We pride ourselves on our wonderful VAFA community and regularly talk about the terrific role volunteers play, so how about this week i) pat a volunteer on the back and say thank you and ii) seriously consider nominating someone at your club who you think fits the criteria.

On a more concerning note, the last few weeks in the VAFA, and across community football in general, the incidence of vilification matters being reported has been prominent.

The Victorian Amateur Football Association (VAFA) reinforces that it is committed to fostering an enjoyable environment by

prohibiting certain conduct and providing a means of redress for victims of vilification and discrimination.

The VAFA fosters and maintains a sporting environment which promotes understanding, accepts the unique differences of all persons affiliated with or interested in Australian Football, and recognises the need to prohibit discriminatory or vilifying conduct.

The VAFA relies upon the overarching AFL Vilification and Discrimination Policy, as well as other applicable AFL Victoria Policies including the AFL Victoria Member Protection Policy.

The VAFA's Vilification & Discrimination Policy establishes the means of redress for players, umpires, officials and volunteers aggrieved by what they reasonably consider to be vilification or discrimination based on their individuality.

In short, the VAFA policy is clear in that *no Association Participant or Club Official shall engage in conduct which may reasonably be considered to incite hatred towards, contempt for, ridicule of or discrimination against a person or group of persons on the ground of their: race; religion; gender; colour; sexual preference, orientation or identity or special ability or disability.*

The VAFA has processes in place to address matters which are brought to our attention - processes we take very seriously. We implore the whole VAFA community to stand up and call out behaviour that should not be tolerated either on or off the field.

We are all responsible in making our club and playing environments safe places for all and we ask our whole community to band together to stamp out any form of vilification or discrimination across the VAFA.

On a brighter note, while our umpire numbers are improving slightly, it was great to hear of an instance last week where a former AFL player, now at a VAFA Club, provided direct encouragement to a female boundary umpire who was struggling to throw the ball in in blustery conditions. This "working together" approach is far more productive, rather than some who have taken it upon themselves to turn to social media to snipe at the VAFA's umpire shortage and other Association matters – please remember, we are all in this together.

## Battle of Thermopylae for Ayce and his men

Despite Old Brighton claiming yet another victory, there is a new ladder leader in William Buck Premier Men's with **St Kevin's OB** soaring to the top of the table following their 74-point Round 6 victory over **Old Melburnians**. And they did it without Tom Boyd (their leading goal kicker) and Jarrad Waite (that guy who kicked 58 two years ago). Their forward set-up of Billy Kanakis (4) and Boyd's replacement Sam Barnett (3) caused havoc for OM's defenders, but the most surprising/impressive move was Sam Critchley starting forward and kicking the first goal of the game. After averaging just 62ppg in the first five rounds, SKOB hit their straps on Saturday with 126. Kanakis will be missed as he relocates to Sydney but with the two power forwards returning soon, SKOB's scoring woes may be a thing of the past. As for OM's, this was their third test against a top four side after going down to Uni Blues (R3) and Old Brighton (R5). R1 Rising Star nominee, Ed Nichols, is currently operating in the elite category after another two goals and a standout performance, but now at 3-3 after starting 2-0, OM's will be keen to improve their record when they travel to Harry Trott Oval this weekend.

While Brian Waldron may have described his tip as idiocy on last week's *FTLOTG Podcast*, there's no denying Joe Pignataro's tip of **Old Scotch** to defeat **Uni Blues** was inspired. The Cardinals, who had narrowly defeated the Snow Dogs one week earlier, made the most of their opportunities in front of goal with 10.9. In the end, that was the difference as Uni Blues delivered a masterclass in poor kicking - sending through 11 straight behinds in the opening half and finishing the game with 5.18 thanks to a 4.4 final term. Brodie Easton's form has been a highlight of Scotch's season to date, and he continued with a BOG performance, while Aidan Franetic was just as impressive. When Scotch's defence is on song, they're winning games with an average of 52 points against in their three wins. The Blues have been the comeback kids over the past few rounds but not even the continued good form of Jack Stephens and Marshall Rippon could save them from a brutal case of the yips. Expect Ayce Cordy to lead his men into their Round 7 clash against Trinity like King Leonidas in the Battle of Thermopylae – but unlike the Spartans, the result should go in their favour.

Maybe I'm wrong and **Trinity** could pull off their first win of the season after impressing against **Old Brighton** last weekend. Despite a change of senior coach during the week, the T's took it up to the then ladder leaders and even led by eight points at half time. In the end, Woodrow Medal fancy (as he is every year) Harry Hill willed his men over the line while Seb

Williams kicked a season-high four goals. Charlie Beasley was outstanding in defence for the T's for the second week in a row and their young brigade of Dylan Xenos, Hugo McGlashan and Xavier Fry gave supporters every inkling the club's future is bright. The Tonners will host Old Xaverians at the Beach Oval in the *RSN Match of the Round* in a clash of second vs third – arguably the most enticing match-up of the year to date.

Two losses were never going to turn into three as **Old Xavs** returned to form in emphatic fashion, defeating **Collegians** by 59 points at Toorak Park. For the first time this season, Xavs produced the three-headed monster up forward of Ryan Schoenmakers, Grant Valles and former Sydney Swan, Xavier Richards. Schoenmakers was the pick of the bunch with a match-high four goals, but two from Richards on debut and another standout performance from Valles gives Xavs a forward line as potent as any – especially when Rohan Bewick returns. It was a devastating start for Collegians with Tom Penberthy returning for his first senior game since the 2018 Grand Final but going down with an ACL injury in the opening term. With John Meesen sitting out, it left the Lions without a ruck to combat Jason Holmes, but Oli Jackson did his utmost while kicking two goals. The Lions are left at 1-5 after six rounds but will be hoping the likes of Sam Hibbins and Tom Sheridan return for their clash with OM's.

In the final game, **Caulfield Grammarians** claimed their third win on the trot with a 42-point win over **St Bernard's** at the Snake Pit. Offensively, the Fields are the best in the competition over the past three rounds with an average of 119ppg. Keegan Stewart was the main target this week with four goals while Julian Dobosz didn't play, and Brett Eddy was needed only once. On the flip side, it was the Snow Dogs' third loss in a row. Bernard's averaged 83ppg over the first three rounds but have since managed scores of just 56, 57 and 58. Mitchell Mahady and Charlie Vague were their best against the Fields, but they will be hoping to break their run of losses against an in-form SKOB at TH King.

## Bloods running hot in Premier B

Heading into round seven, **Old Haileybury** now are perched atop the Premier B table after arguably their most impressive win since their 2017 Grand Final victory, fending off the fast-finishing Blackers by just five points. With the margin within a kick in the dying stages, the Bloods secured the final clearance of the afternoon through star Brede Seccull to help grab a memorable victory for the magenta & black.

The ladder-leaders now turn their attention to **Williamstown CYMS** who took care of business themselves against the Vultures, claiming a handy 83-point win to move into 5<sup>th</sup> on the table. Holding a mere 18-point lead heading into the main break, the CYs proceeded to slam home 11 of the 12 goals after half-time to blow the game wide open. Looking ahead to this clash, the Bloods elite ability to put scores on the board behind the likes of Durras Seccull, Sam Loewe and Corey Connelly, matched with the outstanding play of Emilio Bitters and skipper James Paul in defence, Haileybury are flourishing in-front of our very eyes. Winless outside the confines of Fearn Reserve, the CYs will need to lean heavily on the likes of captain Tom Johnstone, Brad Tucker and Sam Callard in the middle of the ground to keep possession and limit their opponents inside-50 count, as going goal-for-goal with the Bloods could spell trouble for Mat Montebello's crew.

Going down to Haileybury was the **University Blacks**, who had their colours lowered for the first time in 2021. Despite trailing by 24 at the main break, the Blackers managed to claw all the way back and after a classy Harrie Lahy snap in the dying stages, had an opportunity to snag victory from the grips of defeat, ultimately falling short. A trip to Albert Park now awaits Uni Blacks as they square off with **AJAX**, who succumbed to a ferocious Tigers squad, allowing five of the final six goals of the match to go down by 23-points. The Jackas seemingly kept their opponents in check for three quarters, forcing the Tigers into their defensive style of play, but let go of the chain in the last quarter and were ultimately run out of Brindisi Street without the four-points. The main test for **AJAX** will be limiting the likes of James Sansom and Jordan Quaille in the middle of the ground, as once the ball goes forward to the key bogs in Daniel McCullough and Alastair Robbins, it could be raining goals at Gary Smorgen. Keep watch on Ben Krongold and Nick Lewis who will have their hands full with this classy Uni Blacks outfit.

Returning to form and ending their two-game skid was **Beaumaris**, putting the Roys' to the sword and running out comfortable 56-point victors at Banksia Reserve. Piling on ten majors to three after half-time, the Sharks put their rough fortnight behind them and showed again why they should be considered prominently to go deep into September. Following on from their second-half dismantling of Fitzroy, Beau will now turn their attention to the struggling **Old Carey** who were handily beaten by fellow former William Buck Premier competitor De La. A disappointing and sluggish start to 2021 for the Panthers sees

them sit in 8<sup>th</sup> spot and outside of the defensive minded **AJAX** and **Parkdale**, are the lowest scoring side in the competition, averaging just under 10-goals a match. As these two sides clash on Saturday, be sure to monitor how Simon Pasinati and company strategizes to handle arguably the most in-form player in the comp in Chris Grigoriadis, who continues to shine across the midfield and half-forward. With Grigoriadis at one end, Lewis Diggins has led the Sharks across half-back and will have the task of slowing the Panthers leading man Harrison Bean, who has been outstanding for Carey so far this year.

Winners of three-straight, **De La Salle** are in the midst of their longest winning streak since 2017 and have a great chance this weekend to make it their first four-game winning stretch since 2015, travelling to Gerry Green Reserve for a matchup with the winless **Parkdale**. Strong victories over Carey, Beaumaris and Fitzroy see De La entrenched well-inside the top-4 and a win this weekend could see that lead grow as the fifth placed CYs vs Haileybury. The Vultures continue to play for pride and develop through the adversity, with Cooper Balic leading from the front and pushing his side towards competitiveness. The midfield duo of Hugh Nicholson and Fraser Cameron should have a field day for De La, while Adrian Indovino and Tom Deane-Johns should fare well up-forward as they deal with the Panthers backline that leaks over 117-points per contest.

Brunswick Street Oval will play host to our final clash for round seven with **St Bedes/Mentone Tigers** and **Fitzroy** locking horns. The Tigers enter on the heels of an impressive fight back over the Jackas, booting five-goals-to-one in the final term to notch win number three. Fitzroy were thoroughly outclassed by the Sharks in route to their fourth consecutive loss, their longest losing streak since 2017. Ahead of only Parkdale, Fitzroy concede the most points per clash at just under 79 a game, and with the league leading goal-kicker James Mangoni coming to town, the Tigers should have no issue getting on the scoreboard if they can get the ball out of the middle. How Fitzroy can defend the Tigers strong forward line should be a key-piece for Luke Mahoney to study, as well as how they can combat Michael Barnes, who continues to feature prominently in the Tigers back six.

## Panthers produce upset of the year

behind them when they host a constantly competitive Marcellin team. Ormond will face Monash in a top of the table clash that stands to be a classic.

**Monash** continued their unbeaten start to 2021 beating **Marcellin** by 10 points at Frearson Oval. While the Blues were wasteful in front of goal, the Eagles clearly had come to play and a strong half from star midfielder Patrick Howe meant Marcellin were only down by five points at half-time. In the second half, the Eagles could not stop big MacGregor Cameron's influence both in the ruck and around the ground as he, along with forward Mitch King and in-form mid Beau Harris, had Monash up by 21 points going into the last. The fourth quarter was all Marcellin, as in his 200<sup>th</sup> game, Jonathan Blanch tried to will his team to victory. Despite a terrific defensive display, the Eagles could not quite get the job done in the end despite Jeremiah Antypas impressing with three goals on the day. The Eagles will travel to Como Park to face the wounded Old Geelong hungry to make a stand after their decimation on the weekend. Monash will host Ormond in a battle of the two top teams, and defences in the league. Can Ormond stop the dominance of Cameron? Can Suckling and the Buckleys send Ormond to the top of the ladder? We will see....

In our final game of the round, **Mazenod** walked away 69-point winners against **Preston** at W.R. Ruthven Reserve. It was blowing down at Preston last Saturday and starting with the wind the Nodders were able to get out to a 28 point lead after the first. However, they found it a lot more difficult in the second as the Bullants piled on four goals to the Nodders' one. From there, the Mazenod defence stood tall and held the Bullants to only two goals for the rest of the game. Liam Sutton was terrific all day for Preston while Jackson Curic continued his great form kicking three on the day. Nick Pascuzzi bagged four again for Mazenod (eight in the last two games) while wingman Jack Sullivan was best on ground. The Nodders welcomed back Big V 2019 B-D4 representative Tom Warby who was also in the best. Mazenod will look to keep the gravy train going when they host Hampton this week. Someone will get their first win for 2021 this year, and the Bullants will hope it is them when they host the relentless UHS-VU.






