



Despite a line-up missing **Nick Wilton**, **Dermot Dann**, **Peter Curtin** and **Mark Summers**, the Old Xavs accounted for a very competitive **Caulfield Grammarians** by 57 points. **Corcoran** really tried to charge his players up at three-quarter time and they responded.

Nick Burne at full back had a marvellous day. He's beginning to get his touch back after a spell overseas. Caulfield's **Ray Berzins** found him a handful. **Steve Curtin** only kicked 3 goals but he was lively in attack and his contesting resulted in several goals. **John Kanis** in the centre impressed for Caulfield — he was still running at the final bell.

If **Peter Curtin** played, there would have been four brothers in the same side! **John**, **Paul** and **Peter** play most of their football in defence with **Steve** the black sheep being a forward. Peter French Previews today's matches



What an interesting round, and right throughout the sections too and with a third of the season completed a brief review of A, B and C Sections is timely. **Old Melburnians** has stamped itself as outright favourites for C Section Honours with a splendid last half against a determined and obviously much improved **Monash Blues**. **Kew** regained some lost ground with an important home win over **Old Brighton** and **MHSOB** lifted itself from the doldrums with a surprising win over **Thomastown**. **Old Haileybury's** back to back wins has brought smiles at McKinnon whilst **AJAX** like **Bulleen-Temp (A)** & **St. Kilda CBC (B)**, is experiencing a season it would no doubt like to recommence. Such is the situation in C Section.

In B there is a similar pattern to A & C with just the one undefeated side — **Parkside**. The Devils have been all around promotion in recent seasons and 1987 surely represents the Club's best chance yet to finally reach the promised land of A Section. New Coach **Rod Osborne** has instilled discipline and has moulded an even and most competitive side which boasts strength and height in **Yoksich, Sansonetti, Franklin & Bradley** and a solid corps of skillfull, experienced and clever movers and carriers in **Williams, Sturgess, Page, Papas King and Sherlock**. However O'Borne' greatest achievement to date has surely been the harnessing of the great talent of full forward **Chris Freeman** who has had his concentration and temperament problems in past seasons. **Freeman** is the sections leading goalkicker and his current form and attitude is a great boost to the club which, if it can hold onto the double chance can realistically look forward to celebrating the bi-centenary in A Section. **Therry & Marcellin** are only a game behind and as both have club depth they're bound to hold onto their place in the four which leaves fourth spot wide open for a revitalised **St. Bernards**, a rapidly improving **Ivanhoe**, a typically slow starting Blacks or can Fawkner find its its 1986 form?

To ascertain where I'm sure there's more than one keen follower of the fortunes of A Section Club who is surprised at **Ormond's** outright leadership of the Section after 6 matches. Back in March I had a hunch it might be a year of consolidation at Malane Street, but the addition of youngsters, **Cox & Nankervis**, the dramatic improvement in **Paul McDonald, Craig Tonkin, Paul Schuhkraft and Brad Nash** plus the steadiness and maturity of the likes of **Beards, the Mehrten and McDonald brothers, Barnes & Russell** has seen **Ormond** overcome all challenges to date. **Old Paradians & Old Xaverians** are the best performed and promoted Club in years and both have the talent to play in back to back Grand Finals.

Last season's finalists **Collegians, North O.B. & De La Salle** are in real danger of losing touch with the leaders, although **De La** is the marginal leader of the trio at this point. Surprise packet has been **Uni Blues** who are receiving great drive from **Mike Yandell** but will miss the nip of **Gust** who has gone overseas. **Caulfield and Old Scotch** are destined for mediocrity if not relegation whilst **Bulleen-Temp.** is team building and would need a complete form reversal to survive in the Section, which brings us to Round 7 and if Ross Booth and I can pick the card between us today we'll have done extra well.

The match of the month and certainly the round will be played at **Ormond** when first meets third. **Xavs** will be well and truly keyed up for this game and will welcome the return of **Greetham & Peter Curtain**. The goal to goal line battles could well divide the issue. **Steven Curtain** will be too strong and clever for **Brad Nash** and I wonder whether **McArthur-Allen** will give the talented left footer the assignment. I'd be temped to go with **Clark** and leave **David McDonald** to mind **Greetham**. The battle for centre supremacy will be a real clash of the titans, with Ormond's **Phil Mehrten** pitted against Xavs **Mark Atkins**. **Mehrten's** fitness may be his achilles heel at the moment, although Ormond will control the wings where **Nankervis & Kingston** will have the call over the under rated **Callan & Ryan**. **Steve Kings**'s meeting with **Mark McDonald** will be another highlight and could well be the key to the game. King must concentrate all day but will be helped considerably by the poise and skill of **Peter Curtain** on one side and the fierce tackling and determination of **Dalton** on the other. Either man is more than capable of holding **Sutherland or Young** and as **Schuhkraft** will come up against **Nick Burne** who found his 1983/4 form last Saturday, the Ormond youngster will do well to kick even half of last week's tally. Ormond will sadly miss skipper **Russell Barnes** who was concussed last Saturday. He was just the man to mind either **Carlin or Bourke**, neither of whom would have appreciated his close checking style. Whoever gets the job, possibly **Nash**, will need to be on his game as many Xav goals have come from the pair this season. Ormond will win in the ruck where **Paul McDonald** is playing splendidly. It is a pity **Som-**

mers is still suspended as their duel, like many in this game would have been a highlight. However despite **McDonald's** form I doubt whether he'll have much influence as Xavs have three very fine players in **Martin Beattie and rovers O'Sullivan & Tiernan**, all of whom are likely to cause far more damage than either **Andrew Mehrten or Paul Cox**. To sum up Xavs have the better goal to goal line, are smarter around the flanks and will be all fired up to inflict the season's first defeat on the competition leaders.

At Elsternwick Park **Old Scotch & De La Salle** meet in an absolutely vital game for both Clubs. Not only is fourth place at stake but also the chance to stay ahead of the rest and up with the **Blues**. **Scotch** will appreciate its first outing at head quarters and will be anxious to show its supporters that it can do a lot better than last week's ordinary performance, and with **John Mar, Reddish, Senior & Allen** in good touch and **Fuller Brown & Smith** combining well the Cardinals are certainly capable of winning. However **De La Salle** are never better than when faced with adversity. They have **Mick Deveson** out with a hamstring and realize they must win. They play the ground better than most and the recent inclusion of **Condon & Donoghue**, the return of **Greg McHenry**, plus the fine form of **Colin Lowe** should tip the game their way.

Collegians will be away to **Uni Blues** and face a hat trick of defeats. I thought they had a real chance of upsetting **Ormond** last week but were too often second to the ball and do not seem to have the urgency of last year. **Blues** on the other hand are playing with plenty of confidence as an away win at De Sa would suggest and back on familiar territory today ut start favourites. But despite the Blues form of late this could be the Lions chance to stop the rot. They still have the nucleus of a fine side and possess the Sections leading goalkicker, **Richard Herman**, who will be more than a handful for any opponent. Realizing that this might be their last chance I'll give them one more chance and select them today.

North are at home to **Old Paradians** and last weeks win even against **Bulleen-Temp.** will have restored much of the confidence lost at Old Scotch the previous Saturday. Of course today they'll fine **O.P.'s** fr greater opposition than the Bullants and even though I expect them to match the visitors for endeavour, class will out and so its **Old Paradians** for mine.

If ever **Bulleen-Temp.** was going to break the ice, today must be the day. They are at home to **Caulfield** who are about as predictable as Melbourne's weather, but who will also be anxious to stay a step ahead of **Collegians and North**. I'm going for the Fields — their marking power being the big difference between the sides, but its not a selection made with great confidence!

In B Section **Therry & Marcellin** clash at Oak Park in the match of the day. **Therry** will start favourite in this their first senior game against the Eagles. They run the ball as well if not better, have **Biddleton, Crotty & Wrigglesworth** in fine touch and are that little bit smarter up forward. **Marcellin** will need big games from the **Getson Brothers, Slattery, Petroff, Amad & Cullinan** and must pay heed to **Le Lievre's** instructions if it is to upset a confident Therry on its own ground. As Therry have 'A' Section ideas right throughout the Club they'll win this most important game.

St. Kilda CBC will open its account today at home against **Fawkner** who have lost its way of late and **St. Bernards** at home has the form to sink the **Blacks**. **Parkside** will be untroubled by **Old Trinity & Ivanhoe** will stay in touch by beating **Banyule** at the Boulevard.

There are two big games in C Section. **Old Brighton** are at home to Section leaders **Old Melburnians** and given their intimate knowledge of Beach Road Oval are the tip to upset the **Navy Blues**, whilst **Old Haileybury** having discovered the secret of winning will keep **Thomastown** at bay out at McKinnon. **Thomastown** will be no pushover, especially after a surprise loss at Melbourne High last week, but **Shand** has **Haileybury** in the right mood at present ad with **Hart, Kingsley and Gurney** playing well they'll win.

Hampton Rovers will be determined to record its second win and at home must have a chance against the High School. However the visitors performance last week cannot be overlooked and they may have turned the corner. In the remaining games **Monash Blues** will return to the winning list be beating **Balaclava and Kew** will cement its place in the four by accounting for **AJAX** at Albert Park.

I was quite pleased with a 12 last Saturday and will be delighted to equal it this week in what is a difficult round.

REVIEW OF MATCHES PLAYED MAY16 (ROUND 6)

This round was played in adverse conditions and showed that some clubs did better in the heavy conditions than they had done in the warmer and drier earlier round.

D SECTION

What a close round! Three points was the winning margin in three games. **Old Mentonians** returned to the winning list when they defeated **North Brunswick** in a low scoring game. The winning margin of three points was repeated at **Coburg** where **Old Camberwell** defeated the 'Burgers by the same margin. Only inaccuracy took some of the gloss of **Bulleen United's** big win over **Heatherton**. **St. Kevin's** defeated **Elsternwick** by fifty-three points despite lessening their pressure during the final quarter. In a very low scoring game **Old Ivanhoe** triumphed by three points over **Preston** which means **Preston** remain in the four only by percentage.

E SECTION

Round six results have changed the order of the leading clubs to a marked degree. Despite their inaccurate kicking **Old Essendon** defeated **Brunswick** by ten points. **Brunswick's** two consecutive defeats by a total of twelve points have made the club fall from first to fourth. **State Bank** moved back into the top four as a result of their big win over **Clayton** who have yet to score a 1987 victory. Lowly placed **Powerhouse** surprised a leading side in **Old Geelong** with an eleven point victory on the **Ross Gregory Oval**. **West Brunswick's** fifty-one point win over **Peninsula Old Boys** showed me I am a poor tipster who selected on intuition rather than fact. Well done **West!** **St. Bede's** moved to section leadership following their near ten goal win over **University High School Old Boys**.

F SECTION

Williamstown C.Y.M.S. vindicated my faith in them with a thirty-nine point win over **La Trobe University**. **Whitefriars** certainly showed **Commonwealth Bank** where the football strength lies when they disposed of the **Bankers** by one hundred and twenty-five points. The other **Bank**, **A.N.Z.**, only had a deficit of ninety-nine points at the conclusion of their game against leaders **Doveton**. The wide winning margins in the section continued at **Ringwood** where **Aquinas** defeated **University Reds** by one hundred and sixteen points. **St. Andrews** dropped from the leading bracket as a result of their defeat by **Old Carey** at **Bulleen**. **Footscray Institute** won its second consecutive match by defeating **St. Leonards** by four goals.

G SECTION

The results in this section provided a reshuffle of positions and they have enlivened interest in remaining rounds. **De La Salle** found little difficulty in overcoming **Monash White** by over seven goals while **Collegians** inflicted a five goal defeat on **St. Bernards**. The **Port Colts — Old Scotch** game was a very even contest in which the **Colts** far greater accuracy paved the way for their nineteen point victory. **Bloods** moved further ahead of the other sides when with uncanny accuracy, they accounted for **Old Melburnians** by thirty-three points. **Marcellin's** narrow victory over **Kew** was the real surprise of the round and gives further reason for the **Eagles** to question my tipping. **G.T.V.9** scored their first win of the season by defeating **Old Haileybury** by six goals.

H SECTION

State Bank must have a phobia for scores of thirty-seven points. However unlike Round 6, their losing margin last week was only two points suffered at the hands of **Old Xaverians**. **Bulleen Templestowe** scored another big victory this time at the expense of **Old Geelong** who finished seventy points in arrears. Leaders **Eltham** received only token opposition from **Therry** before the **Turtles** won by sixteen goals. In the battle for twelfth place **Powerhouse/Balaclava** defeated **North Old Boys** by ten goals to leave the **Northerners** languishing at the bottom of the ladder. Second placed **Old Brighton** scored a huge win over **C.B.C. St. Kilda** while **St. Kevin's** moved into the top four as a result of their fifty-one point victory over **Richmond Central**.

UNDER 19 SECTION 1

Collegians greater accuracy enabled them to defeat **De La Salle** by nineteen points which meant **De La** has now fallen a game behind the leading sides. **University Blues** defeated **Ormond** by eighty points and thus maintained sectional leadership. **Melbourne High School Old Boys** trailed **Old Paradians Green** by only fifteen points at half time. In the second half the **Paradians** asserted their superiority and won by six goals even though **Melbourne High** put in a spirited last quarter effort. **Bulleen Templestowe** defeated **North Old Boys** by twenty-five goals and by doing so kept level with the leading bracket. **Marcellin** defeated **Old Xaverians** by only four points because of its greater inaccuracy. Despite their loss the **Xaverians** have maintained second place on percentage.

UNDER 19 SECTION 2

University Blacks defeated **Old Melburnians** by forty-seven points in a dramatic return to winning form. **Banyule** inflicted **St. Bernards** second successive defeat when they had four goals to spare as the final siren sounded. **Therry** maintained sectional leadership with a twenty point victory over **Old Scotch**. Other results meant **Therry's** lead has stretched to two games. **Thomastown** defeated **Old Haileybury** by twenty-seven points to record their first victory of the season. Lowly placed **Old Brighton** provided the sectional upset of the day when they defeated second placed **C.B.C. St. Kilda** by thirteen points. This margin was widened by **St. Kilda's** inaccurate kicking.

UNDER 19 SECTION 3

In a thrilling game **Hampton Rovers** and **Old Paradian's Purple** were level on scores when the game ended. **Caulfield Grammarians** defeated **Monash Blues** by fourteen points while **Ivanhoe** had little difficulty in overcoming **Williamstown** by fifteen goals. **Whitefriars** had the bye.

PREVIEW OF ROUND 7 — MAY 23, 1987

D SECTION

North Brunswick will be anxious to atone for last week's loss when they play **Bulleen United** today. I expect a hard fought match which will result in a narrow victory to **North Brunswick**. **Old Camberwell** will be endeavouring to consolidate their leading position against **Old Mentonians**. As the **Dark Blues** are playing the more consistent football and are at home I select **Old Camberwell**. **Old Ivanhoe** have shown superior form this season to **Coburg** and playing on **Chelworth Park** is an extra advantage. **Old Ivanhoe** to win!!! The main game in the section will be that between **St. Kevins** and **Preston**. **Preston** must redeem themselves after successive defeats while **St. Kevins** will be all out to maintain the section lead. At home and because of better recent form I select **St. Kevins**. **Heatherton** visit **Elsternwick** where they should find the small ground to their advantage. Nevertheless I believe the 'Wicks will have sufficient talent to insure they win.

E SECTION

The match of the day in E Section will be that on the **Dunstan Reserve** where **Brunswick** and **St. Bedes** meet. Neither club has done much wrong this season and the meeting of the section's most active forwards and the section's most restrictive back lines will have a vital bearing on the outcome. After two consecutive albeit narrow losses I select **Brunswick** to win today. **Old Essendon** make the long journey to **Clayton** where they should win comfortably as **Clayton's** 1987 form has little to recommend it. **State Bank** travel east to **Como Park** to engage **Old Geelong**. The **Tigers** have the better recent form although on the wide **Como** wings the **Geelong** side could well test the **Bankers**. **State Bank** should take the points. **Powerhouse** buoyant after two successive victories travel to **Peninsula Old Boys** who have won only one 1987 game. Winning form is good form and as an old man of **Powerhouse** I select them to win today. Neighbours **West Brunswick** and **University High School Old Boys** meet on the **Western Oval**. There is little separating their respective 1987 performances so selection poses some problems. The local winds on the **Western Oval** can pose difficulty for unaware sides. At home I select **West Brunswick**.

F SECTION

Williamstown await **Old Carey** and both sides know victory is a must for either to stay with the leading sides. On the **Fearon Reserve** I select **Williamstown** to record another victory. **Commonwealth Bank**, whose confidence must be low, meet **Footscray Institute** on the **Harry Trott Oval**. I will stick with **Footscray** to win their third successive game. **A.N.Z. Bank** meet **Whitefriars** on **Oval 15**. Despite **Albert Park** conditions proving difficult for visitors all form points to a **Whitefriars** victory. The main section game is that between **Aquinas** and **Doveton**. **Doveton** has not put a foot wrong while **Aquinas** has proven a talented newcomer. After an interesting and closely contested match I expect **Doveton** to emerge victorious. **St. Andrews** make the long journey to **St. Leonards** with the knowledge they must win to stay with the leading sides. Form points to a **St. Andrews** victory. On Sunday the **University** sides **Reds** and **La Trobe** meet at **Melbourne**. **La Trobe** are capable of doing well and as **Peter O'Donoghue** knows the **Melbourne Oval** better than most I select **La Trobe** to win.

G SECTION

De La Salle play **Kew** in what should be an even contest. **Kew's** form last week was not up to its usual standard and today I expect them to return to the winning list. **St. Bernard's** and **G.T.V.9** should provide an entertaining game at **Niddrie** where I believe the home ground advantage will pave the way for a **St. Bernard's** victory. Long standing rivals **Old Scotch** and **Collegians** meet on **Gosh's Paddock** in what should be an evenly contested game. As **Old Scotch** has the better 1987 record I select them to win. In the main sectional game **Bloods** are at home to **Port Colts**. Given the respective 1987 performances of each club I must select the **Bloods** to win again. **Marcellin** travel to **Old Haileybury** with renewed enthusiasm following their victory last week. **Marcellin** should make it two in a row today which will please their supremo **Damien Sullivan**. **Monash White** will be anxious to atone for last week's loss as well as to remain with the leading bracket. These incentives should spur the **Whites** to victory over **Old Melburnians**.

H SECTION

State Bank and **Old Brighton** should contest a closely fought game on **Oval 4**. Despite the **Bankers** liking for this Oval I select **Old Brighton** because their 1987 form has been the more consistent. **Old Geelong** should prove too strong for **Richmond Central** while the main game of the round should be that between leaders **Eltham** and **Bulleen Templestowe**. This should be the biggest test **Eltham** has so far faced and their defenders could face a torrid time. After a closely contested game I favour **Eltham** to emerge victorious. There is not a great deal between the 1987 performances of **North Old Boys** and **Therry** who meet today on the **Ryder Oval**. **Therry** have already scored a victory this season and statistically their performances are marginally ahead of those by **North Old Boys**. These are my reasons for selecting **Therry**. **St. Kevins** and **C.B.C. St. Kilda** should provide

an interesting contest from which I expect **St. Kevins** to emerge with the four points. **Old Xaverians** should be able to continue along their winning way today by accounting for **Powerhouse/Balaclava**.

UNDER 19 SECTION 1

Two losers from Round 6 **De La Salle** and **Old Xaverians** meet in an important game. The **Xaverians** have the more impressive 1987 record and I favour them to take the points today. 
150 AT M.H.S.O.B.

OTF wonders whether all clubs are aware of the duties of the "Interchange Steward" and we're happy to quote Rule 43(xiii) if you're not!

The **HOME** club in each first round match is responsible to supply a steward to supervise the interchange of players:

- (a) The Steward shall position himself between the boundary line and fence on the centre wing within a marked area fifteen (15) metres in width and shall be attired in a white coat.
- (b) All interchanging of players shall take place within the marked area and the official runner of the club concerned shall advise the Steward of each interchange. Any interchange made during the quarter time, half-time or three quarter time intervals must be notified to the Steward prior to the commencement of the next quarter.
- (c) Interchanging of players may be made at any time during the course of a match. The Steward shall keep a record of all interchanges made during the game and shall hand such record to the field umpire at the conclusion of the match. The record shall consist of the numbers of the players involved in the interchange and the quarter or interval during which such interchange took place.
- (d) A player who is replaced otherwise than as provided in these rules shall not be entitled to return to the field for the remainder of the match.


50 GAMES AT M.H.S.O.B.



Adrian Schrader (still well known to many followers) starred for **Old Xaverians**.


