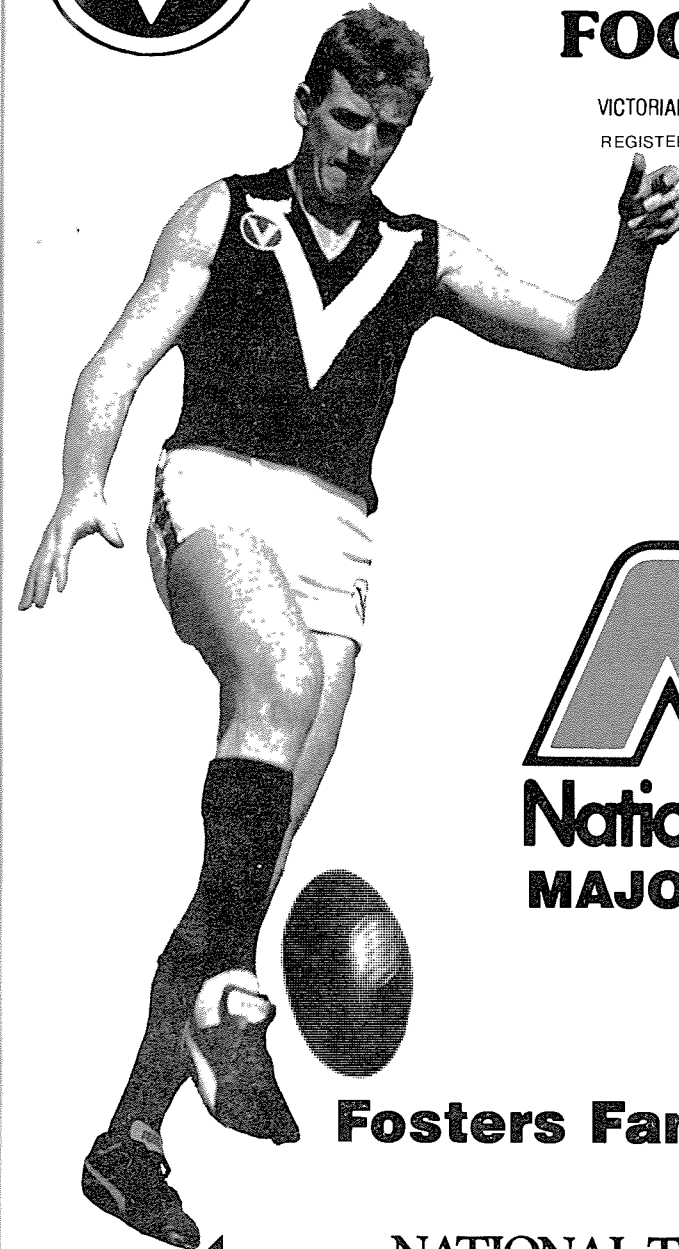
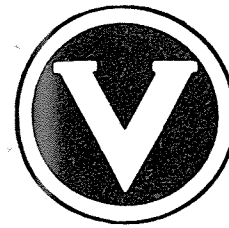

A Section Review by Ross Booth



Perhaps the four is not settled but **De La Salle's** draw with **Old Xaverians** and **North Old Boys** thrashing by **Ormond** suggest to me that **De La** will now be very difficult to shift.

Old Xaverians looked a bad thing at quarter time trailing **De La** by five goals. But, they clawed their way back into the game to trail by just 2 points at the last change. **The Xavs** hit the front for the first time in the last quarter but it was shortlived as **De La** got the next 3 goals. Not to be denied the **Xavs** fought back, two goals then a string of behinds and they drew level. The big crowd witnessed a derocious game dominated by defences. It seemed to be a round where half backs called the tune. **Murray Varcoo**, **Steve King** and **John Curtain** held sway for **Xavier** and for **De La** the best defenders were the experienced trio of **Brian Hanrahan**, **Tim Cooke** and **Pat Maher**.

The two point advantage to **De La** is quite handy now when weighed up against **North's** huge 79 point loss to top side **Ormond**. It was a brave selection but I just had a feeling! It was fairly even till half time with **Ormond** leading by 22 points but 7 **Ormond** goals to nil sealed the game by three quarter time. **Paul Schuhkraft** bagged 7 goals at full forward to be **Ormonds** best. His season tally is now 58. Any chance for 100? State rep **Phil Kingston** had a good duel with North wingman **Ben Curutti**. The 'Monds half backs **Russell Barnes**, **David McDonald** and **Paul Forsyth** were grand. Ruck-rover **Tony Cahill** was probably **North** best.

Scotch had a narrow 10 point win over relegation rivals **Uni Blues**. These two plus **Collegians** and **Caulfield** will fight it out with the **Bullants** for the honour. So, an important win for the **Cardinals**. Most of the scoring was done at the eastern end — even though the breeze was light. 27 goals at one end, 7 at the other. Quite amazing considering the conditions. **Scotch** had first use of the scoring end and it was the **Blues** who had to catch up in the 2nd and 4th quarters, but they weren't quite good enough. The move of **Peter Sherwen** to full back allowed **Steve Spiers** to bag 7 goals at full forward. Captain **Rob Fuller** and ruck-rover **Ric Senior** played big parts in **Scotch's** win. **Blues** best was young winger **Richard Furphy** with the **MacAulay** brothers, **Nick** and **Simon** not far behind.

Old Paradians scored a massive 95 point win over **Caulfield Grammarians**. **O.P.'s** had 42 scoring shots to **Caulfield's** 12 - quite a one-sided game. Indeed, had it not been for **Caulfield's** 6 goal third quarter it would have been a whitewash. **O.P.** centre half forward **John Alta** kicked 5 goals, **Martin Heffernan** roved well but it was four U. 19 players who impressed - **Owen Abrahams**, **Shane Gorman**, **Dion Nibali** and **Tim Bearne** replacements for the injured **Tony Woods**, **Paul Considine** and **Steve Exton**. Sadly, **Dominic Spillane** was injured again, this time a shoulder. Special thanks to the Editor of **Shag's Rag**. It's a great magazine. Have you ever thought of going into journalism? Which line was best for **Caulfield**? Half-back of course - **Mike McMahon**, **Mark McClelland** and **Andrew Norman**.

Finally, **Collegians** would be pleased with the 4 points against **Bulleen-Templestowe** but not with the winning margin just 17 points.

This week's round of matches don't appear to be all that difficult; the hardest being the **North-Scotch** clash.

Peter French Previews today's matches



After a week's rest which from all accounts most A Section Clubs, seemed to appreciate, especially those with injury worries, we move into the final chapter of the season, and the run home to the finals.

Of interest I was asked during the week by former Hawk and Old Carey coach **John Dunshea** why we hadn't played a split round over last weekend and today. The answer was simple enough. No-one had thought of it and perhaps the marketing committee will look at the suggestion for 1988. Speaking of 1988 I recently received an exciting proposal from **State Bank** which the Executive is currently studying. Its along the lines of the F.A. Cup and could form part of the V.A.F.A.'s Bi-Centenary celebrations. Rest assured I'll keep you posted.

Now to the games where **De La Salle** faces a huge task against competition leaders **Ormond** who have carried all before them to date, although coach **Mike McArthur-Allen** is mindful that they have still to play all 3 sides in the current top four. **Ormond** are certainly not invincible. However they are consistent and meet **De La** with the knowledge that they scored an impressive 24 point win at **Ormond** on May 9th in a pressure packed game which was worthy of a final. In addition **De La's** home record this season is poor with just 3 wins from 6 matches. They suffered losses to **Blues** and **North** and drew with **Old Xavs**. Their overall record since 1985 is even, with both sides sharing minor and second round successes.

The break has been a blessing for both sides, **Ormond** in particular. Returning for the 'Monds will be **Phil Mehrten, Brad Nash, Craig Tonkin** and **Geoff Russell** whilst **De La** will welcome back **Mick Deveson, Mick Knuppel** and hopefully **Matt Beddoe**. I'm selecting **Ormond** to win as they have the defenders capable of restricting **De La's** few players capable of kicking goals and as **Mick Greene** will be absent through injury, **Ormond's Paul McDonald** who has had a very good season to date, and **Scott Taylor** will combine to control the rucks and provide the **Ormond** small men and carriers **Paul Cok, Andrew Mehrten** and **Paul Sutherland** with enough opportunities for key forwards **Paul Schukroff** and **Mark McDonald** to kick a winning score. I believe **De La** relies too much on **Colin Lowe** and **Peter Rennie** and perhaps **Chris Campbell** and may be forced to use **Mick Deveson** up forward to lift its attack. For **Ormond Brad Nash** who has had a wonderful year at full back to the surprise of many **Ormond** supporters, skipper **Russell Barnes** dependable **David McDonald** plus **Paul Forsyth** and **Brett Connell** have formed a close and reliable defence whose rebound game is often overlooked. Its sure to be another game well worth a visit and promises to be a real match of the day.

Not far behind it for importance and excitement will be the **North O.B.** and **Old Scotch** game at Brens Oval. Back on May 9th **Scotch** kicked an incredible thirty goals to ten, a statistic you can be **Don Martin** and his players have not easily forgotten. There's incentive a plenty for both sides as **Scotch** are only 6 points out of the four and victories by **Ormond** and **Collegians** would see 4 clubs on six wins with **De La** holding a slender 2 point lead. **North** too realize the value of a win and at home I'm confident they'll achieve it and move into the four. Their desperation, evenness and strength across the centre will I believe give them the points in a vital match for both clubs.

Collegians will move closer to the four by revenging their first round defeat by **Caulfield Grammarians**. **The Lions** are chasing their first hattrick of wins for the year and will be untroubled today against **Caulfield** who are completely out of form and touch and would need a minor miracle to survive the season.

Old Xaverians are at home to **Bulleen-Templestowe** who a number of "experts" now rate a better side than their ladder position suggest. Unfortunately its too late for the **Bullants** this season and as long as **Xavs** are not over confident they will win and win handsomely.

Uni Blues face the long trip to Bundoora to meet **Old Paradians** who are right back to form and will show no mercy if the **Blues** are not fair dinkum. However **Alan Salter** is over those problems now as the **Blues** last two efforts show and although I could not select them today, they're bound to put up a far better effort than that of **Caulfield**.

To Be Section where **Parkside** has slipped to second and **Therry** has halted the **Blacks** charge. Of major interest is who will finish first and second and gain the all important double chance? Of the top four **Therry** may have the toughest game. They meet **Old Trinity** at Elsternwick Park and just cannot afford to slip up. They should appreciate a final opportunity to play at the finals venue and on paper have the talent to overcome **Old Trinity** who still require another win or two to remain the section for next season.

Uni Blacks has a back to back home game against **Marcellin** who have moved to top of the section following a big win over **Fawkner** despite a lacklustre final quarter. **The Eagles** won by just 15 points in the early encoun-

ter and although favourites for today can expect a hard game from the **Blacks** for whom time is running out for a finals berth. **Blacks** really needed a win last round and should they fail today its finals hopes will be dashed. In what will be an entertaining game **Marcellin** has the form and class to retain top spot.

St. Kilda C.B.S. will no doubt have come back to earth after its great win over **Parkside**. **The Saints** will be confident of repeating that success against **Ivanhoe** today and at home I believe they can. They have really been a bit unlucky this year having lost five games by 7 points or less and if they can win today would have a great chance of surviving the season. With that incentive I'm selecting **St. Kilda**.

St. Bernards travel to Mutton reserve to take on a disappointing **Fawkner**. For the visitors its been a great year so far and the Club is rightly confident of repeating its 1984 effort. For **Fawkner** its been a year to forget. The loss of players to other competitions and injuries in key positions has revealed a lack of depth which is now required in all levels of the game. The club's policy of promoting its promising youngsters is the right way to go but today **St. Bernards** look far more settled and despite the efforts of the **Saggers** and **Busst** brothers, **Tymms, Steve Buckley, Peter Majerczak** and the other reliables **St. Bernards** will win.

Banyule and **Parkside** meet at Waringal Park in a local derby which should see the **Devils** bounce back following its surprise loss to **St. Kilda**. Club President **Tom Johnston** was not surprised claiming that ten players were sidelined by injury. **Tom** you'd certainly receive a sympathetic hearing from your counterpart at **O.M.'s David Strange!** The return of **John Papas, Mark Sturges, Mark Sherlock, Peter Whitfield** and the legendary **Jack King** will bolster the side although the loss of **Tony Pavia** is a tragic blow, as the nuggety back pocket has had a great year and provided plenty of drive. After its great win over **Therry, Banyule** has been disappointing and I cant see them beating **Parkside** today.

Old Melburnians will no doubt relish a home game against bottom side **Hampton Rovers**. As predicted **O.M.'s** struggled at **Thomastown** and need a big win to restore pride and confidence, two losses in three weeks. With three tough games ahead **O.M.'s** must make certain of victory today or it may find itself out of contention!

AJAX let me down last week against **Monash** whereas its opponent **Old Brighton** crushed a dispirited **Old Haileybury**. **Old Brighton** is on target for a finals berth and the return of **Peter Gran** (9 goals last week) might just see them make it. Today they'll have no problems with the 'Jackers.

Melbourne High are at home to **Old Haileybury**. Both clubs have had poor seasons and lacked consistency. **Old Haileybury** without the on field services of captain coach **Wayne Shand** and new recruit **Darren Secul** will not appreciate the tight confines of the High School Oval and is heading for a tenth defeat. Victory to **Melbourne High** will see the club out of the relegation zone, although **Old Haileybury** may still have some anxious moments.

There are two great games in the Section. At Kew **Monash** will be anxious to test themselves against the section leaders. They have been the quiet achievers all year and have done well for a club who was runner-up in 'D' Section last year. **Kew** has been the pace-setter of late having picked up the ball **O.M.'s** dropped. At home today they will pressure **Monash** into error and have that 'gentle' giant **Tony Peric** playing consistently. His clash with **Peter Forbes** will have a bearing on the game which promises to be a beauty. **Monash** will be competitive but **Kew** will win.

The other 'big' game is at Albert Park where **Balaclava** will be playing for its place in the four against **Thomastown**. Knowing that **Old Brighton** will beat **AJAX** and has a percentage lead the "Kangas" will give the visitors a real working over and although the Bears are well in the hunt they do not play well away from home and certainly not at Albert Park. I don't even think this will be close — Sorry Sam its a **Bala** win!

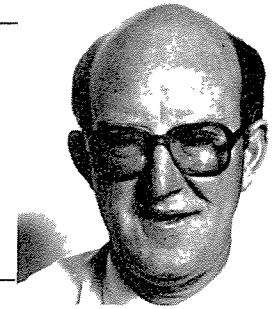

REVIEW OF MATCHES PLAYED 11/7/87 ROUND 13

D SECTION

Round 13 results meant a leavening of the competition and renewed interest in the positions of the top six sides as well as in the teams facing relegation. **Preston's** sixty one point majority over **North Brunswick** has put them only one game outside the top four while **Bulleen United's** three goal loss to **Old Mentonians** saw the "Bulls" plummet to fourth place which they hold by percentage from **Old Mentonians**. **Old Camberwell** accounted for leaders **St. Kevins** by five points which means the **Wells** have now won three consecutive games by less than a goal. **Old Ivanhoe** moved to second place following their thirty one point victory over **Elsternwick** whose inaccurate kicking greatly lessened their hope of victory. In the battle for the "wooden spoon" **Heatherston** managed to defeat **Coburg** by eight points. This defeat has really dented any remaining hope, held by **Coburg**, that they can avoid relegation.

E SECTION

Brunswick had a victory of forty one points over an inaccurate **Powerhouse** while **Peninsula** defeated **Clayton** by thirty three points. These results have placed **Powerhouse** under threat of relegation for the second successive season. **West Brunswick** gave a skilful display to overwhelm **Old Geelong** by ninety one points. **Old Geelong's** inept forward line did not help their team remain competitive with **West Brunswick**. **State Bank** did improve their percentage with an eighty one point victory over **Universith High School Old Boys** while leaders **Old Essendon Grammarians** defeated **St. Bedes** by sixteen points and thus placed them in danger of losing their place in the top four at the business end of the season.

F SECTION

Doveton returned to third place following their sixty one point win over an inaccurate **Williamstown C.Y.M.S.** and as a result of **Whitefriars** defeating **St. Andrews** by sixteen points in what was a very high standard game. After three even quarters, **Whitefriars'** experienced players took their side to victory. Section leader **Aquinas** had no difficulty accounting for **Commonwealth Bank** by seventy eight points whereas the unpredictable **La-Trobe University** defeated **St. Leonards** by the minimum margin. **Old Carey** remained outside the top four sides by percentage only following their thirteen point victory over **Footscray Institute**. In the Sunday game **University Reds** defeated an improving **A.N.Z. Bank** by eight points.

G SECTION

Port Colts proved my prediction correct when they defeated **De La Salle** by twenty eight points while in the upset of the season **St. Bernards** inflicted **Bloods** first defeat when the **Saints** were fourteen points up at the sound of the final siren. **Monash Whites** had a landslide one hundred and sixteen point victory over **Old Haileybury** who managed only four minor scores. **Collegians** proved my judgement sound when they defeated **Marcellin** by seven points. Likewise **Kew** were not extended to defeat **GTV9** by forty four points although **GTV9's** inaccuracy did make their losing margin wider. **Old Scotch** displayed sufficient talent to account for **Old Melbourneburnians** by fifty one points.

H SECTION

Therry must be the least fortunate side in the competition because for the second week in succession they went down by a point. This week **State Bank** were victorious by the minimum margin. In another close match second placed **St. Kevins** defeated **Old Xaverians** by four points whereas the **Bulleen Templestowe — C.B.C. St. Kilda** game saw a marked scoring discrepancy as the **Combine** ran out easy winners by eighty two points. By coincidence this was the same winning margin as **Old Brighton** had over **Richmond Central**. In an unusual occurrence leaders **Eltham College** held **Powerhouse/Balaclava** scoreless. The "Turtles" ninety seven point winning margin would have been far greater if their forwards had kicked straighter. **Old Geelong** had the bye.

PREVIEW OF ROUND 14 (JULY 18, 1987)

D SECTION

Near neighbours **Coburg** and **North Brunswick** will meet on the **De Chene Reserve**. Neither side has displayed much form this season and selecting the winner is a hazardous task. Traditionally **Coburg** sides have

had an advantage at home so I will stay with **Coburg** as my selection. **Preston** will provide **Old Camberwell** with spirited opposition but I must select **Old Camberwell** to win because their recent form has been so good. The main match of the round sees **St. Kevins** and **Old Ivanhoe** drawn to play on the **Righetti Oval**. **St. Kevins**, because of its superior record and home ground advantage, is my selection. Neighbours **Old Mentonians** and **Heatherston** will clash at **Keysborough** where I believe the **Mentonians** will emerge victorious. **Bulleen United** should return to the winning list today as the result of defeating **Elsternwick** who are finding D Section a difficult assignment to manage.

E SECTION

Round 14 results could have a vital effect on the end of season placement of all sides. **Brunswick** visit **State Bank** for a game which could well decide who will win the double final chance. I am an unabashed admirer of **State Bank's** ability to win on **Oval 4** and this home ground advantage plus **State Bank's** more active forwards prompts me to select them. **Powerhouse** must defeat **Clayton** and defeat them by a wide margin to cushion themselves against further relegation. I believe **Powerhouse** players have the ability to win. **Peninsula** are formidable opponents to all sides who visit **Mt. Eliza**. Today I believe the **Pirates** will be too talented for **Old Geelong** and thus move or step closer to avoiding relegation. **Old Essendon Grammarians** must defeat **University High School Old Boys** to be sure of retaining top spot. I have little doubt that the **Old Essendon** players possess the ability to win and win well. In a mini final **St. Bedes** are at home to **West Brunswick**. The winner will move to third position and because **West Brunswick** have carried all before them of late I believe the "Black and Whites" are strong enough to defeat **St. Bedes** despite the game being played on their School soil.

F SECTION

Williamstown make the long journey east to play **Whitefriars** whose home ground will prove difficult for **Williamstown** to master. I have little doubt that **Whitefriars** will win the match. **Doveton** who are at home to **Commonwealth Bank** should not meet with too much opposition en route to victory. An improving **A.N.Z. Bank** journey east where their opponents will be leaders **Aquinas**. As I do not share **Mick Seitz's** optimism I select **Aquinas**. The unpredictable **La Trobe University** side are at home to **St. Andrews** who are in fine form. With **Wilson** a focal point up forward **St. Andrews** should repeat their May 9th victory over the **Students**. **Old Carey** make the long journey south east to play **St. Leonards** who showed glimpses of form last week. The lure of a final's berth will carry **Old Carey** to victory. In a game that carries victor prestige only **Footscray Institute** are at home to **University Reds**. The forwards of each side have given comparable performances although the **Red** defence is statistically the more effective. At home I select **Footscray Institute** to win its third game for the season.

G SECTION

De La Salle should return to the winning list with a victory over **Collegians**. Giant killers **St. Bernards** play **Port Colts** who won their May 9th match. I select **Port Colts** to win again today. **Old Scotch** meet **Bloods** on the rebound following their first loss. I have little doubt that **Bloods** will emerge victorious again today. **Marcellin** has not revealed any glimpses of form which could result in their victory so I have little doubt **Monash Whites** will win today's game and will win it well. **Kew**, anxious to maintain a top four position, will show no mercy to **Old Haileybury** whose form has been poor. I believe **Kew** will win convincingly. In the battle for the wooden spoon I favour **GTV9** to defeat **Old Melburnians** as the **G.T.V.** players are on their home ground and their recent form has been the better.

H SECTION

Bulleen Templestowe, at home, will prove too talented for **State Bank** while the luckless **Therry** should record their first victory against **Old Geelong**. **Old Xaverians** should return to the winning list at the expense of **C.B.C. St. Kilda** while in a final's preview **Old Brighton** are at home to **St. Kevins**. Home ground advantage plus a tighter defence should enable **Old Brighton** to emerge victorious. **Richmond Central** should be too talented for **Powerhouse/Balaclava** whose form has left a lot to be desired this season. **Eltham College** has the bye.

UNDER 19 SECTION 1 (Round 13)

De La Salle can still be finalists so a big effort will be required from their players today, against **Ormond** in an attempt to build percentage. **De La Salle** should record a big win. For what could be a final's preview **Old Paradians Green** are at home to **University Blues** whose last two games have seen marked scoring contrasts by their forwards. How strong the Blues are today will not be known until the game gets underway. This doubt plus the effect of the **Bundoora** conditions prompts me to select the **Old Paradians Green** who, however, must put in the required effort to win. **Melbourne High School Old Boys** should record their third win this season by accounting for **North Old Boys** today. **Collegians** have shown glimpses of form of late and could extend **Marcellin** today. However at the sound of the final siren I believe **Marcellin** will have won the match. **Old Xaverians** meet **Bulleen Templestowe** in a game which will show contrasting styles of football. The experience of the **Old Xaverians** has been a big factor in the side gaining sectional leadership. Today I expect the **Old Xaverians** to win after a closely contested game.

UNDER 19 SECTION 2 (Round 13)

Banyule are at home to **Old Melburnians** and when judged on their Round 12 form I have no hesitation select-

ing **Banyule** to win. Leaders **Therry** should be sufficiently talented to defeat **St. Bernards** and thus dent the **Saint's** final hopes. In a potential finals preview **Old Scotch** journey to **Thomastown** where the home side will hold an advantage because their terrain is different from that in **Yarra Park**. I have been pleased to observe the improvement made by the **Thomastown** players and feel they will give another good account of themselves today. However I cannot select against **Old Scotch** who have the more impressive seasonal record.

The inconsistent **University Blacks** are at home to **C.B.C. St. Kilda** who are currently in the relegation zone. I select the **Blacks** to win which should please my regular readers from that side. **Old Brighton** are at home to **Old Haileybury** and judged on their respective records, the "Bloods" will take the points.

UNDER 19 SECTION 3 (Round 13)

Leaders **Whitefriars** travel across town to play **Williamstown**. 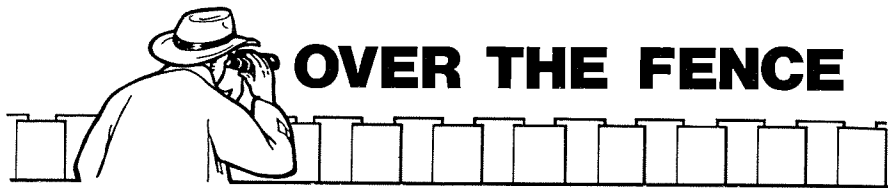

Beaurepaires The Boys in Blue

RULE 11:

The first and second rounds of the Senior Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit.

RULE 12:

The first and second rounds of the Under 19 Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players who have not attained the age of 19 years or where in the opinion of the Executive Committee, special circumstances exist such other age as the Executive Committee determines.

RULE 13:

The second round of the Under 19 Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players within the age limits prescribed in Rule 12 to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit provided that a player who has represented a Club in an aggregate of more than five (5) matches in the Senior Grade and Reserve Grade in the first round in any season shall not be eligible unless he has represented such Club in more than five (5) matches in the first round of the Under 19 Grade in the same season unless such Club shall be represented in a match in the second round of the Senior Grade on the same day. In the event of a draw taking place in a match in the second round of the Under 19 Grade, all players who took part in the drawn game shall be eligible to take part in the game to be replayed.

RULE 14:

The first round of the Reserve Grade shall be open to all eligible and registered players to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit.

RULE 15:

The second round of the Reserve Grade shall be open to all players who:

- (i) are eligible and registered to represent the Club with which they have been granted a permit.

- (ii) have represented such Club in at least two matches of the Reserve Grade in the first round in the same season; and
- (iii) if they have represented such Club in the Senior Grade in the first round in the same season, have participated in not more than eight matches in the said first round.

Provided that if such Club is represented in a match in the second round of both the Reserve Grade and Senior Grade on the same day the second round match of the Reserve Grade shall be open to all players who:

- (i) are eligible and registered to represent the Club with which they have been granted a Permit; and
- (ii) have represented such Club in a total of at least two matches of the Senior or Reserve Grade in the same season.

In the event of a draw taking place in a match in the second round of the Reserve Game all players who were eligible to take part in the drawn game shall be eligible to take part in the game to be replayed.

As far as G & H Section eligibility is concerned the Executive has ruled that

- (i) A player must play in a minimum of Four (4) G or H Section matches.
- (ii) A player may not play in more than Eight (8) Senior and/or Reserve Grade matches.
