



We certainly had a lot of fun presenting our V.A.F.A. Footy Show on 89.5 Southern FM last Sunday. Many thanks to guests **Mike Sholly** (Asst. Coach Old Xavs), **Steve Curtain** (despite being knocked out on Saturday), **Neville Nash** (Umpires Advisor), **Ray Sneddon** (VAFA Marketing Consultant), **Ray Berzins** (Caulfield Grammarians), **Bruce Bourne** (State Selector) and **Geoff Sincock** and **Steve Marshall** (Old Haileybury). We tried to give a good coverage to clubs in the southern region.

Between us, **Peter French** and I were unable to tip the card. I wasn't much help. Admittedly it was an even round but fortunately **Bulleen-Templestowe's** win over **Caulfield Grammarians** saved me from complete embarrassment.

It must have been a bottler out at Ormond! **Old Xaverians** 14 point win stamps them as a real contender in my mind. **Peter French** might not have thought so when he left early in the last quarter with **Ormond** 18 points up. What he missed was **Old Xavs** piling on 6 goals. And it was a sensational start to the match with **Xavs** full forward **Steve Curtain** being knocked out in the first minute. It did not stop there. **Mick Atkins** caught **Phil Mehrten** off balance in the third quarter and sent him into the fence! **Danny Corcoran** was very hyped-up at the last huddle and his charges responded.

The first major upset was caused by **North Old Boys** who with a 5 goal last quarter overran **Old Paradians** to win by 15 points. **Gary Carroll** and **Steve O'Rourke** are providing a lot of drive for **North**. According to reliable sources (**Norm Hedley**), **North** "could be on the way".

Peter French Previews today's matches



Before commenting on last weeks upsets or today's encounters a pat on the back to colleague **Ross Booth** for a first class review of last Saturday's matches. In addition **Ross** is doing a sterling job both on 3LO on Saturday evenings and 3AW on Sunday mornings and his hosting of the "footy show" last Sunday on Southern Community Radio was handled most professionally. Well done Ross.

It really was a round of upsets with five previously undefeated sides — **Ormond (A)**, **Parkside (B)**, **Old Melburnians (C)**, **Doveton (F)**, **Eltham O.C. (H)** going under leaving **Whitefriars** with an enviable record of being unbeaten in Seniors, Reserves and Under 19's. A great effort indeed by the Donvale based club. The other unbeaten sides are **Bloods (G)**, **Preston MBOB (D Reserves)** and **Uni Blacks (U.19 1)**.

I was pretty pleased after selecting **Old Xaverians** and **Old Brighton** but readily acknowledge the efforts of **North Old Boys**, **Bulleen-Templestowe** and **Old Trinity**. I wonder whether **North** can kick on from here and you can bet there were some happy faces at the Ted Ajani Reserve by 5 p.m. The return of **Tony Keenan** was undoubtedly a bonus whilst **Darren Collins** stamped himself on Amateur Football booting 6 goals in the side's eleven goal second term burst. The overall benefit of the weekends' results which also saw **St. Kilda C.B.C.** break the ice was to even up the sections so that a finals appearance is still well within the grasp of most clubs.

Now to the 8th round where long standing rivals **De La Salle** and **North Old Boys** meet at the East Malvern ground in the match of the day. **De La's** form is certainly up and down and if it is to feature in this seasons finals it simply cannot afford to drop games to the sides below nor lose any more home games. **North** on the other hand, have bounced back admirably following that incredible loss to **Old Scotch** three weeks back. Ah the glorious uncertainty of Amateur football! For **North** to win it will need **Gus Carroll** to continue his recent good form as his opposite number, that inspirational **De La** skipper **Mick Greene** is having another season of defying the odds. I've noticed he's kicking the ball more this year. Is that a change in his style, a direction from the coach or have the **De La** small men stopped feeding off his many possessions? **De La** statistician, **Damien O'Donnell** might say that I'm imagining it but I'll bet the thought has not been lost on the **McArthur-Allens**, **Ferguson's**, **Sholly's** et al. Besides this confrontation young **Colin Lowe** will be up against yet another wily defender in **North's Jerome Griffin**. They will also be hoping that **Garry Connolly** returns to liven up the midfield. Young **Mike Kruppell** who is relishing a defenders role may have his hands full with either **Hebert** or **Egan** who are both clever and dangerous forwards. However coach **Stephen Rae** has **Nash** or **Karl Anderson** at his disposal should the **North** forwards cut loose. In what traditionally is a classic encounter I'll stick with **North** whose confidence and team spirit has improved dramatically.

The other big game will be played at the Trott between **Collegians** and **Old Scotch**, who also boast a great tradition of memorable encounters. However this game this year will be remembered as the day the Lions recaptured their '86 form. Their win against the Blues last week was just the tonic needed after the poor start to the season and the sheer brilliance of **Richard Herman** whose likely clash with **Rob Fuller** promises to be a real highlight, is the main difference between the sides. **Scotch** struggled to kick 8 goals last week and **Schober**, **Wright**, **Parsons**, **Williams** and **Hinchin** form a defence that suggest the Cardinals will struggle to better that tally today. **John Meir** is in good touch and should beat **Pollack** and **Richard Senior**, **Reddish** and **Ed Allen** are smarter around the ground than **Keith Parsons** and **Lemon**. However **Tregear** and **Kahn** who is gradually finding last season's touch will form a winning centre-line and with **Stephen Bickford** starting to fire at last, **Collegians** will move ahead of **Scotch** by 5 p.m. tonight.

Old Xaverians will appreciate a home game against **Uni Blues** whose inability to put two good games together is a big worry and poses many doubts over their finals hopes. **Xavs** are really on the boil. They are responding magnificently to **Danny Corcoran** and need only to guard against over-confidence to come away with the points today.

Old Paradians are away again - to **Bulleen-Templestowe** and despite their loss to **North** last week have too much experience and talent for the bullants, although my spies tell me they were lethargic last week and often second to the ball. So **Graeme Jacobs** that could be the answer!!!! However I'm sure neither **Gerard Sholly** or his side will have been proud of last week's effort and **Bulleen-Templestowe** might be unfortunate to catch them on the rebound today.

Ormond has the short trip to Albert Park to play **Caulfield Grammarians** and will be smarting after their last quarter fade out against **Old Xavs**. I most certainly was surprised to hear of their loss having left, as Ross

Booth says, after 10 minutes when the home side through the agency of **Phil Mehrten** engaged a 3 goal lead. However that's ancient history and **Ormond** like **Old Paradians** will rebound strongly and assert this supremacy with a big win over **Caulfield** who really have some problems.

In B Section **Marcellin** meets **Parkside** who have never won at Bulleen in the match of the day. Both sides were beaten last week, **Marcellin** starting poorly with the wind whilst the Devils were gone by half time. At home the Eagles' running game should give them the edge. **Banyule** and **St. Kilda CBC** clash at Elsternwick Park in a crucial game for both clubs. I like the Saints. Their win last Saturday will have restored a lot of confidence and their form has not been all that bad despite their lack of wins. **Uni Blacks** are in a slump and will not relish a visit from **Ivanhoe** who are certainly the form side. **Blacks** are in real danger of losing touch with the top sides and are bound to put in a much improved performance. Nevertheless the **'Hoe** will win. **Old Trinity** are still up in the air after their excellent win over **Parkside**. They'd better return to reality quickly today as they face the other "form" side in **St. Bernards** who have not put a foot wrong in the last month. **Old Trinity** is capable of matching it with all sides but they're not quite as consistent as **St. Bernards** and I'm selecting the visitors to consolidate its position in the top four.

Fawkner is at home to **Therry** and is in desperate need of a win. These two clubs have staged some great games over the years and today should be no exception. In the year of the upset I've a hunch the home side can upset the Therry machine and win narrowly.

To C Section where **Old Melburnians** are bound to bounce back and inflict a large defeat on the hapless **AJAX** and **Thomastown** will also be out for revenge and ensure that **Hampton Rovers** do not enjoy the long trip home. **Melbourne High** will fancy itself against **Monash Blues** and at the school oval could well surprise the students and provide the upset of the round. **Old Brighton's** effort last week will have shown the club of its capabilities and **Mark Sarau** has been around long enough to ensure his charges do not slip up at **Balaclava** where it is never easy to win. In the remaining game **Old Haileybury** finds itself in the match of the day against **Kew**. **Old Haileybury** are hard to beat at McKinnon, and realize that if they're to feature in this years promotion battle a win is a must today. **Kew** on the other hand has done little wrong and for the home side to win it must blanket the Kew small men — **Busuttil**, **Brice**, **Bradley**, **Burden** and **McColl**. They are all runners and are always in the thick of things, indeed young **Phillip's** clash with **Bradley** is bound to be a beauty. I'm sure this will be a close game, but lean to **Kew** who might be that bit more direct when things get tight.

Eleven was a more than satisfactory effort last week and although I've gone for a few outsiders today I'm confident of equaling if not bettering that mark.

REVIEW OF MATCHES PLAYED MAY 23 (ROUND 7).

D SECTION

Bulleen United continued on its inaccurate but winning way with a twenty eight point win over North Brunswick while **Old Mentonians** maintained winning form with a fifty two point win over **Old Camberwell**. These victories lifted **Bulleen United & Old Mentonians** into the leading four sides. The results of the other three matches were as I expected except the **St. Kevins — Preston** game where the leaders fell in by one point in a game where Preston, despite having more opportunities, failed to kick straight. **Coburg** finished over eleven goals behind **Old Ivanhoe & Elsternwick** defeated **Heatherton** by thirteen goals.

E SECTION

Once again your tipster forecast the sectional card. **St. Bedes** kicked themselves to defeat against the more accurate **Brunswick** who won by twenty eight points. As expected **Clayton** proved no match for **Old Essendon** who moved to leadership of the section as a result of this victory. **State Bank** vindicated by confidence with a ninety five point win over **Old Geelong** who lost for the second successive week. **Powerhouse** continued on their winning way up the ladder through defeating **Peninsula Old Boys** for whom relegation is now a distinct possibility. **West Brunswick** consolidated its sixth position with a clear cut victory over **University High School Old Boys**.

F SECTION

Williamstown vindicated by faith in them when they defeated **Old Carey** by twenty two points to remain in the four and to move ahead of the fifth side (**St. Andrews**) by a clear game.

Commonwealth Bank showed a marked form reversal when they defeated **Footscray Institute** by over twelve goals despite their forward inaccuracy. **ANZ Bank** put up spirited resistance before losing to new leader **Whitefriars** by forty points. The real surprise was **Doveton**'s poor showing against **Aquinas** who are now equal on points with **Doveton** and seeking second place as a result. **St. Andrews** defeated **St. Leonards** by sixty nine points to regain fifth position and thus keep in range of the leading bracket. **La Trobe University** proved far too strong for **University Reds** with a sixty five point win.

G SECTION

Round 7 results were mainly those your tipster forecast although the margins in some games were more disparate than I imagined. **Old Haileybury's** seventeen point win over **Marcellin** prevented me from selecting the G Section Card. **Kew** returned to the winning list by defeating **De La Salle** by ten points, while inaccuracy almost cost **St. Bernards** their game against **GT9**. **St. Bernards** with eleven more scoring shots fell in by a goal. **Old Scotch** blitzed **Collegians** who offered little resistance before **Scotch** won by over twelve goals. **Bloods** continued on their winning way when they accounted for **Port Colts** by twenty two points. Great Blood accuracy would have widened that margin. **Monash Whites** with a thirteen point victory over **Old Melburnians** consolidated their top four position.

H SECTION

Old Brighton had fifty points to spare against **State Bank** and by winning made themselves more secure in the leading bracket. Leaders **Eltham** lowered their colours for the first time this season when **Bulleen-Templestowe** defeated them by twenty points. Conversely **North Old Boys** had their first win of the season when they disposed of **Therry** by two goals. **Therry** had only themselves to blame because they had eight more scoring shots. **Old Xaverians** gained a badly needed percentage boost when they defeated **Powerhouse/Balaclava** by eighty seven points. **St. Kevins** proved too strong for **CBC St. Kilda** at Albert Park where they won by seven. **Richmond Central** advanced up the ladder as a result of their forty eight point victory over **Old Geelong**. **Richmond** are now comfortably situated in fifth place.

UNDER 19 SECTION 1

Old Xaverians bounced back onto the winning list when they defeated **De La Salle** by fifty six points. **Univ. Blues** kept their 1987 record intact when they finished in front of **Collegians** by twenty five points. **Melb. High School Old Boys** returned to the winning list with a stunning eighty nine point victory over **Ormond**. **Marcellin** again proved me to be a poor judge when they defeated neighbouring **Bulleen-Temp.** by a wide margin of forty points. This loss sent **Bulleen Templestowe** from the top four as **Old Paradians Green** replaced them following the walkover which they received from **North Old Boys**.

UNDER 19 SECTION 2

Old Melburnians proved too strong for **Old Brighton** and recorded a twenty six point victory in a game that saw the day's highest aggregate score. **University Blacks** proved me wrong again because they defeated **St. Bernards** by twenty points. Really I should have written St. Bernards lack consistency because their form over

the past four weeks has been enigmatic. Leaders **Therry** wore down a determined **Thomastown** in windy conditions. After an entertaining game **Therry** won by seventy seven points. **Old Scotch** did return to the winning list because they defeated **Banyule** by forty two points. **Banyule's** inaccuracy contributed to the margin. **Old Haileybury's** forty one point defeat of **CBC St. Kilda** vindicated by judgement in selecting them.

UNDER 19 SECTION 3

Leaders **Whitefriars** continued on the winning way when they defeated **Monash Blues** by twenty six points. Greater accuracy by the **Old Paradians Purple** players enabled this young group to record their first victory when they defeated **Williamstown** by eight points. **Caulfield Grammarians** defeated **Hampton Rovers** by fourteen goals after a fairly uneven contest. **Ivanhoe** had the bye.

PREVIEW OF ROUND 8. May 30, 1987

D SECTION

North Brunswick journey to **Heatherton** where the home side have shown no real 1987 form. As **North Brunswick** have the better 1987 record I select them to win today. **Bulleen United** seem to be gathering momentum although their inaccurate shooting for goal must be worrying to **Max McColl** and his advisors. Today I select **United** to score again, at the expense of **Old Camberell Grammarians**. **Old Ivanhoe** journey to **Old Mentone** where the locals will be all out for victory to stay in touch with the sectional leaders. **Old Ivanhoe** has the score on the board so I select them today. Leaders **St. Kevins** journey to **Coburg**, where many leading sides have been defeated over the years. The vagueness of the winds along the Merri Creek will necessitate total **St. Kevins**' concentration of else **Coburg** will take the points. Over the seven games **Coburg** have scored only nine less points than **St. Kevins** so there is not a wide margin between the strength of the sides. Despite my uncertainties **St. Kevins** have done sufficient this season to warrant me selecting them. **Elsternwick** are a home to Preston whose 1987 form has not been up to the standard of previous season's performances. **Elsternwick** has scored more heavily but the Preston defenders have been the stronger. **Preston** has shown enough form to justify me selecting them to win today.

E SECTION

Now Brunswick has regained that winning feeling I believe they will win again today at the expense of **Univ. High School Old Boys**. **St. Bede's** should return to the winning list today with a big victory over **Clayton** who have struggled this year. **Old Geelong**;s form has slipped over the past two weeks and I expect they will lose their third consecutive game today when they meet **Old Essendon**. **State Bank** will show no mercy to lowly **Peninsula Old Boys** when they meet on Oval 4. I forecast a big credit score to the Bankers. **West Brunswick** & **Powerhouse** should play an interesting and evenly contested game. As the two clubs have similar records this season I believe home ground advantage will be the difference today so **West Brunswick** are my selection.

F SECTION

St. Andrews await **Williamstown** with the knowledge victory could see them replace **Williamstown** in the top four. There is little between the two sides on seasonal performances and I expect closely contested game after which **Williamstown** will emerge victorious. **Old Carey** at Bulleen should be untroubled to defeat **ANZ Bank** despite the Bankers good display last week. At Bundoora I expect **La Trobe University** will be too talented for **Commonwealth Bank**. The **Whitefriars-Doveton** game could well be a preview of this year's Grand Final. **Doveton**'s poor display last week has prompted me to select Whitefriars today. **University Reds** journey to **St. Leonards** for a game which could be the Saints best chance of victory since round one. I select the Reds purely because of their better overall 1987 performances.

G SECTION

How can I select **Marcellin** to defeat **De La Salle** after their recent unpredictable form? Victory by **De La Salle** (which I predict) will see them safe in the four for another week. **Kew** at home should prove too talented for **Old Scotch** while **Monash Whites** should be able to build percentage against lowly placed **St. Bernards**. **Collegians & Port Colts** have similar records this season and so their match should be a fairly even contest. At home I believe **Collegians** will take the four points. **Old Haileybury** bolstered by last week's victory should win again today at the expense of **Old Melburnians**. With such a marked difference in their 1987 performances I select **Bloods** to maintain their unbeaten records with a resounding victory over **GT9**.

H SECTION

St. Kilda await **State Bank**. Visiting teams repeatedly find victory elusive at the Coughlin Oval and today I believe **State Bank** will suffer defeat at the hands of C.B.C. St. Kilda. Leaders **Eltham** face another danger game when they journey to play **Old Brighton** on the difficult to play Beach Oval. After a lot of thought I have decided to stick with the home club and I predict an **Old Brighton** victory. **Old Xaverians & Old Geelong** should stage an evenly contested game from which I expect **Old Xaverians** to emerge victorious. **St. Kevins** should be able to record a big victory at the expense of **Powerhouse/Balaclava**. **Bulleen-Templestowe** should continue on their winning way by defeating **Therry** comfortably today. **Richmond Central** at home should be talented enough to defeat **North Old Boys** whose first win last week must have boosted their confidence.

UNDER 19 SECTION 1

Marcellin's recent performances compel me to select them against **De La Salle** today. In what could be a Grand Final preview **Old Xaverians** play **University Blues**. The Blues have carried all before them this season but the Xaverian side is a star studded one. After a hard fought and even contest I select the **Old Xaverians** in **Albert Park**. The home ground advantage should be sufficient to enable **Collegians** to emerge with the four points. **Ormond** who are not enjoying a successful season will be too strong for **North Old Boys** who are yet to record a victory. In what could be a final's preview **Bulleen Templestowe** are at home to **Old Paradian's Green**. The **Combine** faltered last week while the **Paradians** won by default. This could make the **Paradians** match fitness somewhat suspect and I select **Bulleen Templestowe** to emerge victorious after an evenly contested game.

UNDER 19 SECTION 2

C.B.C.St. Kilda, who lost second place as a result of their loss last week, should return to the winning list today against Old Melburnians. St. Bernards will be anxious to record their fourth victory, which has been a long time coming, against Old Brighton. Despite Old Brighton's home ground advantage I believe St. Bernards can win. In an important game Old Scotch will take the points because they really have more incentive as the double chance in the finals could be at stake this early in the Season. Two northerly based sides Banyule & Thomastown are drawn on the former's ground. Banyule must improve their accuracy or they will find Thomastown taking the game with their tenacious play. 



FIRST 300 GAME PLAYER AT THOMASTOWN



Well done Tony from all at Doveton!!! Also good luck with the song writing.





