This plan will include creation of a third women's team when the opportunity arises.</li> <li>In conjunction with the Recruitment and Retention Working Group, develop pathways and partnerships with the FJFC, VFLW and AFLW</li> <li>Support Team Managers</li> <li>Liaise with the Director, Football Operations and Coaching Director.</li> </ul>
