that of a player affiliated with a club in the amateur body of South Australia, Western Australia or Tasmania, who is transferred to Victoria in his employment, or a National Serviceman who returns to Victoria.

A player who has played with a club in the V.A.F.A. this season, and has subsequently played with another club, must stand down for two matches before being eligible to play for his V.A.F.A. club again.

In a case such as this, the date on which he last played with the other club must be shown on his permit application.

Re-registration of a player whose permit is still in force, that is, a player who has not played with any other club since he last played with the club with which he is seeking re-registration may be made at any time up to the last home and home match.


BALL BRIEFS

ASSUMPTION — A “TINGLING TENNER”

It was on a cold Kilmore morning in May 1963 that a then medical student Kerry Breen asked the question, “Why doesn't the Assumption Old Collegians field a team in the Victorian Amateur Football Association?”

The answer was given in a positive way by the work of Des Tehan and Matt Byrne during 1963 with the view to joining the V.A.F.A. in 1965. The formation of the Club was speeded by the V.A.F.A. decision to form F Section in 1964.

Now in its tenth season in the V.A.F.A. Assumption Old Collegians has progressed to B Section. In its progress up the Amateur ladder the Club won the E Section pennant in 1967.

One feature of its history has been the continuity of service of many club stalwarts. Three men have filled the Presidency — Frank De Neefe for 5 years and two former club captains — Adrian O'Keefe (President 1969-1972) and this year's President Maurice Beaumont.

Norm Nugent has been Secretary since the formation of the Club. Matt Byrne has been the V.A.F.A. Delegate since 1964 and occupies the position of club patron. Matt is always to the fore in club activities and has played a role second to none in having the club succeed.

The management of the club holds monthly meetings at Life Member Michael Kearney's Lord Raglan Hotel. Apart from official functions this hostelry is a most popular venue for post mortems and discussions on forthcoming matches.

An active social committee led by well known Club and Amateur personality John “Barrell” Fitz, does its share to promote Social relationships and to keep the Club solvent thus lessening Treasurer Michael Carille's troubles with his bank manager.

The highlights of the Social calendar are the counting of Club Best and Fairest votes on the night of the last

home and away game and the Annual Presentation Night held on the Section Grand Final night.

Years of hard work and planning bore fruit in 1971 with the opening of the club's new pavilion adjacent to the Western Oval in Royal Park. This building saves the long trek across parkland from older pavilions to the Western Oval.

Three coaches have guided the club in its history. Bernard “Bunga” Curtin was in charge for three seasons during which time the club rose from F to E Section.

Bryan Harding took over the coaching in 1967 and guided Assumption to the E Section premiership that year. Under Bryan's guidance the club rose to C Section in 1970 and B Section in 1973.

Due to his commitments as an Inspector of police Bryan retired from coaching in 1972 to be replaced by his ex-classmate Jim Gallagher who as a half-back flanker represented Footscray and Victoria with distinction.

Assistance to both Bryan and Jim has been given by Lindsay Howard both as Reserves Coach and as the Coaches' runner. Lindsay, whose playing career has been interrupted by injury has proven a loyal and dedicated club member.

On the field Assumption has been led by Bernard Curtin 1964-6, Adrian O'Keefe 1967-8, Maurice Beaumont 1969-71 and Paul Nugent 1972-3.

Executive Committee viewed with concern that two players had been ordered off the ground — more than the previous five years combined.

Commonwealth Bank, ninth in B Section, overwhelmed Old Xaverians eighth (13.6 to 6.5). Borrack, Pretty (4 goals) and Dick starred.
