ALL coaches will register to their community club/s via [CoachAFL](#). Coaches must select the club/team they are coaching in their Coaching Profile when renewing or accrediting for the first time. This selection of club registers them for the 2021 season.

*Coaches registered to a Club in a League that had their 2020 season cancelled due to the COVID-19 outbreak will receive a 50% discount on their membership fee to CoachAFL for the 2021 season. This discount will be applied automatically to their CoachAFL membership fee in 2021 when they renew their 2021 CoachAFL membership. To qualify, coaches must have been registered and accredited to a club in cancelled league prior to July 31, 2020.
