This plan will include creation of a third women's team when the opportunity arises. ✚ In conjunction with the Recruitment and Retention Working Group, develop pathways and partnerships with the FJFC, VFLW and AFLW ✚ Support Team Managers ✚ Liaise with the Director, Football Operations and Coaching Director.
